**CHARLES D. HINCE BENEFIT FOR RECOVERY TRUST FUND**

The following information was submitted to the Newsletter Plus by Steve Ostapower, coach, Ocean State Squids.

On August 31, Charley Hince, while body surfing in the waters of Martha's Vineyard, was tumbled by a wave and broke his neck. Charley, a member of the New England Swimming community for many years, had recently completed his college swimming career upon graduating from Providence College. Charley was fortunate to survive this terrible accident but now faces a challenging future as a quadriplegic. While some of Charley's expenses will be covered by insurance, most will not. A trust fund has been established to help Charley and his family members with expenses necessary to help with his recovery and rehabilitation. Charley is in good spirits and is approaching these challenges with the same enthusiasm and focus that he used throughout his competitive swimming career. 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**NEW ENGLAND SWIMMING SHORT COURSE SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS:**

At its meeting on January 14, 1997, the Board of New England Swimming voted to accept a proposal from Connecticut Swimming to run a joint New England and Connecticut Senior Championship on March 6--9, 1997 at **WESLEYAN UNIVERSITY, MIDDLETOWN, CT.**

The meet will be closed with only New England and Connecticut registered swimmers allowed to attend. It will be a trials and finals meet with trials swum in two six-lane courses in the morning. In the evening, there will be three heats of each event swim in a nine-lane course (with scoring to 18).

New England Swimming will use its time standards which will include bonus events as run last year (with the same bonus time standards). Connecticut Swimming will use its time standards.

The order of events will be basically the order of events used in Senior Championships by New England Swimming, although the position of the two distance events has not yet been decided. There will be two additional relays, the 200 free relay and the 200 medley relay, which will be swum as "demonstration" (non-scoring) events.

New England Swimming is pleased to be able to offer this opportunity to its senior swimmers--a chance to offer more quality competition to the senior experience and a chance to offer our swimmers access to a quality pool.

**WORKERS** at the Senior Championships: New England Swimming will be required to provide its "fair share" of workers at the meet at Wesleyan University. This will include officials, timers, runners, office workers, etc. **ALL TEAMS WILL BE ASSIGNED WORKERS AND WILL BE EXPECTED TO FULFILL ALL THEIR WORK ASSIGNMENTS.** Teams that travel by van or bus must still have enough adults available to work the meet. "Responsible swimmers" will be able to do some of the timing (but not all). If New England had run its own meet, which it had planned to do, there would have been the same type of work assignments made.

**VOLUNTEERS NEEDED:** Volunteers are needed in several capacities for New England Swimming. If you are interested or have any questions, please contact the person(s) listed.

1. **TOP TEN COMMITTEE:** The Committee needs one or more persons to compile Top Ten Times. Results will be supplied; a computer may be used, but is not necessary. Contact the New England Office--617-449-0270.
2. **OVC'S:** One or two people are needed to write OVC's (official verification cards) for swimmers who have qualified for national meets. Most of the OVC's are written at championship meets. For more information, contact Carol Mitchell-- 617-665-7439.

A swimmer who has qualified for Senior Championships in one (1) event may swim one (1) bonus event. A swimmer who has qualified for the meet in two (2) events may swim two (2) bonus events. A swimmer who has qualified for the meet in three (3) or more events may swim three (3) bonus events. A swimmer must have swum these events during the qualifying period and must have met the Bonus Time for the event. No swimmer may enter more than three bonus events.

**ANNUAL MEETING:**

According to our new by-laws, approved at the October Annual Meeting, our Annual Meeting will now be held in May. The tentative date is May 3, 1997 and the tentative location is Wellesley, MA.

We will be holding a General Meeting with the election of new Board Members, a Meet Manager's Meeting, an Officials Meeting, and a Coaches Meeting. Board offices which will be elected include: General Chairman, Administrative Vice-chairman, Finance Vice-chairman, Senior Vice-chairman, Age Group Vice-chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, Technical Planning Chairman.

**DISTRICTS: INCENTIVE CUTS FOR AGE GROUP CHAMPIONS:**

Events 200 yards and shorter: In each district, the two swimmers who achieve the two fastest times which are **NOT** Age Group Championship qualifying times, will be eligible to enter that event at Age Group championships with their District Championship time.

Events 400 yards and longer: In each district, the one swimmer who achieves the fastest time which is **NOT** an Age Group Championship qualifying time, will be eligible to enter that event at Age Group Championships with his/her District Championship time.

15 to 18 events only: In each of these events, the top two (for events 200 yards and shorter) or one (for events 400 yards and longer) 15- and 16-year old swimmers' times which are **NOT** Age Group Championship qualifying times, will be eligible to enter that event at Age Group Championships with their District Championship time.

NOTE: These times at Age Group Championships will be seeded after all the qualified yard and meter times.

**NOTES CONCERNING "END OF SEASON" MEETS:**

**ELIGIBILITY: SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS:** New England Swimmers must have participated in at least one New England calendar meet in the past 11 months.

**ALL OTHER MEETS:** There is no "meet attendance" requirement except for:

**SWIMMERS ON THE ZONE TEAM and SWIMMERS DESIRING REIMBURSEMENT FROM NEW ENGLAND SWIMMING FOR NATIONAL MEETS:** These swimmers must attend three New England calendar meets during the short course season.

**TIMES:** All swimmers entering New England's "end of season" meets must enter with a time achieved at a meet. The meet may be a New England calendar meet but it also may be a league meet, "Y" meet, recreation team meet, high school meet, etc. **if you have a copy of the results.** These results must be brought to the meet with you.

Note that this year times for Ten and under, Age Group and Senior Championships may date from **March 1, 1996.** Times for Bronze Classic and District Championships must still date from September 1, 1996.

**TIMERS:** In order to make our "end of the season" meets run smoothly for the swimmers, New England Swimming allows the teams running the meets to assign timers for the teams attending the meets. **THESE TIMING ASSIGNMENTS ARE MANDATORY!** Teams may not ignore these assignments. Note that for the Senior Championship there will be timers and other workers assigned to each team.

## **ANNUAL MEETING:**

Under our new by-laws, the Annual Meeting is now held in May (rather than in the fall). The meeting will be on Saturday, May 3, 1997 at the Wellesley Community Center, Wellesley, MA.

There will be a General Meeting with the election of new Board Members, a Meet Manager's Meeting, an Officials' Meeting (with updates for Stroke and Turn officials and Starters), a Coaches Meeting and an Athletes Meeting.

Board offices to be elected include:

One-year terms: General Chairman, Administrative Vice Chairman, Secretary, Finance Vice Chairman, Senior Vice Chairman

Two-year terms: Age Group Vice Chairman, Treasurer, Technical Planning Chairman

The coaches will elect their own representative and the board will appoint a new athlete representative.

The Board of New England Swimming is not scheduled to meet in March.

**CHAMPIONSHIP MEET INFORMATION:**

**AGE GROUP CHAMPIONSHIPS:** Harvard University, Cambridge, MA  
March 13--16, 1997

**CONSOLATION FINALS:** At the February 11, 1997 meeting of the Board of New England Swimming, the Board voted to accept the recommendation of the Technical Committee that the 11 & 12 and 13 & 14 age groups swim both consolation and final heats at night. The 15 & 16 age group will only swim finals at night.

**NEW ENGLAND/CONNECTICUT SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS:** Wesleyan University, Middletown, CT  
March 6--9, 1997

Because of the nature of a joint meet, there are several differences that you will note in this year's Senior meet. Here are some of the differences:

**RELAYS:** There will be two additional relays, 200 free relay and 200 medley relay, both non-scoring. For all relays, the fastest heat will be swum at night.

**AWARDS:** There will be an outstanding swim award for both men and women.

**SCRATCHES:** Swimmers who do not scratch for evening events will out of the rest of the meet and will be fined \$30. Scratches for the trials sessions must be turned in by 8 am for each day's events except all scratches for the 1650 (to be swum on Sunday) must be turned in SATURDAY EVENING.

**WORK ASSIGNMENTS:** Teams must supply the name of a worker's liason for each session. Teams that do not provide their workers as assigned will be fined \$50 per worker. (The fine for workers who leave the session early will be \$30 per worker.) Work assignments will be sent to each team contact. Officials will be included in the team work assignment if they sent in the "Officials' Nomination Form" with their entry.

**COACHES:** Coaches are required to display their credentials from a shirt or pants pocket in order to be allowed on deck.

**INFORMATION FROM REID CHRISTEN, SENIOR COACH REPRESENTATIVE**

**VOTING FOR AGE GROUP COACH OF THE YEAR:** Ballots will be distributed at Age Groups. Call the New England Office if you need a ballot.

**Criteria:** The coach should be primarily a coach of age group swimmers (12 and under) and make contributions to age group swimming of the LSC (Local Swimming Committee) level. The coach does not have to be an ASCA member.

**NEW JUNIOR COACH REPRESENTATIVE:** Reid Christen will be finishing his term as Senior Coach Representative at the Annual Meeting on May 3. Leslie Cooper will be the new Senior Coach Representative, and we need to vote on a new Junior Coach Representative. Nominations are now being accepted and voting will take place at the Annual Meeting (to be held on Saturday, May 3, 1997). Nominations should be submitted to Mary Riddell by April 1, 1997. Mail-in ballots will be available April 15 for coaches who will be unable to attend the Annual Meeting.

**BYLAW CHANGES:** New England Swimming has a new set of bylaws which limit the number of voting board members to no more than three voting board members per team. Although this limitation does not include the athlete representatives, it does include coach representatives.

Some tentative agenda items are: election of coaches' representative, coaches' budget discussion and approval, coaches' clinic plans, issues from the Annual Meeting, ethics policy, championship meet schedule and meet formats. Bids for all meets for the 1997--1998 short course calendar are due by July 1, 1997. Bids for all meets for the 1998 long course calendar are due September 1, 1997. A bid must be in proper form (complete meet information package) or it will not be considered. An untimely (late) bid will be considered only if teams hosting meets on the same weekend consent or the calendar committee finds that the late bid meet will not adversely affect a timely bid meet. **The sanction fee will be increased to \$40 per day for any late bid meet.**

The Calendar Committee will review all timely submitted bids and attempt to award meets consistent with each team's preferred date. In the event any particular weekend is oversubscribed, the Calendar Committee will attempt to move one or more meets from an oversubscribed weekend to a less subscribed weekend in the best interests of the New England Swimming community. The final decision with respect to any bid rests with the Calendar Committee.

The Calendar Committee and the New England Swimming Board, in the best interests of New England Swimming, may waive any of its policies with respect to securing bids for championship meets. The New England Swimming Board will consider a subsidy (up to four per season) of \$250 to a team which hosts a distance meet open to all New England teams as a calendar meet. A distance meet is a meet which offers the 1650/1500 or the 1000/800 which may be combined with a 400/500 freestyle or a 400 IM. A distance meet run by a team in conjunction with an existing meet (i.e. on the same weekend) is not eligible for subsidy.

## "TIE-BREAKER" FOR PLAQUES AT CHAMPIONSHIPS:

At the last meeting of the Board of New England Swimming, it was decided to establish a "tie-breaker" for plaques at New England Championships. This way every swimmer will be able to take home a plaque. The newsletter will acknowledge the tie, and a new plate for the plaque will be sent to the swimmer some time after the last championship.

When there is a tie, the number of first places will be compared.; If neither swimmer has a first place or they both have the same number, the number of second places will be compared and so on. This will determine who will take home which plaque.

**LONG COURSE BIDS** are due August 1, 1997.; Bids that are received on time will have priority over bids that are received late. Meets that are bid after the deadline will be subject to a \$40 per day sanction fee rather than the usual \$15 per day fee.

OFFICIAL VERIFICATION OF HIGH SCHOOL TIMES

Official times achieved by USS registered athletes at High School swim meets will be acceptable for Official Verification (OVC) consideration only if all the following conditions are met:

1. The meet must be of championship caliber between three (3) or more school teams; i.e. League, Conference, Sectional or State Championship.
2. There must be automatic timing with a backup system in use at the meet.
3. There must be two (2) USS observers present on deck, one at each end of the pool to verify compliance of the swim with USS rules. Arrangements for the USS observers must be made by the swimmer or their High School Coach. They must be USS certified stroke and turn judges.
4. Notification of this OVC request should be made to the LSC Chairman or OVC Chairman at least two (2) weeks prior to the swim. At this time a form can be obtained from the NE office to be signed by the observers at the time of the swim.

If you want initials on the cards, the price for 1,000 cards is \$31, including mailing. If the cards are picked up in Needham, the cost is \$28. If you want 2,000 or more cards with initials, the cost is \$26 per thousand, including mailing, or \$23 per thousand if the cards are picked up in Needham. The minimum order for cards with initials is 1,000 cards.

## TOP TEN BANQUET

**TOP TEN BANQUET:** The Top Ten Banquet will be held on Sunday, October 26, 1997 at The Mill House, 810 Merrimack Avenue (Route 110), Dracut, MA. From Route 93 take exit 46, Route 110 Dracut-Lowell. The restaurant is 3.5 miles on the right with the banquet entrance in the rear.

**TOP TEN:** Please share the Top Ten information in this newsletter with your team as soon as possible. Encourage your team members to make reservations as soon as possible. In the past we have filled up before the deadline.

Top Ten Times are compiled using results from New England meets held during the past year. Short course (25 yard) times run from June 1, 1996 through May 31, 1997; long course (50 meter) times run from October 1, 1996 through September 30, 1997.

In addition to New England sanctioned calendar meets, we also use times from out of district sanctioned meets if the results are sent to the office and if the meet is open to all USS swimmers. We consider all times from the meet--trials, finals, and swim-offs--but we do not use time trials. We also consider lead-off splits from individual events and relays when they are printed in the results.

We do not include meets that are closed--restricted to certain teams, league members, etc. For this reason, we do not consider high school meets, "Y" meets, etc.

**OUTSTANDING SWIMMERS** are those who have accumulated the most points through their top ten standings. The scoring is as follows:

#### REGISTRATION:

In August the office sent each New England team a letter and a form which asked for the team's official address for the fall and also asked for the team's registration chairman for 1998.

Most teams have returned the form. The team's address label has been updated (if necessary), and the registration chairman has received the team computer print-out and other registration materials.

If your team has not returned the form (a lovely "dove gray" color), please do so immediately. If you cannot locate the form, please call the office for a second mailing.

**REIMBURSEMENT POLICY, 1997—1998:**

A New England registered swimmer who swims in an individual event at Junior Championships will be reimbursed \$150 by New England Swimming. A New England registered swimmer who swims in an individual event at the US Open will be reimbursed \$150 by New England Swimming. A New England registered swimmer who swims in an individual event at National Championships will be reimbursed \$300 by New England Swimming. A New England registered swimmer who swims in an individual event at the Olympic Trials will be reimbursed \$300 by New England Swimming. There will be no limit either for the number of meets or the amount of money to be reimbursed to a swimmer.

During the short course season a swimmer must fully participate in three New England calendar meets to be eligible for reimbursement. During the long course season a swimmer must fully participate in two New England calendar meets to be eligible for reimbursement. "Full participation" means participation in all or at least two days of competition and at least one event at each day of participation.

If the New England Senior Championships is in place with a named facility by a certain date (90 days preceding the first day of the meet for long course; 120 days preceding the first day of the meet for short course), mandatory participation in the Senior meet is required in order for a swimmer to receive reimbursement. The New England Board may waive this requirement for good cause, such as illness or conflict with a National Team requirement.

A swimmer must request the reimbursement within eight weeks of the meet. The request must include the stub from the swimmer's plane ticket or receipt of other expense to equal or exceed the amount of requested reimbursement.

To be eligible for reimbursement, an athlete must have been registered in New England and have competed in a New England calendar meet at least six months prior to the meet for which reimbursement has been requested.

A swimmer who does not participate in three New England calendar meets during short course season may request a waiver for a championship meet during that season only if he/she participates in three New England calendar meets during the long course season. A swimmer who does not participate in two New England calendar meets during the long course season may request a waiver for a championship meet during the short course season. All requests for waivers will be considered following the long course season.
