INFORMATION FROM USA SWIMMING:

Please note that this issue of Newsletter Plus contains several pieces of information from USA Swimming:

- 1. The new United States Swimming Code of Conduct which was approved at convention this past September.
- 2. A new policy from USA Swimming which allows waivers for certain coaches who have disabilities.
- 3. The USA Swimming "Report of Occurrence" which should be filed following any accident in the swimming venue.

COACH REGISTRATION:

Coach registration this year has raised a few questions. In order to be registered as a coach, the application must be accompanied by copies of current CPR, First Aid, and Safety Training for Swim Coaches. Each team's registration packet included a sheet which listed the various courses which qualify for the requirement.

A few things to note: Effective January 1,11998, the American Red Cross instructor certificates were taken off the approved list. Based on a recommendation from the American Red Cross, these were removed because yearly certification in CPR and First Aid are not required for ARC instructors. If ARC instructors do not hold a current certification in the appropriate course, they can take a Review Challenge (30 minutes) to obtain a current certification. This change was announced in the December 1997 Newsletter Plus.

Some coaches are submitted the new American Red Cross Sport Safety Training course in place of Safety Training for Swim Coaches. This course will fulfill United States Swimming requirements for CPR and First Aid, but it does not replace Safety Training for Swim Coaches. This information was in both the February 1998 and June 1998 copies of Newsletter Plus.

MORE INFORMATION CONCERNING "END OF SEASON" MEETS:

TEAM HIGH POINT AWARDS: Team High Point Plaques for places 1 through 8 will be presented at Eight & under Champships, Twelve & under Championships, and Thirteen & over Championships. In addition, at the Twelve & under Championships, a combined team championship award will be presented to places 1 through 3 for total combined score for all three Age Group Championship meets (Eight & under, Twelve & under, and Thirteen & over).

TWELVE & UNDER CHAMPIONSHIPS: Ages for the Twelve & under Championships will be established as of the first day of the original date for the meet—February 19. Swimmers who age from 12 to 13 or from 10 to 11 between February 19 and March 5 may swim in the Twelve and under Championships at their previous age. However, times achieved by these swimmers will not be eligible for USA or NE records or for USA Top 16 or NE Top 10.

INCENTIVE CUTS: There will be no incentive cuts at Age Groups this year.

ELIGIBILITY: SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS: New England Swimmers must have participated in at least one New England calendar meet in the past 11 months.

ALL OTHER MEETS: There is no "meet attendance" requirement except for:

SWIMMERS ON THE ZONE TEAM and SWIMMERS DESIRING REIMBURSEMENT FROM NEW ENGLAND SWIMMER FOR NATIONAL MEETS: These swimmers must attend three New England Calendar meets during the short course season.

TIMES: All swimmers entering New England's "end of season" meets must enter with a time achieved at a meet. The meet may be a New England calendar meet, but it also may be a league meet, high school meet, etc. if you have a copy of the results. These results must be brought to the meet with you.

Times for 8 & under, 12 & under, and 13 & over Championships may date from February 27, 1998; times for Districts and Bronze must date from September 1, 1998; times for Senior Championships may date from February 27, 1998.

TIMERS and OTHER WORKERS: In order to make our "end of season" meets run smoothly for the swimmers, New England Swimming allows the teams running the meets to assign timers from the teams attending the meets. THESE TIMING ASSIGNMENTS ARE MANDATORY AND MAY NOT BE IGNORED. For Senior Championships, run by New England, other workers will also be assigned to each team.

United States Swimming CODE OF CONDUCT

305.1. The mission of USA Swimming is to encourage participation and the pursuit of excellence in all aspects of swimming. USA Swimming grants the privilege of membership to individuals and organizations committed to that mission. The privilege of membership may, therefore, be withdrawn or denied by USA Swimming at any time where USA Swimming determines that a member or prospective member's conduct is inconsistent with the mission of the organization or the best interest of the sport and those who participate in it.

In order to assist all members to better serve the interests of those who participate in swimming, USA Swimming has adopted this Code of Conduct.

- 305.2. Any member or prospective member of USA Swimming may be denied membership, censured, placed on probation, suspended for a definite or indefinite period of time with or without terms of probation, fined or expelled from USA Swimming if such member violates the provisions of the USA Swimming Code of Conduct, Set forth in 305.3, or aids, abets or encourages another person to violate any of the provisions of the USA Swimming Code of Conduct.
- 305.3. The following shall be considered violations of the USA Swimming Code of Conduct:
- .1 Violation of the right to compete provisions set forth in Sections 301.1 through 301.4.
- .2 Violation of the anti-doping provisions set forth in Sections 304.4 or 304.5.
- Discrimination in violation of Part Five of the USA Swimming Corporate Code of Regulations or any other section of the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, or in violation of Section 201(b(6) of the Amateur Sports Act which requires that USA Swimming must provide: "an equal opportunity to amateur athletes; coaches, trainers, managers, administrators, and officials to participate in amateur athletic competition, without discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, age, sex, or national origin":
- .4 Conviction of, imposition of a deferred sentence for, or any plea of guilty or no contest at any time, past or present, or the existence of any pending charges, for (i) any felony, (ii) any offense involving use, possession, distribution or intent to distribute illegal drugs or substances, or (iii) any crime involving sexual misconduct;
- .5 Any sexual contact or advance directed towards an athlete by a coach, official, trainer, or other person who, in the context of swimming, is in a position of authority over that athlete;
- .6 The sale or distribution of illegal drugs or the illegal sale or distribution of any substance listed on FINA's recognized list of banned substances:
- .7 The use of illegal drugs in the presence of an athlete, by a coach, official, trainer of, or a person who, in the context of swimming, is in a position of authority over, that athlete;

- .8 The providing of alcohol to an athlete by a coach, official, trainer manager or any other person where the athlete is under the legal age allowed to consume or purchase alcohol in the state where the alcohol is provided;
- .9 The abuse of alcohol in the presence of an athlete under the age of 18, by a coach, official, trainer of, or a person who, in context of swimming, is in a position of authority over, that athlete:
- .10 Physical abuse of an athlete by any person who, in the context of swimming, is in a position of authority over that athlete;
- .11 Any act of fraud, deception or dishonesty in connection with any USA Swimming-related activity.
- .12 Any non-consensual physical contact, obscene language or gesture, or other threatening language or conduct directed towards any meet official and which is related to any decision made by such official in connection with a USA Swimming-sanctioned competition;
- .13 Action, other than through general advertising, by a coach, owner, officer, volunteer, representive, or employee of a swim club, or a USA Swimming or LSC employee, either through direct contact with an athlete or the encouragement of others, to recruit or otherwise encourage an athlete who is already a member of a USA Swimming member swim club to compete for or become a member of the swim club with which the acting party is affiliated, unless the acting party receives prior written approval to recruit or encourage the athlete from the coach of the athlete's existing USA Swimming-member swim club or contact is initiated by the athlete, the athlete's parent or authorized representative;
- .14 Violation of any team misconduct rule as established by the USOC, USA Swimming, any Zone or LSC team authority;
- .15 Any other act, conduct or omission which is detrimental to the image or reputation of USA Swimming, a LSC or the sport of swimming.

Waivers for Coaches with Physical Disabilities

Several people who have applied for coach membership have had disabilities that prevented them from completing CPR (asthma) and Safety Training for Swim Coaches (wheelchair). These people were unable to participate in the skills demonstration required to pass these courses.

Effective December 1, 1998, the attached procedures must be followed by people applying for coach membership who are unable to complete the safety courses due to physical disabilities. A copy of the waiver is also attached.

This procedure will be added to the Registration/Membership and Risk Management Manuals when they are revised in 1999.

USA SWIMMING COACH SAFETY REQUIREMENTS WAIVER FOR COACHES WITH PHYSICAL DISABILITIES

USA Swimming requires anyone applying for coach membership to provide proof of current certification in First Aid, CPR and Safety Training for Swim Coaches (STSC). These courses include skill demonstrations that people with certain disabilities may be unable to participate in. In this event, the coach candidate should follow these procedures:

- 1. Obtain current certifications in any of the three courses where his/her disability is not a factor. Certifications must be from the list of USA Swimming approved courses.
- 2. Take the remaining course(s) and complete the written exam at the end of the course.
- 3. Request that the organization that administered the course(s) send a letter to USA Swimming, stating that the candidate passed the written exam(s) but is unable to participate in the skills demonstration portion of the exam(s) due to a physical disability. Letters should be sent to: Member Services Coordinator, USA Swimming, One Olympic Plaza, Colorado Springs, CO 80909 (fax: 719/575-4050).

USA Swimming will send the candidate and Local Swimming Committee (LSC) Membership Chair a waiver. Candidates will be eligible for coach membership provided that all the following conditions are met:

- ✓ Candidate has current USA Swimming-approved certifications where a waiver is not necessary (First Aid, CPR, and/or STSC)
- ✓ Candidate can provide proof of having passed the written exam(s) for those courses where a waiver is necessary
- ✓ Candidate agrees to provide a copy of the waiver to the LSC at any time
- ✓ A lifeguard or another USA Swimming coach member is on deck at all times

The coach candidate must prove to the LSC Membership Chair that all the above conditions have been met. At that time, coach membership can be granted by the LSC.

1999 Senior Long Course Championships

When the 1999 Calendar was announced showing the New England Senior Championships falling after Sr. National Championships, there were many questions raised regarding the rationale for making such a radical change in our traditional schedule. Some of the concerns raised were:

- It disrupts the normal progression of meets from age groups to Seniors, Junior Championships and Nationals.
- Long Course Seniors would be diminished because of lack of incentives to do well.
- The late date leaves little free time in the summer for the swimmers.
- Swimmers entering their senior year in high school would have less opportunity to visit prospective college campuses over the summer.
- College swimmers may not be able to attend at all if their college started early.

All of the above points are valid considerations, but they are not the only things that must be considered. The two most important factors that have always driven our calendar in the past have been pool availability and the national schedule. As the National Championships keeps getting earlier, we find that keeping the "natural progression" pushes the championships for the youngest ages to the beginning of July. Many coaches are concerned that the long course season is already too short, and are reluctant to make it any shorter.

There is much difficulty finding suitable long course pools in the early summer because there are often conflicts with club or other league meets, or with athletic camps held at

colleges during the summer. In fact, at the time the schedule was being put together, we did not have pools available for both Seniors and Age groups if we held them based around the national calendar.

The technical committee is charged with trying to find workable solutions with the reality at hand. The decision was not made without a lot of discussion on both sides of the argument. The committee finally agreed to propose the August 15 date for New England Seniors, and New England Swimming is going to <u>TRY</u> this format for this year. The committee is made up primarily of coaches and the athlete's representatives, who were unanimously in favor of the change. Some of the arguments for moving the meet to mid August were:

- It would strengthen New England Seniors, because teams could go to the meet at full strength, without having two different training programs for their athletes who had already qualified for nationals versus athletes trying to qualify.
- It would allow for a longer season for the age group swimmers.
- Because the season would be longer, it would allow teams the flexibility to have a longer spring break between long course and short course.
- Swimmers who barely make national qualifying times at New England Seniors often find that they do not swim as well a week later and may not swim a qualifying time at juniors or nationals. They then have to start all over the next season trying to qualify for the national meets. Swimmers who make junior or national cuts at seniors held in August could use those times to qualify at both short course and long course meets the following year. The swimmer could then concentrate on the optimum training geared to the national or junior meets next year.

This may not be a permanent change. However, every year the calendar is filled with problems that don't satisfy everyone. We have to keep trying innovative ways to deal with our logistics. There are good, traditional arguments against the change, but we won't know the real impact it has on our swimmers until we try it.

The technical and calendar committees put in a tremendous amount of effort each year trying to deal with both the format and timing of the season end meets. Technical committee meeting schedules are always published in the New England Swimming Newsletter. It can be reasonably assumed that any technical committee meeting held between November and January will be addressing championship issues, because that is the key time period for finalizing both the short course and long course championship schedule. People who have concerns or ideas they would like considered would do better to try to contact someone on the committee before the meeting, rather than waiting until after decisions are made.

February 11--13 Bronze Championships (2 meets, all ages)

18--20 Eight & under Championships; 9 and over Age Group/Senior Qualifier

25--27 9--10, 11--12 Championships (trials & finals for 11--12)

March 2--5 13--14, 15--18 Championships (trials & finals)

9--12 Senior Championships (trials & finals)

17--19 Districts (2 meets). Swimmers who have achieved an age group or senior cut may not participate in that event in this meet.

Bids for <u>all meets</u> for the 1999--2000 short course calendar are due by July 1, 1999. A bid must be in proper form (complete meet information package) or it will not be considered. An untimely (late) bid will be considered only if teams hosting meets on the same weekend consent, or the calendar committee finds that the late bid will not adversely affect a timely bid meet. The sanction fee will be increased to \$40 per day for any late bid meet.

The Calendar Committee will review all timely submitted bids and attempt to award meets consistent with each team's preferred date. In the event any particular weekend in oversubscribed, the Calendar Committee will attempt to move one or more meets from an oversubscribed weekend to a less subscribed weekend in the best interests of the New England Swimming community. The final decision with respect to any bid rest with the Calendar Committee.

The Calendar Committee and the New England Swimming Board, in the best interests of New England Swimming, amy waive any of its policies with respect to securing bids for championship meets. The New England Swimming Board will consider a subsidy (up to four per season) of \$250 to a team which hosts a distance meet open to all New England teams as a calendar meet. A distance meet is a meet which offers the 1650/1500 or the 1000/800 which may be combined with a 400/500 freestyle or a 400 IM. A distance meet run by a team in conjunction with an existing meet (i.e. on the same weekend) is not eligible for a subsidy.

In order to encourage teams to run more distance meets (see definition above), trials and finals meets and "A" meets, there will be no surcharges for distance meets, trials and finals meets or "A" meets.

New England teams that still owe surcharges will not have bids considered until the fees are paid.

The Bid Form for all meet bids will be found in this newsletter and is part of the bid package.

PROPOSED 2000 LONG COURSE CHAMPIONSHIP CALENDAR

The proposed calendar for the 2000 long course season will be announced in September, and bids will be due early in the fall. This change will allow New England to evaluate the new (late) date for long course Senior Championships.

OFFICIALS REPORT FROM COLORADO SPRINGS, COLORADO

Bill Geary (MVP) and I traveled to Colorado Springs in May for the Officials Training Clinic held at the Olympic Training Center. While there we had a jam-packed schedule of events to attend in order to educate us about what is happening around the country in the world of officiating. We both came home with the same pleasant conclusion: New England Swimming officials are well informed and up to date.

There were some interesting small group discussions with the different LSCs that resulted with similar themes occurring. The most prevalent one was that there are some officials that shouldn't be officiating (for various reasons) and what to do about it. There was even talk about having a decertification process in place to relieve these officials of their responsibilities. Another interesting proposal was that all meet referees should be familiar with the Hytek and Colorado programs so that they could intervene when problems might arise in running a meet. There are still not consistent standards between LSCs in regard to training officials. Some wanted a standardized evaluation form to be used to advance officials. Of course, communication from the national staff to the 9,919 registered officials across the country was an important issue, too. It is interesting to note that all our comments were taken seriously will be addressed in the near future by the National Officials Committee.

Overall, it was a great experience for Bill and I and we want to thank New England Swimming for giving us this great training opportunity.


Monitoring Coach Safety Certification Expiration Dates

At its January meeting, the Board of Directors directed the Registration/Membership Committee to investigate ways that USA Swimming could start tracking the coach safety certification expiration dates. At it's meeting on March 5, the Registration/Membership Committee approved the following procedure, which will become effective on September 1, 1999 for the 2000 membership year:

The registration program will be revised so that the date of the first safety certification to expire will appear prominently on each coach's membership card. A new card will be issued when the certification is updated; the new card will include the next expiration date or 12/31, whichever comes first. (Below is a copy of the proposed coach membership card.)

It will remain the personal responsibility of the coach to maintain current certifications. The bold printed date is a reminder to the coach as well as a guide to others as to the validity of the credential. As an additional reminder to coaches, all three of their safety certification expiration dates will print on the stub portion of their membership card, with the following statement:

Please note the expiration dates of your safety certifications. Coach members are responsible for maintaining current status of CPR, First Aid and Safety Training for Swim Coaches (STSC) If you do not renew the certifications <u>PRIOR TO</u> their expiration dates, your USA Swimming coach membership will be invalid and your insurance will be in jeopardy. There is no grace period – you must renew your certifications <u>PRIOR TO</u> their expiration and send a copy of the new certifications to your LSC Membership Chair immediately.

GUIDELINES FOR THE "NO RECALL" STARTING PROCEDURE (effective June 1999 for all Grand Prix events and Junior and National Championship events)

RATIONALE

The swimmer's best effort is generally on their first start. They should not be penalized for a good start by having a race recalled due to someone else false starting. The penalty for the false start will be imposed to the offender after completion of the swim. It is each swimmer's responsibility to focus on their own start and race and not be affected by actions of another on the blocks. Reaction to movement on the part of another swimmer could result in a disqualification if confirmed by the referee or, at the very least, find themselves being caught on the block. Additionally, all other violations are called after the completion of a swim.

STARTER RESPONSIBILITIES

All National Championship procedures will take place as usual. If the starter observes a false start, the race will continue without recall and will record the lane/s in violation and report it to the referee. Any other information observed by the starter should also be reported.

If the movement occurred before the signal and the starter has time to stand the heat, no signal shall be given and the offending swimmer will be disqualified by the referee or designee after confirmation with the starter. All other swimmers entering the water upon reacting to the "stand" command shall be released. The starter shall inform the heat by saying "please hold a motionless position." The heat is then restarted.

A recall by the starter for unusual circumstances that affect the racing course (i.e., a lane line breaks) is appropriate.

REFEREE RESPONSIBILITIES

The procedure for initiating a race is the National Championship protocol currently in use. The referee must observe the start for movement or any irregularities, if any, immediately record the observation but shall allow the race to continue without recall. Communication with the starter for confirmation will determine if there was a false start. Upon confirmation, and the completion of the race, the referee or designee shall inform the swimmer of the violation. If a heat is instinctively recalled, the referee will relieve the heat and restart. In the 50 meter races, notification of the infraction will be communicated by the referee/chief judge at the starting end to the chief judge at the finish end who then will inform the athlete of the infraction.

RECALL STARTER

A recall starter will not be used with this procedure. The starter shall have full responsibility of ensuring that proper starting procedures occur.

NOTE: This procedure will be used at the New England Senior Championships.


Monitoring Coach Safety Certification Expiration Dates

At its January meeting, the Board of Directors directed the Registration/Membership Committee to investigate ways that USA Swimming could start tracking the coach safety certification expiration dates. At it's meeting on March 5, the Registration/Membership Committee approved the following procedure, which will become effective on September 1, 1999 for the 2000 membership year:

The registration program will be revised so that the date of the first safety certification to expire will appear prominently on each coach's membership card. A new card will be issued when the certification is updated; the new card will include the next expiration date or 12/31, whichever comes first. (Below is a copy of the proposed coach membership card.)

It will remain the personal responsibility of the coach to maintain current certifications. The bold printed date is a reminder to the coach as well as a guide to others as to the validity of the credential. As an additional reminder to coaches, all three of their safety certification expiration dates will print on the stub portion of their membership card, with the following statement:

Please note the expiration dates of your safety certifications. Coach members are responsible for maintaining current status of CPR, First Aid and Safety Training for Swim Coaches (STSC) If you do not renew the certifications <u>PRIOR TO</u> their expiration dates, your USA Swimming coach membership will be invalid and your insurance will be in jeopardy. There is no grace period – you must renew your certifications <u>PRIOR TO</u> their expiration and send a copy of the new certifications to your LSC Membership Chair immediately.

2000 TEAM ADDRESSES AND REGISTRATION:

The time for 2000 registration is growing near. Shortly, the office will be sending each team a form asking for the team address for the fall and also for the name and address of the registration chair-person.

Please return the form promptly, but not before putting some thought into the names listed. The team contact will receive the team mailings including the newsletter and meet announcements. The registration chair person will be responsible for all aspects of registration, including supervising and mailing all registration forms. Registration materials will not be sent until the form has been received.

As in the 1999 registration year, there will not be a computer printout for 2000 registration. The individual registration forms take a little longer (for the office as well as for the team), but the number of inaccuracies is cut tremendously.

The good news is that there will be no increase in dues for 2000. The club fee will be \$125 before December 1, 1999 or for new clubs and \$150 after December 1, 1999. Top Ten Times are compiled using results from New England meets held during the past year. Short course (25 yard) times run from June 1, 1998 through May 31, 1999; long course (50 meter) times run from October 1, 1998 through September

In addition to New England sanctioned calendar meets, we also use times from out of district sanctioned meets if the results are sent to the office and if the meet is open to all USS swimmers. We consider all times from the meet--trials, finals, and swim-offs--but we do not use time trials. We also consider lead-off splits from individual events and relays when they are printed in the results.

We do not include meets that are closed--restricted to certain teams, league members, etc. For this reason, we do not consider high school meets, "Y" meets, etc.

OUTSTANDING SWIMMERS are those who have accumulated the most points through their top ten standings. The scoring is as follows:

In a constant effort to promote the sport of swimming and expand the participant base, USA Swimming continues to forge partnerships that create opportunities for their athletes. EF Sports Tours, one of these partners, is the official provider of international and domestic swimming tours for USA Swimming. We are proud to be able to provide USA Swimming Clubs and athletes with the chance to travel, train, and compete abroad within an educational and sport oriented framework.

EF Sports Tours has experienced great success in taking teams of athletes from across the United States on international tours. We would like to extend the same travel invitation to individual athletes from within your LSC who's teams may not be traveling this year.

REIMBURSEMENT POLICY FOR NATIONAL MEETS, 1999--2000

ATHLETE REIMBURSEMENT POLICY:

A New England registered swimmer who swims in an individual event at Junior Champion-ships will be reimbursed \$150 by New England Swimming. A New England registered swimmer who swims in an individual event at the US Open will be reimbursed \$150 by New England Swimming. A New England registered swimmer who swims in an individual event at National Championships will be reimbursed \$300 by New England Swimming. A New England registered swimmer who swims in an individual event at the Olympic Trials will be reimbursed \$300 by New England Swimming. There will be no limit either for the number of meets or the amount of money to be reimbursed to a swimmer.

During the short course season a swimmer must fully participate in three New England calendar meets to be eligible for reimbursement. During the long course season a swimmer must fully participate in two New England calendar meets to be eligible for reimbursement. "Full participation" means participation in all or at least two days days of competition and at least one **individual** event at each day of participation.

If the New England Senior Championships is in place with a named facility by a certain date (90 days preceding the first day of the meet for long course; 120 days preceding the first day of the meet for short course), mandatory participation in the Senior meet is required in order for a swimmer to receive reimbursement. The New England Board may waive this requirement for good cause, such as illness or conflict with the National Team requirement.

A swimmer must request the reimbursement within eight weeks of the meet. The request must include the stub from the swimmer's plane ticket or receipt of other expense to equal or exceed the amount of requested reimbursement.

To be eligible for reimbursement, an athlete must have been registered in New England and have competed in a New England calendar meet at least six months prior to the meet for which reimbursement has been requested.

A swimmer who does not participate in three New England calendar meets during short course season may request a waiver for a championship meet during that season only if he/she participates in three New England calendar meets during the long course season. A swimmer who does not participate in two New England calendar meets during the long course season may request a waiver for a championship meet during that season only if he/she participates in three New England calendar meets during the short course season. All requests for waivers will be considered following the long course season.

COACH REIMBURSEMENT POLICY:

For each team that sends a swimmer to a National Championship or Junior Championship meet, New England Swimming will provide \$150 to reimburse coach expenses. The \$150 per team may be used to reimburse one coach or be split between several team coaches at the team's discretion. The team will have to provide New England Swimming with receipts for coach expenses which equal or exceed the \$150 reimbursement.
