Please check the expiration date (VALID TO: date) on your 2000 Coach Registration card and plan to take one of these courses if your card expires before the long course season begins.

Courses are sometimes difficult to find, expecially in the "dead of winter" so please plan ahead!!!

REGISTRATION: If you have sent your coach registration to the office and have not received your new 2000 Coach Registration Card, please check with the office. The section in the file box for "snags" is quite large this year. In order to be registered as a coach, the office must receive copies of <u>current</u> CPR, First Aid, and Safety Training for Swim Coaches. The acceptable course list was sent to the Registration Chairman of each team with the registration packet. Note that "instructor" cards are not acceptable (and have not been acceptable for several years). If you have any further questions, please call the office.

For all coaches, the date of the first safety certification to expire appears prominently on the card. A new card will be issued when the certification is updated (and a copy of the certification is submitted to the office). The new card will include the next expiration date or 12/31/00, whichever comes first.

Please remember that New England Swimming policy requires that all officials and coaches display their cards while on deck. A coach who is not displaying a card or who is displaying a card which is no longer valid will be asked to leave the deck. Teams that are running meets should check the registration cards of all coaches when they pick up their packets. The team's safety coordinator may help with this task and also may assist the referee to check coach cards on deck.

As in the past, coach members are responsible for maintaining current status of their CRP, FA, and STSC. If a coach does not renew the certifications prior to their expiration dates, the USA Swimming coach membership will be invalid and insurance will be in jeopardy. There is no grace period—coaches must renew their certifications prior to the expiration and send a copy of the new certifications to the office. Please allow at least two weeks for your new coach membership card to arrive and plan accordingly.



QUALIFYING FOR NEW ENGLAND "END OF SEASON" MEETS:

NUMBER OF MEETS REQUIRED: There is no minimum number of New England meets required in order to swim in the "end of Season Meets." There are two exceptions: If you wish to be reimbursed for expenses for attending Junior Championships or Senior Championships, then you must participate in three (including Senior Championships) New England Calendar meets. If you are applying for the New England Zone team, you must participate in three New England calendar meets.

TIME STANDARDS: Whether or not you attend New England calendar meets, you must achieve the required time for a particular meet. This may be done in a dual meet, league meet, high school meet, Y meet, etc. BUT you must have printed results and you must either send those results to the office before the appropriate meet or bring the results to the meet in you verification packet.

AGE REQUIREMENTS: USA Swimming rules state that a swimmer swims in a meet at the age the swimmer is on the first day of the meet. This applies whether or not the swimmer participates on the first day(s) of the meet.

GUIDELINES FOR THE "NO RECALL" STARTING PROCEDURE (effective Summer, 1999 for all Grand Prix events and Junior and National Championship events)

RATIONALE

The first start generally is the swimmer's best effort. Therefore, swimmers should not be penalized for a good start by having a race recalled due to someone false starting. Under the "no recall" starting procedure, the penalty for a false start is imposed on the offender after completion of the swim. This starting procedure, however, emphasizes swimmer's responsibility to concentrate on the start and the race and not be affected by actions of the other swimmers on the blocks. If confirmed by the Referee, swimmer's reaction to the movement by another swimmer could result in a disqualification or at the very least, in a delayed response to the start signal. Also note that, under this procedure, informing the athletes about a disqualification for a false start after the event is consistent with all other disqualifications under the swimming rules.

STARTER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

Usual National Championship starting procedures will be in place, except that, if a false start occurs, no recall signal will be given. Instead, the Starter shall allow the race to proceed and shall make a written record and immediately report to the Referee the lane or lanes which false started. Any other observation by the starter or information relative to the start should also be reported.

If, after assuming the starting position on the command "take your mark" a swimmer leaves their mark prior the start signal and the Starter has time to give the "stand" command, no signal shall be given and the offending swimmer will be disqualified by the Referee or a Referee's designee after confirming the lane with the Starter. All other swimmers entering the water in reaction to the "stand" command shall be released. The starter shall inform the heat by saying "please remain motionless" or "second start" and shall restart the heat.

The Starter may recall a heat for unusual circumstances, such as a lane line break, sudden noise interfering with the start signal, or anything that may affect fair conduct of the race.

REFEREE'S RESPONSIBILITIES

The Referee shall use the current National Championship procedure for initiating a race and shall observe each start for movement prior to the signal and other irregularities. The Referee shall record the observations immediately after the start, but shall allow the race to continue without recall. If the Referee and Starter independently agree on the infraction and the lane or lanes, the swimmer or swimmers in those lanes shall be charged with a false start. The referee or a designee shall inform swimmers of the violation upon completion of the race. No false start can be charged if a heat is instinctively recalled by the Starter and the heat shall be restarted. In the 50 meter races, notification of the infraction will be communicated by the referee or the chief judge at the starting end to the chief judge at the finish end who then will inform the athlete of the infraction.

RECALL STARTER

A recall starter will not be used with this procedure. The starter shall have full responsibility of ensuring that proper starting procedures are implemented and enforced.

The above procedure was used at New England Senior Championships this past summer and will be used at New England Senior Championships in March. It may be used at the 13 and over Championships in March, also, and if it is going to be used, it will be noted in the meet invitation. As of the long course season, this will be the procedure for all USA Swimming meets.

INFORMATION FOR NEW ENGLAND "END OF SEASON" MEETS:

Please note that there was an error in the information printed last month. Also, there is some additional materials concerning Age Group and Senior Championships.

NUMBER OF MEETS REQUIRED: There is no minimum number of New England meets required in order to swim in the "end of season meets" with the exception of New England Senior Championships. In order to participate in New England Senior Championships, a swimmer must have participated in one New England Calendar meet in the past 11 months. If a swimmer have a problem with this requirement, the swimmer should contact the New England Office at 781-449-0270.

There are two other exceptions: If a swimmer wishes to be reimbursed for expenses for attending Junior Championships or Senior Nationals, then the swimmer must participate in three (including New England Senior Championships) New England Calendar meets. If a swimmer is applying for the New England Zone team, the swimmer must participate in three New England Calendar meets.

TIME STANDARDS: Whether or not a swimmer attends a New England Carendar meet, the swimmer must achieve the required time for a particular meet. This may be done in a dual meet, league meet, high school meet, y meet, etc. BUT, you must have printed results and must either send those results to the office before the appropriate meet or bring the results to the meet in the verification packet.

AGE REQUIREMENTS: USA Swimming rules state that a swimmer swims in a meet at the age the swimmer is on the first day of the meet. This applies whether or not the swimmer participates on the first day(s) of the meet.

"NO RECALL" STARTING PROCEDURE: The "No Recall" Starting Procedure will be in effect at NEW ENGLAND SENIORS, 9--12 AGE GROUP CHAMPIONSHIPS and 13 and over AGE GROUP CHAMPIONSHIPS.

Please note that this procedure will also be ineffect at the Eastern Zone Championships.

SCRATCH RULES: Mandatory scratch rules (similar to the ones used at New England Senior Championships) will be used at 13 and over AGE GROUP CHAMPIONSHIPS and at the 9--12 AGE GROUP CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR THE 11 and 12 year old swimmers. Please make sure all swimmers, coaches, and parents attending the meets are familiar with the rules.

For all three meets, there will be a scratch box on deck and scratches must be turned in the night before the session to be scratched. There will be a phone number to scratch events on the first day of the meet. Please refer to each individual meet entry for specific times and phone numbers.

Any swimmer who fails to compete in an individual event heat in which he/she is entered and has not been scratched from will be barred from further competition for that day, including relays and time trials. The swimmer will also be automatically scratched from the following day's events unless the clerk of course has been notified of the swimmers intention to compete by a time stated in each entry. NOTE: Finals are considered continuation of events started with trials.

Any swimmer who competes in an individual heat and qualifies for Championship, Consolation or Bonus finals and fails to notify the meet referee of his/her intention to withdraw from the finals within 30 minutes of the announcement of the results and qualifies for that event, and does not compete nor is excused by the meet referee, will be barred from all subsequent competition in the meet, including relays and time trials.

The day will include the General Meeting and Election of Officers, meetings for Meet Managers (required of teams running meets), Coaches (including election of new Coaches Representative), the Athletes Committee, and recertification clinics for Officials. The new USA Swimming officiating video will be shown.

NOMINATING COMMITTEE: The Nominating Committee is working on the slate of candidates to be presented at the Annual Meeting. Offices which are up for election this year include: General Chairman, Administrative Vice Chairman, Finance Vice Chairman, Senior Vice Chairman, Secretary (all two year terms) and the Board of Review and Nominating Committee (one year terms). The Board of New England Swimming will meet on Tuesday, April 11, 2000 at the Wellesley Community Center, Washington Street, Wellesley, MA at 7:30 pm. All members of the swimming community are welcome to attend.

A Message from the Calendar Committee

A number of parents and coaches have expressed to the New England Swimming office concern about the adequacy of the various sites for New England's championship and other end-of-the-season meets.

A brief review of the process that the Calendar Committee follows in selecting meet sites may be helpful to everyone's understanding of this important issue.

Each year the Calendar Committee sets a time frame for submission of bids on the regular season meets and the Championship meets. The committee determines the dates of the post-season championship and related meets, seeking to create a progression of meets from the youngest age group up to the Senior Championship meet. This progression is important, as any variation from the youngest age group up to the oldest age group will result in the exclusion of some swimmers whose birth-days fall between the meets. In some years we have been forced to vary the progression because of the availability of certain facilities. We also look to the national calendar to ensure that swimmers will have an adequate opportunity to qualify for national or junior championships.

Every New England team is free, and indeed, is encouraged, to bid for meets during the season and for the Championship meets. New England Swimming does not preselect the teams or sites for championships. Unfortunately, many of the best facilities for hosting large championship meets are not available or are not being bid for championship meets by teams with access to those facilities. For example, up until this season no team had bid the Senior Championship meets for the past three years. Thankfully, during that time Brown University agreed to let New England Swimming host the Senior meet at the Brown facility. But a number of excellent facilities remain unavailable for any of the New England Championship meets.

For most of the championship meets in the past several seasons, only one team submitted a bid on each championship meet, and in some cases there was no bid at all. The sites selected were the only sites willing to host these meets and we are grateful to the teams that have come forward to host these meets. In many instances the best facilities in New England are simply not being made available to host championship meets. This situation is beyond the control of New England Swimming, as we do not have access to these facilities.

Until this situation changes, or more teams with access to quality facilities are willing to step forward to host championship meets, and/or convince the powers that be at those facilities to allow their teams to host championship meets, we are left with limited choices for end-of-the-season championship meets.



NEW ENGLAND SWIMMING ANTI-RECRUITING POLICY

Active recruiting – the solicitation of an athlete of one USS member club by another USS member club – is contrary to the best interests of New England Swimming and its more than 5000 athlete members.

USS member clubs within New England Swimming shall be prohibited from directly or indirectly soliciting or encouraging an athlete of another USS member club to leave his or her existing member club to join the soliciting club. This anti-recruiting policy shall prohibit a USS member club officer, employee, or coach from directly or indirectly initiating contact with an athlete from another USS member club in New England Swimming, or the athlete's family, with the intent that the athlete join the soliciting club.

The intent of this anti-recruiting policy is to prevent organized and club-sanctioned efforts to persuade a member of one USS member club to leave his or her member club to join the other member club. It is not the intent of this anti-recruiting policy to prevent athletes or parents of athletes of one member club from initiating contact with coaches, officials or athletes of another member club for the purpose of inquiring about joining the other member club. Once such contact is initiated, the restrictions of this anti-recruiting policy shall not apply to any contact with that athlete or family by that member club. Nor is it the intent of this anti-recruiting policy to prevent athletes or parents of athletes from different clubs from discussing any aspect of their respective USS member clubs, or incidental contact, such as may occur at a competition when a coach, parent, or athlete of one club offers to congratulate an athlete from another club. However, any such activities which are shown to have been promoted, encouraged or facilitated by a USS member club officer, employee or coach with the intent of recruiting shall be in violation of this anti-recruiting policy and subject the member club and/or its coach to the sanctions of this anti-recruiting policy.

Nothing in this anti-recruiting policy shall prevent a USS member club from conducting self-promotional activities such as advertising, team tryouts or camps for the purpose of recruiting athletes, as long as there is no direct solicitation of athletes of another member club.

Violation of the this anti-recruiting policy may be reported to the New England Swimming Board of Review which, upon review of the complaint, may conduct hearings under the by-laws of New England Swimming. Any USS member club or USS member coach found to have violated this anti-recruiting policy may be suspended from New England Swimming for up to one year for a first offense and for up to two years for a second or subsequent offense. Suspension of a member coach for a violation of this anti-recruiting policy shall prohibit that coach from being on deck for any USS competition sanctioned by New England Swimming during the period of suspension. Suspension of a USS member club for a violation of this anti-recruiting policy shall not prohibit the registration of the club, athletes or coaches, but shall prohibit the member club from competing as a team in USS competition sanctioned by New England Swimming, including all championship competition during the period of suspension. Athletes registered with any such suspended club may compete in any USS competition sanctioned by New England Swimming, but may do so only as an unattached athlete.

FROM THE TECHNICAL COMMITTEE:

The Technical Committee met recently and made several recommendations which will be presented to the Board for approval at the meeting on June 13. However, there were two items which the committee felt teams needed to know about so that they can plan accordingly. If you have any questions concerning these items following the June 13th Board meeting, please call or email the office.

REIMBURSEMENT POLICY: It was recommended that the reimbursement policy be amended for those swimmers who swim at the Olympic Trials. Olympic Trials swimmers will not have to compete at New England Seniors. They will still have to swim in two New England Swimming calendar meets during the long course season and will have to fulfill all other reimbursement requirements—date of registration, receipts, etc. This change would be for long course season only for those swimmers participating in Olympic Trials.

DISTANCE EVENTS AT 12 & under CHAMPIONSHIPS: The committee recommended that three distance events be added to the 12 & under Championships this summer. The added events would be the 400 meter free for 9 and 10 and the 800 meter free and 400 meter IM for 11 and 12. Time standards will be based on the 200 meter free for the 400 meter free, the 400 meter free for the 800 meter free, and the 200 meter IM for the 400 meter IM. The events would be limited to 2 heats per sex per event. Swimmers will be allowed to enter as many events as they have qualified for and then scratch down to 9 events, no more than 5 per day.

EXTENSION OF RETMBURSEMENT PROGRAM: At the June meeting of the Board of New England Swimming, it was voted to extent the current Reimbursement Policy to include New England Swimmers who participate in the USA Swimming Disability Championships on June 23--25, 2000 in Indianapolis, IN. The neet serves as Paralympic Trials and as a selection meet for the Deaf World Games.

RECRUITING POLICY VIOLATION:

Recently, a possible violation of the New England Recruiting Policy was reported to the Review Board. The Review Board determined that the violation was unintentional, but also determined that a punishment would be appropriate. As a result, the team which committed the violation has to have all new swimmers who registered after April 1, 2000 swim unattached for the remainder of the long course season.

The policy has been reprinted several times in the newsletter. If you have any questions concerning the policy or need an additional copy, please contact the office.

The Board of New England Swimming will meet on Tuesday, July 11, 2000 at 7 pm at the Wellesley Community Center, Wellesley, MA. No meeting is planned for August.

FROM THE TECHNICAL COMMITTEE:

At the Board Meeting on June 13, 2000 the following recommendations from the Technical Committee were accepted by the Board.

UNREGISTERED "COACHES" ON DECK: Because of the continuing problem of unregistered "coaches" on deck and the insurance problems that this creates, the Board voted to begin a fine system to deal with this problem. At each meet the referee will ask any "coach" without a card to leave the deck without exception. The referee will also make a list of all those without cards. The list will be sent to the office to be checked by Mary Riddell. If a "coach" who was asked to leave the deck is found to be not fully registered (current certifications and completed education requirement), the "coach" will be fined \$100 and the team will be fined \$200 to be paid within 30 days. Any "coach" who refuses to leave the deck will cause the team's swimmers to swim unattached for the remainder of the meet.

TIMELY REGISTRATION OF TEAMS AND SWIMMERS: Several teams completed the registration of their teams on deck at championship meets this year. In an effort to encourage teams to register at the proper time and to prevent confusion with meet entries, the Board voted the following policy. A reregistering team that expects to participate in the end of season meets must be fully registered by January 15 (or May 15 for long course season), including a fully certified head coach, registered athletes and a check to cover all fees. Any reregistering team that does not adhere to this deadline will be required to swim all swimmers in all end of season meets as "unattached" (with no team points or relays).

AWARDS: The Board voted to purchase medals for all end of season meets—Bronze, Districts, Age Group and Senior Championships. New England will also provide ribbons for all end of season meets, except Seniors and 13 and over Age Groups. There will be no ribbons at those two meets. The medals will continue to have blue, red and white ribbons for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places, but there will be uniform red, white and blue striped ribbons for places 4 through 6 (or 8).

REIMBURSEMENT POLICY: The Board voted that for this summer only, New England swimmers who participate in Olympic Trials will not have to attend New England Senior Championships to be eligible for reimbursement. They will have to attend two calendar meets during the long course season, however.

DISTANCE EVENTS AT 12 & under CHAMPIONSHIPS: The Board voted to include some distance events at 12 & under Championships. Added will be 9 and 10 400 free, 11 and 12 400 IM and 800 free. There will be no more than 2 heats per sex, per event. Swimmers will be allowed to enter as many events as they have qualified for and then scratch down to 9 events, no more than 5 per day. Time standards will be based on the 200 free for the 400 free, the 400 free for the 800 free and the 200 IM for the 400 IM.

DISTANCE MEET SUBSIDIES: The Board voted that any number of distance meets that are approved by the calendar committe be awarded the \$250 subsidy, providing all New England policies are met--financial reports, evaluations, results, etc. A distance meet includes either the 1650 (1500) freestyle or the 1000 (800) freestyle. A 400 IM or a 500 (400) freestyle also may be included. Distance events that are part of a meet including other events, whether in a separate session or not, will not be considered for this subsidy.

SOME NOTES CONCERNING 12 and under CHAMPIONSHIPS.

Three events have been added to the 12 and under Championships:

- 11 and 12 400 IM at the end of the Saturday am session (after relay)
- 9 and 10 400 free at the end of the Saturday pm session (after relay)
- 11 and 12 800 free at the end of the Sunday am session (after relay)

These events will be limited to two heats per sex per event. All swimmers may enter as many events as they qualify for, but may only swim nine individual events (excluding relays).

SHORT COURSE 2000--2001 CALENDAR:

Sectional Meet: It is expected that the Sectional Meet will be held on March 8--11, 2000 in Long Island, NY. The time standards have not been established yet but will be somewhere faster than New England Seniors and slower than the current Junior Championship times. There will be no Junior Championships next year.

Eight and under Championships: In February 2001 there will be two sites for the Eight and under Championships. There will be individual awards and high points and relay awards, but there will be no team scoring. Several aspects of the meet were considered when this decision was made. Some swimmers and their families will not have to travel so far to attend the meet. More swimmers will receive awards. Six lane pools could be used since each meet will be smaller. Spectators will be divided between two facilities.

A MESSAGE FROM YOUR ATHLETE REPS:

Although the response to the idea of team representatives to correspond information with the New England reps was minimal, we have decided to run with the idea despite this. Our hope is that if the teams which have responded, keep up their "part of the bargain" of keeping in touchthat all other New England teams will also join in. For all members of teams that are reading this, that have not picked a rep yet and sent it to me, SIGN UP! Don't wait, we need 100% participation for this to work at the best of its capability. Thank you and we look forward to starting the communication!

REGISTRATION FOR THE YEAR 2001:

2000 is barely half over, but the time for 2001 registration is drawing near. Shortly the office will be sending each team a form asking for the team address for the fall and also for the name and address of the registration chair. New this year will be a request for an email contact for each team.

Please return the form promptly, but not before putting some thought into the names listed. The team contact will receive the team mailings including the newsletter and meet announcements. The registration chair will be responsible for all aspects of registration, including supervising and mailing all registration forms. Registration materials will not be sent until the form has been received. The email address will be used for information that needs to sent to all teams in a short period of time. It is hoped that the email addresses will be used to notify teams when meets have been posted on the web site.

As in the past two years, there will not be a computer printout for 2001 registration. The individual registration forms take a little longer (for the office as well as for the team), but the number of inaccuracies is cut tremendously.

The good news is that there will be no increase in dues for 2001. The club fee will be \$125 before December 1, 2000 or for new clubs and \$150 after December 1, 2000. As in the past the club fee will include non-athlete fees for both the head coach and the safety coordinator. Other non-athletes will be \$30 and athletes will be \$32.

Please note the new system to monitor coach safety certification expiration dates that has been in effect this year will continue for 2001. Also, note new New England policy for late registering teams and for unregistered coaches on deck which is printed elsewhere in this newsletter.

Coaches who registered for the first time in 1999 or 2000 must complete the education requirement before they can reregister for 2001. More information concerning that requirement is also found in this newsletter.

Registration forms will be sent directly to all registered non-athletes in October.

The form which the teams will be receiving in the mail serves two purposes—it triggers the team's registration packet, and it allows the office to update the labels which will be sent to all teams running meets.

INFORMATION FOR TEAMS AND COACHES CONCERNING REGISTRATION:

EDUCATION REQUIREMENT FOR NEW COACHES: A coach who registered for the first time after September 1, 1998 was required to pass the newly required "Foundations of Coaching" test before reregistering for the second year. The same requirement holds for those coaches who registered for the first time after September 1, 1999. Those coaches will have to pass the test before reregistering for 2001. In addition, there are still some coaches who did not pass the test before the registration year of 2000 and could not register for this year as coaches. They must pass the test before registering for 2001 as coaches.

ASCA is helping USA Swimming in the distribution and grading of the test. If you have not received the test and information, please contact ASCA to request a new coach packet at 1-800-356-2722.

Teams should be sure that all coaches registered for the first time in 1999 or 2000 have passed the test and have received a certificate from ASCA. A copy of the certificate should be sent to the office.

NEW NEW ENGLAND POLICIES....

UNREGISTERED "COACHES" ON DECK: Because of the continuing problem of unregistered "coaches" on deck and the insurance problems that this creates, the Board voted to begin a fine system to deal with this problem. At each meet the referee will ask any "coach" without a card to leave the deck without exception. The referee will also make a list of all those without cards. The list will be sent to the office to be checked. If a "coach" who was asked to leave the deck is found to be not fully registered (current certifications and completed education requirement), the "coach" will be fined \$100 and the team will be fined \$200 to be paid within 30 days. Any "coach" who refuses to leave the deck will cause the team's swimmers to swim unattached for the remainder of the meet.

TIMELY REGISTRATION OF TEAMS AND SWIMMERS: Several teams completed the registration of their teams on deck at championship meets this year. In an effort to encourage teams to register at the proper time and to prevent confusion with meet entries, the Board voted the following policy. A reregistering team that expects to participate in the end of season meets must be fully registered by January 15 (or May 15 for long course season), including a fully certified head coach, registered athletes and a check to cover all fees. Any reregistering team that does not adhere to this deadline will be required to swim all swimmers in all end of season meets as "unattached" (with no team points or relays).

Note: A "fully certified" coach has current certifications in CPR, First Aid and Safety Training for Swim Coaches.

OLYMPIC TRIALS, August 9--August 16, 2000, Indiana University Natatorium, Indianapolis, IN

The Trials will be televised on NBC Sports on August 13 from 4--6 pm (ET) and on August 19 from 4--6 pm (ET). The USA Swimming web site is www.usa-swimming.org

The format for the trials will be the same as for the Olympic Games. The fastest 16 athletes from the preliminaries in each event 200 meters and shorter will qualify for the semifinals. These athletes will be championship/circle seeded in the semifinals. The eight fastest athletes from the semifinals will qualify for the "A" final which will take place the following evening. In the 400 free, 400 IM, women's 800 free and men's 1500 free, the fastest eight athletes after the preliminaries will qualify for the "A" final. There will be no "B" final in these events.

A maximum of 26 men and 26 women will be selected. US Olympic Team Selection Meet performances will be prioritized for selection as follows:

Priority #1: First, second, third and fourth place finishers in the men's and women's 100 meter freestyle and 200 meter freestyle.

First place finisher in all other events.

Priority #2: Second place finisher in all events other than the men's and women's 100 meter freestyle and 200 meter freestyle.

Priority #3: Fifth place finisher in the men's and women's 100 meter freestyle and 200 meter freestyle.

Priority #4: Sixth place finisher in the men's and women's 100 meter freestyle and 200 meter freestyle.

If you need more information about the coach requirements, each club registration chair has received 6 pages of information or you may contact the office.

Becoming a Safety Training for Swim Coaches Instructor

Those wishing to be STSC instructors must complete all of the following:

- 1. Possess a current ARC certificate in **one** of the following: Water Safety Instructor, Water Safety Instructor Trainer, Lifeguard Training Instructor, Lifeguard Instructor Trainer, Basic Water Rescue Instructor.
- 2. Possess a current Safety Training for Swim Coaches certificate (see above).
- 3. Have a competitive swimming background. (This should be determined by the Local Swimming Committee and local American Red Cross Chapter.)

SECTIONAL MEET:

The Office has received many questions about the new Sectional Meet, but there are not many answers at this time.

The meet is scheduled for the second weekend in Long Island, NY. There will be time standards, but they have not be established yet, The final decision will be made at the USA Swimming convention in October. As soon as the times have been established, they will be released via the web site and the newsletter. It is expected that the times will be faster than our New England Swimming Senior times, but slower than the old Junior Championship times.

For the purpose of these meets, the Eastern Zone has been divided into two sections, each section having its own meet. New England will participate in the sectional meet with Maine, Connecticut, Adirondack, Metropolitan, Niagra, and New Jersey. The committee that is organizing the meet standards includes one representative from each of the seven LSC's included in our section. New England's representative is Frank Ching.

SEED CARDS: Seed Cards are available through the New England Office. The cost for plain cards is \$22 per thousand, including mailing. If the cards are picked up in Needham, the cost is \$19 per thousand. There is no minimum, and the cards may be split any way between boys and girls.

If you want initials on the cards, the price for 1,000 cards is \$31, including mailing. If the cards are picked up in Needham, the cost is \$28. If you want 2,000 or more cards with initials, the cost is \$26 per thousand, including mailing, or \$23 per thousand if the cards are picked up in Needham. The minimum order for cards with initials is 1,000 cards.

REGISTRATION NOTES:

1. NON-ATHLETES: Non-athletes who are currently registered for 2000 will receive renewal applications in the mail toward the end of October. Coaches who need to renew courses before they reregister should submit a copy of their certification card and they will receive an updated 2000 card.

2. ATHLETES: Some teams are having parents submit registration forms. All registration forms should come through the team registration chair so that the team will know who actually has registered and so that the forms can be checked for completeness. Anyone who registers after September 1 will receive a 2001 card, but will be registered for the rest of 2000 as well as 2001.

MEET ENTRIES:

As the Top Ten Committee completes its work for the past two seasons and as the Web Site Development Committee releases its first report, teams entering meets must be more careful with their entries.

- 1. Accurate AGES must be included in the meet entry. Errors and omissions in ages must be eliminated.
- 2. Swimmer's NAMES must be consistent. The United States Swimming registration programs allows for a "legal" name and a "preferred" name. When entering meets, however, a team must be consistent for all meets. If "William Thomas Smith" uses the preferred name of "Tom," please do not enter him in some meets as "Tom," other meets as "Thomas," or even more confusing, "William." Please pick a name, either the legal name or the preferred name and stick with it.

In addition, because of their expertise and functions within the New England Swimming organization, Cathy Mosca and Mary Riddell are ex officio members. Harold Whitney is the Chair of the committee.

Meet Data Management

The first focus of the committee has been to make recommendations to streamline meet data management. It is the belief of the committee that to efficiently run meets, entries must be received and results must be posted using standardized data entry files that can be used by team and meet management programs. To this end, the committee has recommended and the board has approved the following items.

Important: The following changes in meet requirements, with the exception of the surcharge for handwritten entries, are voluntary for the 2000-2001 short course season. It is the hope of the committee that teams will incorporate these modification into their meet entry procedures this winter so that they and the committee can evaluate and improve them for the long course season.

Teams hosting meets:

- Will e-mail to the New England Swimming webmaster the date when the meet invitation is to be posted. The webmaster will post on the web calendar, the date that the invitation will be made available on the website. The meet invitation should be mailed out the day before this date. For this short course season, the traditional mailing of the meet invitation to all clubs will continue but the goal is to move to website posting only.
- Will e-mail to the webmaster the meet invitation document at least one week before the invitation is to be posted. This document, in addition to the information already required will need to include the following items:
 - The date that the first entry will be accepted. Any entry that arrives before that date
 will be considered to have arrived on that date. It is recommended that teams accept
 entries two days after the meet announcement is posted on the website. Any entry that
 arrives during the day is considered to have arrived at the same time as any other entry
 received that day.
 - 2. Whether they will accept e-mail entries or only allow electronic entries to be submitted on a disk. Teams must accept entries by one of these two methods. In the future, e-mail entries will be the standard.
 - 3. How they will accept payment for the entries. Options include requiring the check to be received a certain number of days after the entry, setting up an account with PAY PAL or some other similar service. PAY PAL is a service that is used by many of the online auction sites to handle money transfers. There is no cost to either the club paying the entry fee or the non-profit organization receiving it when using the PAY PAL system.
- Will e-mail to the webmaster along with the meet invitation, a file containing the events of the meet. The file must be in a standard swimming data exchange format SD3, or Hy-Tek CL2.

The webmaster will put this file on the website so that teams will be able to download it and use it for creating their meet entries. Having this file available helps ensure that entries are accurate and minimizes problems for the teams going to meets and for host teams.

- Must accept standard electronic entries. These files may be in either of the above formats.
 The current version of all major team and meet management programs will import and export data files in these formats.
- Must e-mail results of meet to webmaster or provide a <u>direct link</u> to those results on another site within three business day after the conclusion of the meet. If the host team is providing a link to the results, it must be directly to the results, not to the team home page or to a page containing advertisements. For this season, the traditional mailing of the results will continue but will not be necessary in the future.
- Must e-mail a downloadable file of the results of the meet to the webmaster in either of the standard file formats mentioned above. The webmaster will put this file on the website so that teams will be able to download it and update their files after the meet is over. It will then be easy for the teams to update their records by downloading this file from the website and importing it into their team manager data files.

Teams entering meets:

- Must have a valid e-mail address. This should be a reliable e-mail address that is checked regularly. It will be used by the host team to communicate with the teams sending entries.
- Must submit to the host team a standard data entry file either on a disk or via e-mail, depending on the requirements of the host team. It is assumed that in the future, e-mail will be the standard communication tool for meet entries. The New England Swimming board has approved a surcharge of \$0.50 per entry for entries that have to be entered by hand. This surcharge becomes effective January 1, 2001
- Must submit a hard copy of the entry to the host team. This should be sent with the disk or if e-mail was used to send the original entry the hard copy should be mailed by the next business day. This is to ensure that the file sent was correct and to provide a hard copy of the entry for the meet manager.

Help is available

The committee realizes that these requirements will be new to some of the teams running meets this season and to some of the smaller teams entering meets. Members of the committee have agreed to be available to answers questions as needed to implement these changes

Option to buy Hy-Tek Products at reduced rates

Hy-Tek Team Manager and Meet Manager have become the predominate meet and team management programs in this country and in New England. Most of the major meets in New England are run using Hy-Tek software and a majority of our teams use their team manager products. The products have performed well and are continually being improved. It is the recommendation of this committee, endorsed by the board of directors, that New England Swimming recommend the use of the Hy-Tek swimming products to their member teams. This provides the opportunity for teams in the New England LSC to purchase the Hy-Tek swimming products at a substantial discount. The board wishes to make it clear that the use of Hy-Tek software is not required to run meets in this district and that there are other swimming data management products available. TECHNICAL COMMITTEE REPORT

The following recommendations of the Technical Committee were approved by the Board of New England Swimming on September 12, 2000.

SUBSIDIES FOR CHAMPIONSHIP MEETS: The Board approved the following schedule of subsidies to teams running Championship Meets. The subsidies will be in effect as of this short course season and will be paid to the team running the meet after all appropriate paperwork has been submitted.

The Board also voted that sanction fees be waived for teams running Championship Meets. The sanction request must still be completed, however, and the \$200 deposit would be required.

SCRATCH POLICY AT LONG COURSE 13 and over CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The Board voted to accept the recommendation of the Technical Committee concerning a scratch policy for Long Course 13 and over Championships (a timed finals meet). A check-in or scratch system will take place before warm-ups at each session of the long course 13 and over championships. The meet will be deck seeded. Once the session has been seeded, if a swimmer is a no-show, unless excused by the referee, the swimmers will be out of the rest of the meet, including relays and time trials. Details for the system will be worked out by the Age Group Chairman in conjunction with the meet director, and the policy will be stated in the meet announcement.

Top Ten Times are compiled using results from New England calendar meets held during the past year. Short course (25 yard) times run from June 1, 1999 through May 31, 2000; long course (50 meter) times run from October 1, 1999 through September 30, 2000. The distance events that were added to the 12 & under Age Group Championships this year are not included this year, but will be next year.

In addition to the New England sanctioned calendar meets, we also use times from out of district sanctioned meets if the results are sent to the office and if the meet is open to all USA Swimmers. We consider all times from the meet--trials, finals, and swim-offs--except time trials. We also consider lead-off splits from individual events and relays when they are printed in the results.

We do not include meets that are closed--restricted to certain teams, league members, etc. For this reason, we do not consider high school meets, "Y" meets, etc.

OUTSTANDING SWIMMERS are those who have accumulated the most points through their top ten standings. The scoring is as follows.

STANDING: 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 POINTS :: 12 9 8 7 6 5 4 3 2 1

TOP TEN BOOKS will be sent to all New England teams as soon as they are ready. Books will be available for purchase at the banquet for \$2.50 for each season or by mail for \$3.00 each, including postage.

REPORT OF OCCURRENCE FORM:

Included in this newsletter is the most recent "Report of Occurrence" form from USA Swimming. It is extremely important to complete a "Report of Occurrence" form for all accidents and injuries, no matter how small.

- * It protects the coach and the club in the event of a lawsuit; without one the coach and club are exposed and could lose their personal assets.
- * It triggers USA Swimming to send the athlete's parents a claim form, thereby paying for the medical expenses incurred by the athlete.
- * It gives USA Swimming a vehicle to identify accident trends and adjust our programs to educate coaches and athletes on safety issues.
- * It alerts the insurance company in the event that they have to interview witnesses quickly. Lawsuits take years to make their way through the court system; memories fade over time. It's important to interview the witnesses as soon as possible.
- * We can help companies design safer aquatic products.
- * It won't raise insurance premiums—the premium is the same for all 2,800 USA Swimming clubs.

EDUCATION REQUIREMENT FOR NEW COACHES:

There has been some confusion concerning the new education requirement for new coaches. Coaches who were registered in 1998 or earlier are "grandfathered." Coaches who were first registered as coaches in 1999 or 2000 must complete the education requirement before they register for 2001. Coaches who are registering for the first time in 2001 (the current registration year) must complete the education requirement before they reregister for 2002. Although these new coaches do not have to complete the education requirement until they reregister in 2001, they must possess current CPR, First Aid, and Safety Training for Swim Coaches before registering for 2001.

Up until recently, the tests have been sent to all new coaches by ASCA. At the present time, the test is being revised. Once it is revised, the tests will be sent out to new New England coaches by the office. After the first of the year, if you need a test, please contact the New England Office.
