

VERIFICATION PACKETS must be turned into the verification table at ten & under championships, Age Groups and Seniors. At the classic meets, verification must be included on the entry and coaches must be prepared with results of non New England meets, but packets do not have to be turned in. For complete verification information, see the sheet included with the meet entries.

PINS will be available at the verification table for all participants (including relay swimmers) at Ten and under championships, Age Group Championships, and Seniors. Please remind your swimmers to pick up their pins.



ZONE TEAM: The Zone Meet will be April 2,3,4, 1992 at Princeton University, NJ (plus two travel days). The coaches will be Isabelle Fraser (PVAC), Jim McCombs (MSSC), and two additional coaches to be selected according to coach interest and the clubs represented by team members. Coaches who are interested in the team should contact Isabelle Fraser (413) 567-3415.

Swimmers who are interested in the team must participate in three New England calendar meets. Nine and ten swimmers will be selected at the Ten and under Championship meet; 11 and 12 and 13 and 14 will be selected at Age Group Championships; 15 through 18 will be selected by application.

VERIFICATION AT CHAMPIONSHIP MEETS AND "CLASSIC" MEETS:

A third line has been included on the championship and "classic" meet entry forms which allows room for a verification code. Codes for New England meets have been included and the results of these meets will be available at each championship meet. For all other mees you must include your own code and also bring the results of the meet with you. Be sure to label the results with the code placed on the verification sheet.

At the CLASSIC meets, coaches should be able to produce verification and non-New England meet results is asked. Verification packets DO NOT have to be turned in.

At the CHAMPIONSHIP meets, a packet which includes the verification information and the results of all non-New England calendar meets used for verification must be brought to the verification desk prior to the start of the first event of the meet. Each packet whould be labeled with the name of the team and should be picked up at the end of the meet. The packet should not be included with the entry form submitted to the host team, but a copy of the entry with the verification reformation must be in the verification packet. The packet should include only non-New England calendar meets that are used for verification.

Verification will be checked for each swimmer who does not make the cut in an event or who scratches (at Seniors), false starts, or disqualifies. If the verification for these swimmers has not been included or cannot be checked, the swimmers will receive an administrative DO and will not be able to swim any more in the meet. At Seniors, the verification for a paired event will be the event in which the time standard has been achieved.

The Insurance Corner

Membership and Insurance - The Link

"Can we register as a U.S. Swimming Club Member if only a portion of our athletes are members of U.S. Swimming? Do we have insurance coverage in this situation?"

U.S. Swimming Rules and Regulations deals with membership requirements in several places. Article 501.2 defines the members of the Corporation as follows:

501.2. Every club which participates in USS competition, and all its athletes and coaches, sanctioned by the Corporation must be a member of its LSC and the Corporation. (Italics added for emphasis.)

Article 602.1.1A defines one type of group members within the Local Swimming Committee:

602.1.1A Clubs which have joined and are in good standing as members of the LSC and United States Swimming, have athletes and coaches, all of whom are members in good standing of the LSC and United States Swimming, and whose coaches have all satisfactorily completed safety training required by United States Swimming, (Italics added for emphasis.)

But what about the situation where only a <u>segment</u> of a club is interested in U.S. Swimming membership and competition? Is this allowed within the USS rules?

Yes, but the club that only registers some of its swimmers must be warned at once that it is jeopardizing its insurance coverage. Non-member athlete participation is an insured activity only for "tryouts" under certain time and supervisory conditions. If a non-member athlete were injured, he would not be entitled to accident medical coverage. As for the club, in all likelihood the insurance company would immediately send a reservation-of-rights notice (providing legal defense but reserving the right to deny coverage for any judgement).

What about the situation where, because of duplicate coverage, he club does not care about U.S. Swimming insurance protection? Perhaps the club and its athletes are already usured by a YMCA or municipality.

As a general rule of thumb: "When participating in an 'insured activity', a club must meet the definition of a USS Member Club for insurance purposes." Let's look at an example involving a dual YMCA-USS club member.

- 1. When the YMCA team as a USS Club swims in a USS sanctioned meet, where all swimmers and all coaches must be USS members to even have the right to participate at all, insurance coverage follows. The YMCA may have 100 swimmers, but when it goes to a USS sanctioned event with 75 of its swimmers, all coaches and all 75 swimmers are, and must be, USS members. The 25 left at home would not be subjecting themselves or others to insured injury.
- When swimming as a YMCA Team in YMCA competition, there is no USS insurance coverage unless it is an approved meet, all team members are USS members, all team coaches are USS members, and it can be said to be an organized practice. Even then, USS insurance is secondary.
- 3. When the YMCA Team is practicing in the YMCA pool, USS insurance is not the primary coverage; YMCA insurance is. USS insurance coverage may be the secondary coverage if every swimmer practicing is a USS member, but, if not, then only under a reservation-of-rights if at all. And when practicing elsewhere, USS insurance demands that all coaches and all practicing swimmers be USS members. To hold otherwise would mean that an insurance carrier is expected to provide coverage when only a partial premium has been paid.

USS, U.S. Masters Get Together

Many U.S. Swimming and U.S. Masters Swimming clubs cooperate closely to run meets, share practice time and coordinate fund raisers at the local level. Since the two organizations are separate, however, this relationship can result in questions about membership and insurance issues.

During its semi-annual meeting in January, 1991 the U.S. Sports Insurance Company board of directors considered several questions that have been raised by members of both organizations. They made the following recommendations which were then adopted by the U.S. Swimming Board of Directors.

1.) Question: Can a U.S. Masters Swimming member train with a U.S. Swimming club without purchasing a separate U.S. Swimming athlete membership?

Answer: Yes, a USMS athlete can train with a USS club without purchasing a separate USS athlete membership. If he were injured during the workout, the USMS secondary accident medical insurance would respond.

If the USMS athlete wants to compete in a U.S. Swimming-sanctioned meet, he must first join U.S. Swimming as an athlete member,

2.) Question: Is a USS official covered by liability insurance when he works at a U.S. Masters Swimming meet?

Answer: Yes, U.S. Masters provides liability insurance on a primary basis to cover USS officials who work at USMS meets. The limits of coverage are \$1 million per occurrence, \$2 million in total.

3.) Question: Can a U.S. Masters Swimming member officiate at a U.S. Swimming meet without having to purchase a separate USS non-athlete membership?

Answer: Yes, but only in those positions where USS membership is not required. U.S. Swimming Rules and Regulations Article 202.3.2 states, "All meet directors, referees, starters, marshals, and stroke and turn judges, serving in an official capacity in a sanctioned event, must be members of United States Swimming, Inc...." Therefore, USMS members can serve only in administrative or timing capacities. Meets always need help in these vital areas, however!

Hopefully this information will help to foster the cooperative relationship between U.S. Swimming and U.S. Masters Swimming clubs across the country. Questions about this information should be directed to either organizations' national headquarters.

SEED CARDS: Seed Cards are available through the New England Office. The cost for plain cards is \$22 per thousand, including mailing. If the cards are picked up in Needham, the cost is \$19 per thousand. There is no minimum, and the cards may be split any way between boys and girls.

If you want initials on the cards, the price for 1,000 cards is \$31, including mailing. If the cards are picked up in Needham, the cost is \$28. If you want 2,000 or more cards with initials, the cost is \$26 per thousand, including mailing, or \$23 per thousand if the cards are picked up in Needham. The minimum order for cards with initials is 1,000 cards.

COACH REGISTRATION:

Please remember that a coach must hold current First Aid, CPR and Safety Training for Swim Coaches in order to register as a coach. A few registration applications for coaches were received without copies of the proper certifications. These individuals have received "non-athlete" cards. When the office receives copies of the appropriate certifications, the registration will be updated to "coach" and a "coach" card will be issued.

IN ORDER TO COACH ON DECK AT A NEW ENGLAND MEET, AN ADULT MUST DISPLAY A "COACH CARD"!!!

A REMINDER: Many coaches have Safety Training for Swim Coach cards which expire before January 1, 1993. A coach who has a current card may update via a four-hour course. However, once the card has expired, the coach must retake the entire eight-hour course. We urge coaches to consider the update which will be offered at Wellesley College on April 11. (See application in this newsletter.) There is no penalty for renewing early!!!!

The Insurance Corner

Insurance Issues in the News

The following is a potpourri of questions and situations that | 3. Supervision came up throughout 1991.

1. Automobile liability coverage

Does a USS club have coverage under the USS program?

No. If a parent or coach uses their car to transport athletes or other club members to a practice or meet, the club has coverage under the car owner's policy. This is also true when the club rents a vehicle. Whomever signs for the rental vehicle is the individual whose insurance would respond for the club if an accident occurred and people in the vehicle were injured.

In the first example, the parent's or coach's insurance is the primary coverage. In the second example, the rental agency's insurance would be the primary coverage with the parent's/coach's insurance coming in to play on an excess basis.

Suggestion: Contact a local agent regarding the purchase of "Hired and Non-Owned Automobile Liability Insurance" for your club.

2. Starting block

Does a USS club have liability coverage if they design and build their own starting blocks or make changes to existing blocks?

Yes. The club may build or alter starting blocks to suit their needs. The blocks must comply with standards as stated in U.S. Swimming Rules and Regulations (Article 103.11). The club is not covered for alterations performed on blocks for other clubs or facilities.

What level of supervision is required for the liability insurance to apply in the event of a claim?

There must be direct supervision for in water or out of water activities for coverage to be in place. Direct supervision has been defined as meaning "line of sight" between the supervising coach and the athletes involved in the activities.

Note: Coverage for out of water activities is limited to \$100,000 each occurrence/\$100,000 in the aggregate.

4. Denial of membership

Is there any liability coverage if a club denies membership to an individual and a claim results for the denial?

No. Basically, the only legitimate reason for membership denial is lack of pool space or time. Any other reason could be considered discriminatory. Claims arising out of hamiliation, discrimination, harassment, or defamation are specifically excluded under the general liability policy.





REIMBURSEMENT POLICY FOR 1992-1993;

At the September meeting of the New England Board, the following reimbursement policy for 1992--1993 was adopted. The oolicy is the same as this past year with the addition of the underlined section.

A New England registered swimmer who swims in an individual event at Junior Nationals will be reimbursed \$150 by New England Swimming. A New England registered swimmer who swims in an individual event at Senior Nationals will be reimbursed \$300 by New England Swimming. A New England registered swimmer who swims in an individual event at the US Open will be reimbursed \$300 by New England Swimming. A swimmer who places in the top 16 in one or more individual event will receive an additional \$50. There will be no limit wither for the number of meets or the amount of money to be reimbursed to a swimmer.

During the short course season a swimmer must participate in three New England calendar meets to be eligible for reimbursement. During the long course season a swimmer must participate in two New England calendar meets to be eligible for reimbursement. A swimmer must request the reimbursement within eight weeks except for those swimming in the US Open.

To be eligible for reimbursement an athlete must have been registered in New England and have competed in a New England calendar meet at least six months prior to the meet for which reimbursement has been requested.

A swimmer who does not participate in three New England calendar meets during the short course season may request a waiver for a championship meet during that season only if he/she participates in three New England calendar meets during the long course season. A swimmer who does not participate in two New England meets during the long course season may request a waiver for a championship meet during that season only if he/she participates in three New England calendar meets during the short course season. All requests for waivers will be considered following the long course season.

IMPORTANT -- The meet scheduled for October 24 at Clark University has been cancelled.

Enough lead time must be given and please manage to have at least 5 or 6 people interested in participating. Those wishing to be certified must become members of NE Swimming.

This year I am pleased to report there are no rule changes. Therefore we need to focus on better understanding established rules, further improve skills and have a consistent backstroke turn interpretation. The most common comment I receive concerns different interpretations used in officiating the backstroke turn.

The best advice I can pass on is "do not over-officiate the turn." Be aware and call (DQ) gross or flagrant violations, but "let the swimmers swim." I am aware that US Swimming needs to address the subject of suppling an updated video, but until then all LSC's are in the same position. Suggestions have been made that our own LSC create a video, but as of now nothing is in the works. Until then let's remember we are there for the kids.
