REGISTRATION 1990:

As some of you may realize, the processing of registration has been somewhat delayed this year. We have a new computer program which makes the registration of athletes faster and also puts the non-athletes and teams on the computer for the first time. However, there were a few problems with the program, so things are a little late.

However, all team registrations received by December 30, 1989 are in the computer and have been sent to Colorado.

All Coach registrations received by Dacember 30, 1989 (with the proper documentation of CPR, First Aid, and Safety Training for Swim Coaches) have been put into the computer and sent to Colorado. Yellow cards for coaches have also been mailed out to these coaches.

HOWEVER, I have a large pile of coach registrations that were sent without the proper documentation. I will process these forms as "non-athlete" members, but not "coach" members shortly if copies of CPR. First Aid, and Safety Training for Swim Coaches have not arrived.

Many non-athlete registrations also have been processed. The rest will be done as soon as possible.

About 25% of the athletes have been processed, and the rest will be done as soon as possible. Please remember that a club, athlete, or non-athlete is considered registered as soon as I receive the forms and checks.

BIDS FOR MEETS DURING THE LONG COURSE SEASON: Included in this newsletter is a bid form and calendar for the summer. Please note that all BIDS are due by FEBRUARY 20, 1990!

ALL OFFICIALS

REFEREE CHAIRMAN JOHN JOHANESSEN

A complaint recently came forward concerning the use of our headsets during a meet. It was felt that they were being used illegally.

Instructions came over the air to watch the swimmer in lane ??? for a possible infraction. It either is, or it isn't, its very unfair to single out a swimmer for special watching. If you see an infraction, call it. Now, when the Referee asks, what did you see, where were you standing and what rule was broken, you can discuss it. Just because you've raised your hand, doesn't mean the swimmer is automatically D.O.ed. It's at this time that I've found the headsets to be excellent teaching tools. All stations are listening in, all hear the questions and answers, and if something that happened is not understood by all, then additional information can be requested. Stroke and Turns also get to listen in on false starts, relay starts, comments between the Recall Starter and Referee, why we have a hold on events, rotation of Officials, etc. Some, also provide a little humor which certainly helps loosen us all up and pass the time more easily. I'm one that likes the headsets, I like that instant communication, I like to be aware of all thats going on around me, I have found that a few sets are more sensitive to electrical static than others, If the Starter or Referee has one of these sets in front of the Head Time Keeper, the static goes off each time the timing machine does. Pass these sets to your distant Stroke and Turns, there they will not pick up the static.

It was also a general feeling of the Facilitators (teaching Referees), that unless you are right over the backstroke its just about impossible to tell if the body is past verticle. They also felt that if you asked the Turn and Stroke which hand touched the wall, that this also might be a clear indication that this person did indeed see the total turn. This weekend, I did the Penn Yale meet. ALL the backstrokers were very rapid rolling twisting turners. All my Officials were Referee level. After the womens meet and prior to the mens meet, the general conversation was on the difficultly of viewing that turn while watching the touch. So don't feel bad, we are all trying our best, which is all we can ask of you.

USS NATIONAL CERTIFICATION FOR OFFICIALS:

The purpose of the USS National Certification Program is to provide an opportunity for qualified officials who cannot attend a National Champion-ship to achieve National certification. The same basic requirements apply to both National Championship and USS National certification but, instead of having to participate at a National Championship, the applicant may officiate at a designated National caliber meet. National caliber means that an appreciable number of the competitors and the conduct and officiating are of such quality as might be expected at a National Championship. National caliber designation may only be made by the Vice-Chairman, USS National Certification Program.

The National Qualifier which will be held at Brown University on January 26-28, 1990 has been designated for the USS National Certification Program. The committee will be Priscilla Davis, James Kresel and John Johanessen. Any New England official who wants to participate must serve in three separate sessions at the level of certification desired. There will be a \$5 fee for a patch and pin if the participant is successful.

GENERAL INFORMATION CONCERNING NEW ENGLAND MEETS:

TYPES OF MEETS:

- A(B)--First consideration is given to swimmers with "A" or better times; swimmers with "B" times may swim if there is room.
- B(A)--First consideration is given to swimmers with "B" times; swimmers with "A" or better times may swim if there is room.
- B(C)-First consideration is given to swimmers with "B" times; swimmers with "C" times or no times may swim if there is room.
- C(B)--First consideration is given to swimmers with "C" times or no times; swimmers with "B" times may swim if there is room.

CUTS: Meets that are over subscribed will be cut as follows:

- A(B)--"B" swimmers are cut by time; if all "B" swimmers have been cut,
 "A" swimmers are cut by time.
- B(A)--"A" swimmers are cut by date of receipt; if all "A" swimmers have been cut, "B" swimmers are cut by date of receipt.
- B(C)--"C" swimmers are cut by date of receipt; if all "C" swimmers have been cut, "B" swimmers are cut by date of receipt.
- C(B)--"B" swimmers are cut by date of receipt; if all "3" swimmers have been cut, "C" swimmers are vut by date of receipt.

Specialty meets--cut by date of receipt.

AWARDS:

- A(B)--Medals will be given to the top 6 (or 8 in the case of an 8-lane pool) swimmers (whether entered with "A" or "B" times). If desired, ribbons may be given to the top 6 (or 8) "B" swimmers who finish with "B" times.
- B(A)--Ribbons will be given to the top 6 (or 8) "B" swimmers achieving "B" times.
- B(C)--Ribbons will be given to the top 6 (or 8) swimmers achieving "B" (whether entered with "B" or "C" times). If desired, ribbons may also be given to the top 6 (or 8) "C" swimmers who finish with "C" times.
- C(B)--Ribbons will be given to the top 6 (or 8) "C" swimmers who finish with "C" times.
- Specialty Meets--Ribbons will be given to the top 6 (or 8) finishers.
- NOTE: Championship and specialty meets may have different awards which will be established at the time the bid is awarded.
- At all meets appropriate achievement cards should be written for swimmers achieving times at a higher level.

SCHEDULES:

- Schedule I -- 13 and over: short events (100's; 200 IM)
 12 and under: long events (100's; 200 IM)
- Schedule II--13 and over: long events (200's; 400 IM)
 12 and under: short events (50's: 100 IM)
- Specialty meets-distance meets, senior development meets, mini meets for younger swimmers, relay carnivals, pentathlons, etc.

ENTRY FERS:

A(B) (or if medals are awarded)--up to \$2.00; \$4.60 per relay.

B(A), B(C), C(B)-up to \$1.50; \$3.60 per relay.

Trials and finals meets-up to \$3.00; \$6.60 per relay.

Specialty meets may charge up to \$1.50 unless permission is given to charge another fee.

NOTE: Championship and specialty meets may have different entry fees which will be established at the time the bid is granted.

SURCHARGES:

A(B)--45¢ per individual event

B(A), B(C), C(B)--30¢ per individual event

Trials and finals meet-45¢ per individual event

NOTE: There is no surcharge for relays.

PRE-SEEDED MEETS are not allowed in New England unless a special request is made at the time the bid is submitted and the special request is granted by the calendar committee.

NOTE: In all cases "A" refers to "A" and better times.

HIGH SCHOOL/OVC RULING:

Official times achieved by United States Swimming members in high school Federation Conference, District, Regional, Sectional, League or State Championship meets during the 1989-90 short course season shall be acceptable for official Verification Certification and USS Times-of-Record consideration provided an assigned certified USS official is present at the meet and can attest to the satisfaction of the Local Swimming Committee's OVC Officer that the individual swim was in fonformance with the applicable USS rules. Compliance with the USS forward start rules and USS meet-approval requirement shall be waived for this competition until the end of the 1989-90 high school swimming season.

If you have a swimmer that you feel will be needing an OVC from a high school league championship meet, sectionals, or states, please see to it that there is a USS official on deck to verify the swim. Have the official sign a statement to the effect that the swim was in accordance with the USS rules. Be sure to include the official's phone number.

At its December board meeting, the New England Swimming Board voted that a coach who is not displaying his/her card and does not comply with the request to disply it will be asked to leave the deck. If the coach does not leave the deck, his/her swimmers will receive administrative DQ's.

Dear Ms. Riddell,

Since the inception of the GAMES in 1982, we had received varying amounts of financial support from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The Commonwealth's contribution to the non-profit Massachusetts Amateur Sports Foundation underwrote as much as 30% of the BAY STATE GAMES in past years. In January of 1989 M.A.S.F. was informed that the state would no longer be able to offer any subsidy to the BAY STATE GAMES.

Fortunately, M.A.S.F. had already developed substantial private sector support. That support kept the GAMES alive for 1989. A great deal of effort has gone into adding to the existing private sector support, with considerable success. However, there is still a significant gap between our financial needs and the existing financial support.

In order to keep the BAY STATE GAMES alive, continue to improve the quality of the experience of participation in the GAMES, and establish a solid base for our future, the 1990 GAMES will see several significant changes. The most apparent will be the reduction in sports from 21 (actually 27 since the entire BAY STATE WINTER GAMES were suspended in 1990) to 13. I am sorry to inform you that one of the sports which has been placed on the inactive list for 1990 is Swimming.

It is never easy to make the sort of decisions we have had to make for 1990. A great deal of thought and soul-searching went into the suspension of Winter Games and the reduction of sports for this summer. Many factors had to be considered. While we believe these decisions will make the future of the GAMES stronger, the negative impact on even one athlete is a considerable price for all of us to pay.

We look forward to a time in the near future, when your sport, and others rendered inactive at the 1990 GAMES will return to a bigger, better and fiscally stronger BAY STATE GAMES.

RE: MEET MARSHALS

Please remember that New England Swimming has adopted the USS warm-up rules for meets. Before warm-ups can begin, enough marshals MUST be in place to assure a safe warm-up. That means there must be marshals at each end of the pool to prevent diving, re-entry at the far end, horseplay, running and/or general rowdiness (not our swimmers-must be visitors!). When sprint lanes are opened, one marshal per starting endoof sprint lane is required. A marshal may be any RESPONSIBLE USS member.

A reminder: If your pool is less than 4 feet deep at one end, the blocks should be at the deep end for safety's sake.

CARDIOFULMONARY RESUSCITATION (CPR)

The minimum acceptable training: American Red Cross "Race for Life"

Any one of the following courses will also satisfy the requirement:

- Infant/Child CPR

- Community CFR, or

- Basic Life Support, or

- CPR, or

- Any CPR Instructor Certificate

American Heart Association

- Adult Heart Saver, or

- Infant/Child Heart Saver, or

- Basic Life Support for the Lay Person (Adult/Infant/Child Heart Saver), or

- Basic Cardiac Life Support (BCIS)

Provider, or

- Any Instructor Rating

SAFETY TRAINING FOR SWIM COACHES (SIMPLIFIED?)

Swim coaches must complete CNE of the following to receive a Safety Training for Swim Coaches certificate:

- 1. The full Safety Training for Swim Coaches course (8 hours).
- 2. The Safety Training for Swim Coaches Progression course (4 hours) is available to those coaches who possess a current Water Safety Enstructor/Instructor Trainer or Lifeguard Instructor/Instructor Trainer certificate.
- 3. Those coaches who successfully complete both Phase I and Phase II of the American Red Cross Aquetic Training Workshope can REQUEST a Safety Training for Swim Coaches certificate from the local Red Cross Chapter. No further course work is needed.

Those wishing to be Instructors must complete ALL of the following:

- 1. Possess a MEN MINITALS Water Safety Instructor/Instructor Trainer or Lifequard Instructor/Instructor Trainer certificate.
- 2. Possess a carrier: Safety Training for Swim Coaches certificate (see above).
- 3. Have a competitive evimming background (this can be determined by the LSC and local ARC).

To renew the Safety Training for Swim Coaches certificate, coaches will be required to complete CNE of the following:

- 1. Coaches who possess a CURRENT certificate can complete a challenge procedure (approximately 1.5 hours). If successful, they will receive a new certificate valid for three years. If unsuccessful, they must complete a review course (4 hours).
- 2. Chaches who DO NOT possess current certification will need to complete:
 - a. The full Safety Training for Swim Coaches course (6 hours).
 - b. The Safety Training for Swim Coaches Progression course (4 hours) is available to those coaches who possess a current Water Safety Instructor/Instructor Trainer or Lifeguard Instructor/Instructor Trainer certificate.

The next meeting of the Board of New England Swimming will be on Monday, April 9 at 7 p.m. at the Wellesley Community Center, Wellesley, MA.

REGISTRATION:

FINALLY! Registration for 1990 is up-to-date. The final mailing of cards for both athletes and non-athletes went out this week. A few non-athletes who wanted to register as coaches did not submit the required certificates for CPR, first aid, and Safety Training for Swim Coaches. As a result; they could register as non-athletes, but they could not register as coaches.

TRANSFERS: Swimmers who transfer from one USS team to another must submit a transfer form to the office. The form must include the date of the last USS sanctioned meet that the swimmer swam in. A swimmer who is transferring from one team to another must swim unattached for 120days from the date of their last USS sanctioned meet. All New England calendar meets are sanctioned as are all dual meets with other USS teams and also some league meets, etc. which involve only USS teams.

RECORDS:

There has been some confusion concerning records. New England Swimming keeps records for 10 and unders, 11 and 12, 13 and 14, and 15 through 18 age groups. There are no records for swimmers over 18 years-old. Although we have been told that open records were once kept, we have no records of any. Anyone in the New England Swimming community who would like to work on assembling open records or who has any old ones is welcome to contact the office.

Records which are set out of district (including USS national meets) must be reported to the records chairman, Anne Hawkins, since New England does not receive the results of meets out of district. All relays also must be reported with the names and ages of the swimmers on the relay team.

Records are established once a year (at the end of the season). Therefore, during the season, there may be many record-breaking swims, but the new record is not established until the new records are announced at the end of the season.

The following is the report of the Technical Committee from its meeting on March 24, 1990 as ratified by the New England Swimming Board at its meetings on April 9 and May 14, 1990.

RELAYS: Relays will be placed at the end of each session for long Course and at the end of each session of trials at Short Course.

SENIORS:

NEW ENGLAND SWIMMERS: Beginning with the next Short Course Seniors, a swimmer must have swum in one New England calendar meet in the preceding 11 months in order to swim in Senior Championships.

BONUS HEAT: The bonus heat will not be used for long course since the 15--18 swimmers will be able to swim at Age Groups.

NUMBER OF EVENTS: The word "enter" will be changed to "swim." A swimmer may enter as many events as he/she has qualified in, plus any "paired" events that the swimmer may wish to swim. If a swimmer enters a paired event, the swimmer must also enter the qualified event. The swimmer must then scratch any excess events (more than 3 individual events in any one day or 9 individual events for the meet) according to the announced process.

SCRATCHES: A swimmer who is entered in an event, does not scratch and does not swim will be out of the rest of the meet, including relays.

RELAY LIMITATIONS: A team may enter relays according to the number of swimmers per sex entered in individual events with a maximum of 4 relays per team. per event. For each sex, the number of qualified individual swimmers entered in individual events will be divided by four up to the 4 relay maximum. A team with 16 or more qualified swimmers of one sex entered in individual events may enter 4 relays; a team with 12 to 15 qualified swimmers of one sex entered in individual events may enter 3 relays; a team with 8 to 11 qualified swimmers of one sex entered in individual events may enter 2 relays; a team with 4 to 7 qualified swimmers of one sex entered in individual events may enter 2 relays. All swimmers on these relays must be qualified swimmers who are entered in one or more individual events.

A team that has only 1, 2, or 3 qualified swimmers per sex entered in individual events may add enough non-qualified swimmers to enter 1 relay per event.

If a qualified swimmer is unable to swim and there is no other qualified swimmer available, the relay must be scratched.

Under no circumstances will a swimmer who is 12 years old or under be allowed to swim in a relay at Seniors unless that swimmer has qualified in an individual event.

No more than two relays per team may score in an event.

AWARDS AT AGE GROUPS AND NEW ENGLAND SENIORS: The large Team and Small Team trophies will be eliminated because of the small number of "large" teams. Instead, eight plaques will be given to the top eight teams (which according to present figures would include several "small" teams). New England Swimming will purchase the plaques.

ENTRY DEADLINES: The entry deadlin for championship meets will be 10 days before the meet and for other meets it will be 14 days before the meet. The only exceptions will be New England calendar meets as determined by the technical committee and/or calendar committee(s).

TIME TRIALS: Standards for time trials will be as follows. All sanctions for Short Course season time trials must be received by the sanction chairman by December 31, and for the Long Course season by June 1. Time Trials must include at least five swimmers from each of at least two teams. The results must be typed, signed by the referee and sent to the New England office within two weeks of the time trial. This will begin with the Short Course 1990—1991 season.

TIMERS: Only "responsible" timers may be used in meets.

POLICY BOOK: A committee of board members and non-board members will be established to produce a policy book before the Annual Meeting in the fall.





UNITED STATES AND NEW ENGLAND SWIMMING LOGOS:

The United States Swimming Logo reproduced on this page is the only one that can be used in New England. You may not use the center part without the circles; only USS can use that logo. USS requires that if two colors are used, they must be blue and red. If only one color is used, it may be: blue, blue, red, white, metallic gold or metallic silver.

The official New England Swimming logo may be used in red, white, or blue or in team colors. All registered New England teams may use the New England logo for their own purposes, including programs, bruchumes, uniforms, ban-ners. They also may use it for items that the team is going to sell such as tee shirts, bumper stickers, etc. Any commercial venture using the New England Swimming logo must be initiated by New England Swimming or one of its member teams for their own specific use of sale. For all other purposes, special permission must be granted by the Board of New England Swimming.

CUTS FOR LONG COURSE AGE GROUPS AND SENIORS. The cuts for long course Age Groups and Seniors will be printed in the June Newletter. The cuts are the same as printed for short course except for the eight and unders. The cuts for long course Age Groups are faster than for Eight and under Championships. Long course Age Groups includes eight and unders and 15 through 18's.

The Insurance Corner

Did you know that...

All incidents involving U.S. Swimming members and/or occurring at a USS function must be reported?

A Report of Occurrence form must be completed and submitted for an incident/claim to be covered by the USS General Liability policy?

U.S. Swimming and its insured members may experience problems when the Report of Occurrence form is not submitted in a timely manner.

General Liability

The U.S. Swimming General Liability Insurance Policy is written on a claims made form. This means that coverage is in effect only for reported incidents. Receipt of the Report of Occurrence form "triggers" coverage. If a report is not filed or is filed late, coverage for the claim may be denied.

It is of vital importance that all incidents, no matter how minor, be reported immediately. Prompt reporting is important for several reasons. First, it is much easier to obtain correct information when witnesses are interviewed immediately after an incident has occurred. As time elapses, the facts and details become more difficult to recall. Oftentimes, witnesses are unable to reconstruct the incident accurately.

Additionally, since the policy is on a "claims made" form, late reporting may result in coverage not being available at all. This may leave the burden of responsibility for any defense costs and/or any liability payments on the local member club or, potentially, the individual USS member involved in the incident.

Secondary Accident

Secondary accident medical insurance is a benefit of U.S. Swimming athlete membership, both year-round and seasonal.

The reimbursement process for medical expenses incurred in a swimming-related incident begins with the Report of Occurrence form. When

the completed report is received by the U.S. Swimming National Headquarters, a cover letter and claim form are sent to the injured party or his family.

Medical expenses incurred and reported during the 12 months following the date of the incident are eligible for reimbursement. Failure or delay in submitting the Report of Occurrence form may result in delayed or denied claims payments.

Reporting Procedures

The Report of Occurrence form should be completed by a USS Member Club representative, preferably the club safety coordinator, coach or administrator. The completed form should be sent to both the U.S. Swimming National Headquarters and Financial Guardian of Arizona office. Each address is listed at the bottom of the form. Except for demographic information, the Report of Occurrence form should not be completed by the injuried person or his parents.

A sample Report of Occurrence form may be found on page 23 of this issue. Forms are also included in the 1990 Insurance Summary, distributed to all 1990 club members.

Complete and submit a Report of Occurrence form on any incident, no matter how minor it may appear at the time. Coverage could be impaired if this report is not received promptly by USS and Financial Guardian.

- C(B)--"B" swimmers are cut by date of receipt; if all "B" swimmers have been cut, "C" swimmers are vut by date of receipt.

Specialty meets-cut by date of receipt.

AWARDS:

- A(B)--Medals will be given to the top 6 (or 8 in the case of an 8-lane pool) swimmers (whether entered with "A" or "B" times). If desired, ribbons may be given to the top 6 (or 8) "B" swimmers who finish with "B" times.
- B(A)—Ribbons will be given to the top 6 (or 8) "B" swimmers achieving "B" times.
- B(C)--Ribbons will be given to the top 6 (or 8) swimmers achieving "B" (whether entered with "B" or "C" times). If desired, ribbons may also be given to the top 6 (or 8) "C" swimmers who finish with "C" times.
- C(B)—Ribbons will be given to the top 6 (or 8) "C" swimmers who finish with "C" times.
- Specialty Meets--Ribbons will be given to the top 6 (or 8) finishers.
- NOTE: Championship and specialty meets may have different awards which will be established at the time the bid is awarded.

At all meets appropriate achievement cards should be written for swimmers achieving times at a higher level.

REIMBURSEMENT POLICY FOR 1990--1991:

A New England registered swimmer who swims an individual event at Junior Nationals will be reimbursed \$150. A New England registered swimmer who swims an individual event at Senior Nationals will be reimbursed \$300. A New England registered swimmer who swims an individual event at the US Open will be reimbursed \$300. A swimmer who places in the top 16 in one or more individual events will receive an additional \$50. A swimmer may be reimbursed for a maximum of three meets and a maximum of \$900 per year.

As in the past, a swimmer must participate in three New England calendar meets during the season in which the championship meet takes place in order to be eligible for reimbursement. The swimmer must request the reimbursement within eight weeks except for those swimming in the US Open.

A swimmer who does not participate in three New England calendar meets during the short course season may request a waiver for a championship meet during that season only if he/she participates in three New England calendar meets during the long course season. A swimmer who does not participate in three New England calendar meets during the long course season may request a waiver for a champion-ship meet during that season only if he/she participates in three New England calendar meets during the short course season.

All requests for waivers will be considered following the long course season.

- 5. At least one USS observer MUST be present on the deck at each end of the pool to verify compliance of the swim with USS Rules.

Liability of Safety Marshals

To avoid any misunderstanding regarding the individual liability of meet marshals, try to relate it to your everyday life.

To be a U.S. Swimming Safety Marshal, acting as an agent for and on behalf of United States Swimming, is no different than the circumstance where you are an employee or agent acting in behalf of your employer within the scope of your duties as such.

If you are negligent in the discharge of your duties as an employee-agent, not only are you individually liable but so also is your employer. Your negligence is imputed to your employer.

But that is what insurance is for. Your employer carries liability insurance to protect him and you, just as United States Swimming carries liability insurance to protect it and you.

Do not let the emphasis on safety (which is nothing more than "risk management") paralyze you in the performance of your duties or interfere with the enjoyable avocation of being an official dedicated to one of the very best of amateur sports - no more than you would seriously think of giving up your job just because of the possibility of being negligent in performing it.

Do what you've always done, but perform it with safety awareness. In other words, just be actively aware of the risks associated with running a swim meet (and there aren't any more now than there always have been), and do not hesitate to do something about those you see.

The elements of tort liability are simple:

1. Duty. We in United States Swimming are obliged to provide as safe an environment for the conduct of our sport as we possibly can.

Example: If you, as safety marshal, see swimmers jumping on top of each other in the warm-up lanes, it is your duty to stop it.

Example: While driving an automobile while your duties as an employee on your employer's business, you have a duty to obey traffic laws.

2. Breach of that duty. If you breach your duty you have taken the second step toward liability.

Example: You ignore the swimmers.

Example: You run a stop sign.

3. Proximate cause. If the fact that you breached your duty results in injuries to another (i.e., it is the "proximate cause" of the injury), then liability for those injuries attach.

Example: A swimmer is injured because another swimmer in the lane(s) for which you are responsible as safety marshal dives on top of him.

Example: Your vehicle rams another in the intersection.

4. Damages. Swimmers may violate the warm-up rules all day, and people may run stop signs all day, and there may be little or no damage to person or property, but whatever it is, you and United States Swimming, or you and your employer, are responsible for it.

Remember that despite all the paper, and all the education, and all the shouting, and all the instruction, there will always be people who disobey the rules, just as there are hundreds of people running stop signs throughout this country as you read this Memorandum.

The law does not require you to do more than a prudent person can do to ensure safety, and if what you've done is reasonable under the circumstances and about as best as can be done - that is as good a defense as any.

As a USS official, acting for and on behalf of United States Swimming, you are fully insured under our current policies on liability and will be fully defended without cost to you.

The next meeting of the Board of New England Swimming will be on Monday, December 10, 1990 at the Wellesley Community Center, Wellesley, MA.

NOTES FROM THE TECHNICAL COMMITTEE:

The Technical Committee met on September 29, 1990. The following recommendations were made by the committee and approved by the Board of New England Swimming at its October meeting.

AGE GROUP CHAMPIONSHIPS: In March of 1992, there will be a 10 and under championship meet for 8 and unders and 9 and 10's. Age Groups will include timed finals for 11 and 12 swimmers and trials and finals for 13 and 14 and 15 and 16 swimmers.

RELAYS AT CHAMPIONSHIPS: Relays at Age Groups will continue to be at the <u>end</u> of the morning session; relays at Seniors will continue to be at the <u>end</u> of the finals (evening) session. The restrictions on relays that were in effect this summer will continue during the short course season.

NATIONAL SWIMMERS: In a effort to give more recognition to our New England Swimmers who qualify for national championships, a special pin is being designed which will be given to all swimmers who swim individual events at Junior Nationals and/or Senior Nationals. In order to encourage unity among the New England Swimmers at Junior Nationals, a block of rooms will be reserved at a hotel near the pool. New England teams who wish to reserve rooms at this hotel may do so. In addition a New England dinner will be organized for all New England Swimmers who wish to attend.

TIME TRIALS/DUAL MEETS: In order to be used to qualify for New Englang championship and classic meets, the following rules must be followed:

All dual meets and time trials (other than regularly scheduled league meets) must be sactioned before December 31. Time trials/dual meets must have a minimum of two teams and at least five swimmers from each team. Results must be typed, signed by the referee and sent to the New England Swimming office.



SUMMER ZONE MEET:

The 1990 Summer Zone Meet in Fairfax, Virginia at the Oak Marr Recreation Center was an enjoyable experience. Sixty-one swimmers from New England entered the meet—54 showed up ready to swim. We had a number of swimmers qualify for finals. This is a national level meet for our younger swimmers. Some of you did very well. This is a sport, and you have to accept what happens and get up again for the next event. In general we were happy with our swimmers, their attitudes and team enthusiasm. Our pink shirts were popular with the other teams. We had many compliments about our uniforms.

Hopefully, if Potomac Valley hosts this again, we will have more interest from older swimmers. The cuts will change as five heats per event is what the zone would like to see. We coaches would like to thank all those who helped time and made the meet run smoothly. A special thanks to Bill Vendt (BGSC), Beth Corwin (PWS) and Moe O'Connell (PVAC) for their extra help.

Insurance Corner

THE INSURANCE CORNER

As a parent, coach or athlete, do I have insurance coverage when I am driving athletes to and from swim practices or meets? What about the athletes themselves? Do they have any coverage?

The answers to these questions depend upon the type of insurance (liability or accident) in question and the specific situation involved.

Liability

The U.S. Swimming Commercial General Liability Policy specifically excludes the ownership or operation of any motorized vehicle from coverage. Therefore, the parent, coach or athlete who is driving athletes on behalf of his USS member club must look to his own auto liability policy for coverage in case of an accident. If the club were sued as a result of an auto accident it, too, would qualify for coverage under the driver's personal auto liability policy.

Clubs can purchase a hired/non-owned auto policy to provide excess limits over those provided by the driver's personal auto liability policy. This is a good idea, especially with the large number of swimmers that USS Member Clubs oftentimes transport.

Secondary Accident Medical

The U.S. Swimming Secondary Accident Medical Policy provides coverage to USS registered athlete members for organized, supervised travel to and from:

- 1.) scheduled, organized practice sessions and/or meets
- 2.) social and fund raising activities approved by United States Swimming, Inc.

To qualify for coverage, the travel must be organized by a USS Member Club Coach or Administrator. This coverage is intended to provide protection for organized club travel, such as to a meet or function. It is not intended to insure incidental travel, such as that which takes place with daily practice sessions and neighborhood car pools.

Covered Travel Situations

Example: A meet is being held in a town 25 miles away. Coach Mike Maxwell appoints Gary Carson, a USS registered athlete, as a designated driver for the meet. Gary runs a red light on the way to the meet, causing injury to himself and his three passengers. Is there insurance?

Liability: No U.S. Swimming coverage. Would have to look to personal auto liability policy.

Accident: Secondary Accident Medical Protection applies. Since Coach Mike designated Gary as the responsible driver, all USS registered athletes are covered by the USS policy.

Example: A meet is being held in a town 25 miles away. Coach Mike Maxwell appoints Carol Carson, a club parent (it doesn't matter is she is a registered member) as a designated driver for the meet. Carol runs a red light on the way to the meet, causing injury to herself and her three passengers. Is there insurance?

Liability: No U.S. Swimming coverage. Would have to look to personal auto liability policy.

Accident: Secondary accident medical coverage applies to the USS registered athletes who are passengers in the car. No U.S. Swimming accident medical insurance for Carol.

Travel Situations Not Covered

Example: Jimmy Thomas lives near Nicole Peters. Both are USS registered athlete members of the USS Sharks Swim Team. Jimmy offers to pick up Jenny and drive her to-practice. Jimmy falls asleep at the wheel and wrecks the car, causing injury to himself and Nicole. Is there insurance?

Liability: No U.S. Swimming coverage. Would have to look to personal auto liability policy.

Accident: No coverage since this was "incidental travel" not supervised or organized by a club coach or administrator.

Example: Jimmy Thomas lives near Nicole Peters. Both are USS registered athlete members of the USS Sharks Swim Team. Jimmy's father offers to pick up Jenny and drive her to practice with son Jimmy. Mr. Thomas fails asleep at the wheel and wrecks the car, causing injury to himself, Jimmy and Nicole. Is there insurance?

Liability: No U.S. Swimming coverage. Would have to look to personal auto liability policy.

Accident: No coverage since this was "incidental travel" not supervised or organized by a club coach or administrator.

Important Notes

There are a few significant points to note in closing.

- 1.) It is vital that clubs designate those drivers who are acting on behalf of the club in an organized, supervised situation.
- 2.) The club should assign only mature, responsible drivers.
- Before travel commences, the club should ensure that all drivers have valid driver's licenses and current insurance coverage for their autos.

POOL DEPTH FOR USS SWIM MEETS:

United States Swimming requires that all competition it sanctions be conducted in pools that meet a four-foot requirement at the starting end. However, US Swimming rules state the local swimming committees may waive compliance with this rule in sanctioning local competitions. At its November meeting, the Board of New England Swimming agreed that they have no intent to grant waivers after 1992. Please note that the bid form now requests information about the depth of pools and this information must be printed in the meet information that is sent to teams.

TOP TEN BANQUET:

The Top Ten Banquet held on October 28 at the Windsor Mills Restaurant was well attended by nearly 540 swimmers, parents, siblings and coaches. The speaker this year was Tom Jager, world record holder in the 50 meter free-style who gave an excellent talk to the group and signed many autographs. Pease help New England Swimming make our NAG Top 15 reporting as complete and accurate as possible. The following are some practical suggestions on how you and your team can assist us.

- * In this issue are the new 1990-1991 Short Course NAG Top 16 cuts.
 1990-1991 Long Course NAG Top 16 cuts will be published when available.
 These cuts are somewhat faster than AAAA times. If you have a swimmer in the AAAA category, be sure to check for Top 16 cuts. Relay cuts are not impossibly fast. If you know that your club has one or more fast relays get familiar with the cuts so that you can report them.
- * On the back page of this issue is a form for reporting NAG Top 16 Times and New England records. Please use it! We'd rather receive duplicate forms than accidently omit a time.
- * Report all relays. Be sure to include the names, ages, and USS Swimming numbers for all relay swimmers. (Relays are easy for us to miss!)
- * Send results of all out-of-district meets to the New England Swimming Office. Records and NAG reportable times must be verified before we can submit them. Don't count on another club to send results. Again, duplication is preferable to omission.
- * ELECTRONICALLY TIMED lead off splits (relay or individual event) CAN BE USED FOR RECORDS AND NAG TOP 16 REPORTABLES. If the splits are not going to be printed in the results, get a card signed by the meet referee. Send the card and reportable form to us. (We'll never find and report these splits unless you tell us about them!)

SEED CARDS: Seed Cards are available through the New England Office. The cost for plain cards is \$20.50 per thousand, including mailing. If the cards are picked up in Needham, the cost is \$18.00 per thousand. There is no minimum, and the cards may be split any way between boys and girls.
