New England Swimming places a high priority on offering you, it's members, the highest quality championship meets possible. Not only are we driven by the goal of serving the needs of our member teams, swimmers, coaches, and volunteers, we also **depend** on you and the responsibilities commensurate with your membership to help us provide quality experiences.

As you may be aware, New England Swimming has found it increasingly difficult over the past few years to secure a venue that is suitable for hosting our Age Group Championship meets. Much of this difficulty has stemmed from our past treatment of facilities and regard for facility rules. Several potential venues have withdrawn themselves from consideration as meet sites because they do not feel that the "wear and tear" on their facility warrants the rental fees or good-will that might be generated from the meet.

I am asking everyone to lend a hand in cleaning-up the reputation of our championship meets by encouraging their teams to take ownership and pride in the responsibilities that go along with any championship participation. I am also asking that each team become particularly aware of specific facility rules regarding **food on deck, locker room cleanliness, spectator area cleanliness, and restricted areas of campus and building facilities**. I believe that through this concerted and cooperative effort we, together, can convince facilities that our championships are not only worth hosting, but are desirable.

Thank you for your cooperation. Good luck at the meets.

SEED CARDS: Seed Cards are available through the New England Office. The cost for plain cards is \$22 per thousand, including mailing. If the cards are picked up in Needham, the cost is \$19 per thousand. There is no minimum, and the cards may be split any way between boys and girls.

If you want initials on the cards, the price for 1,000 cards is \$31, including mailing. If the cards are picked up in Needham, the cost is \$28. If you want 2,000 or more cards with initials, the cost is \$26 per thousand, including mailing, or \$23 per thousand if the cards are picked up in Needham. The minimum order for cards with initials is 1,000 cards.

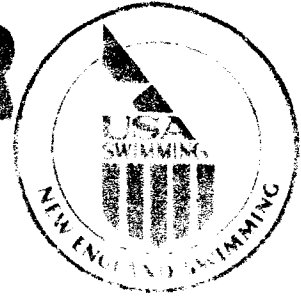

REIMBURSEMENT POLICY, 1996—1997:

A New England registered swimmer who swims in an individual event at Junior Nationals will be reimbursed \$150 by New England Swimming. A New England registered swimmer who swims in an individual event at the US Open will be reimbursed \$150 by New England Swimming. A New England registered swimmer who swims in an individual event at Senior Nationals will be reimbursed \$300 by New England Swimming. A New England registered swimmer who swims in an individual event at the Olympic Trials will be reimbursed \$300 by New England Swimming. There will be no limit either for the number of meets or the amount of money to be reimbursed to a swimmer.

During the short course season a swimmer must fully participate in three New England calendar meets to be eligible for reimbursement. During the long course season a swimmer must fully participate in two New England calendar meets to be eligible for reimbursement. "Full participation" means participation in all or at least two days of competition and at least one event at each day of participation.

If the New England Senior Championships is in place with a named facility by a certain date (90 days preceding the first day of the meet for long course; 120 days preceding the first day of the meet for short course), mandatory participation in the Senior meet is required in order for a swimmer to receive reimbursement. The New England Board may waive this requirement for good cause, such as illness or conflict with a National Team requirement.

A swimmer must request the reimbursement within eight weeks of the meet. The request must include the stub from the swimmer's plane ticket or receipt of other expenses.

To be eligible for reimbursement an athlete must have been registered in New England and have competed in a New England calendar meet at least six months prior to the meet for which reimbursement has been requested.

A swimmer who does not participate in three New England calendar meets during short course season may request a waiver for a championship meet during that season only if he/she participates in three New England calendar meets during the long course season. A swimmer who does not participate in two New England calendar meets during the long course season may request a waiver for a championship meet during that season only if he/she participates in three New England calendar meets during the short course season. All requests for waivers will be considered following the long course season.

TOP TEN BANQUET: The Top Ten Banquet will be held on Sunday, November 3, 1996 at The Mill House, 810 Merrimack Avenue (route 110), Dracut, MA. From Route 93 take exit 46, Route 110 Dracut-Lowell; the restaurant is 3.5 miles on the right with the banquet entrance in the rear.

TOP TEN: Please share the Top Ten information in this newsletter with your team as soon as possible. Encourage your team members to make reservations as soon as possible. In the past we have filled up before the deadline.

Top Ten Times are compiled using results from New England meets held during the past year. Short course (25-yard) times run from June 1, 1995 through May 31, 1996; long course (50-meter) times run from October 1, 1995 through September 30, 1996.

In addition to New England sanctioned calendar meets, we also use times from out of district sanctioned meets if the results are sent to the office and if the meet is open to all USS swimmers. We consider all times from the meet--trials, finals and swim-offs--but we do not use time trials. We also consider lead-off splits from individual events and relays when they are printed in the results.

We do not include meets that are closed--restricted to certain teams, league members, etc. For this reason we do not consider high school meets, "Y" meets, etc.

OUTSTANDING SWIMMERS are those who have accumulated the most points through their top ten standings. The scoring is as follows:

STANDING: 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10

POINTS : 12 9 8 7 6 5 4 3 2 1

TOP TEN BOOKS will be sent to all New England teams as soon as they are ready. Books will be available for purchase at the banquet for \$2.50 each season or by mail for \$3.00 each, including postage.

***1650 YARD FREESTYLE:**

Entries in the 1650 yard freestyle may be limited to two heats per sex and age group, or eight heats total. 1650 yard freestyle events may be combined at the discretion of the meet organizer and referee. In the event that swimmers are cut from the 1650 yard freestyle, they may indicate their desire to be placed on the waiting list for that event. Wait-listed swimmers will be given the opportunity to swim if space is available due to scratches.

AUTOMATIC QUALIFYING TIMES:

All swimmers entering with automatic qualifying times will be guaranteed an opportunity to swim. There are no "cut-out" or maximum qualifying times for District Championships. A swimmer entering District Championships with an automatic qualifying time may not swim the same event at Bronze Classic

CONSIDERATION QUALIFYING TIMES:

We anticipate that most, if not all, swimmers entering with consideration times will have the opportunity to swim at District Championships. If a particular session is oversubscribed, swimmers entering with consideration times may be cut by entry time, slowest to fastest, on a district-by-district basis. **A swimmer entering an event at District Championships with a consideration time MAY ENTER the same event at Bronze Classic**

Times for District Meets may date from September 1, 1996.

NEW ENGLAND SWIMMING RULES FOR SANCTIONS, APPROVALS & COVERED COMPETITION

Sanctions: All USS Teams running invitational meets with other USS Teams must be sanctioned. Cost \$15.00 a day, plus \$200.00 deposit.
Time trials in conjunction with an invitational meet must have a separate sanction. Cost \$15.00 one time fee (could be for three days of time trials).
Camps: Run in New England - \$15.00
 Swim-a-thons - must be sanctioned - no charge.
 Dual meets, tri-meets etc. - do not have to be sanctioned if all people are USS registered. If an OVC might be required, then they must be sanctioned.

 All swimmers and coaches must be USS registered.

There are no dual meet league blanket sanctions.

Approved: A non-USS Team inviting USS Teams to their meet. Approved for insurance only for USS members. They must be accompanied by a USS Coach member. USS rules and regulations must be followed. Cost: \$15.00 (any number of days)
Covered: A USS Team inviting non USS Teams to participate in competition. All participants who are non USS must obtain and sign a release form obtained from USS Swimming, 1 Olympic Plaza, Colorado Springs, CO. 80909-5770. Phone no. 719-578-4578. Fax - 719-578-4669. These forms must be filled out before the meet takes place.

These request should include the **application for sanction**. These are given out when a team is notified they have been awarded a meet. They can also be obtained from Mary Riddell, 20 Cleveland Rd., Needham, Ma. 02192. **Also included should be a draft of the meet information. No meet information should be mailed out without a sanction number on it.** Once the draft has been received and checked, then a sanction number will be issued by mail. **This number should appear on all meet information.**

Time Trials: If a team is considering a time trial not in conjunction with a meet, then at least two teams must be involved with at least five swimmers on each team. The cost is \$15.00. Information on what teams are attending and the events being run, and the officials who will officiating must be sent in writing to Isabelle Fraser at the above address.

Observed Swims: This is for High School and College Championships. Anyone who thinks they need officials for these meets should contact the New England Office. These must be set up well in advance - there is no charge.

REMEMBER - NO OVC'S CAN BE WRITTEN UNLESS A SANCTION HAS BEEN OBTAINED.

SEED CARDS: Seed Cards are available through the New England Office. The cost for plain cards is \$22 per thousand, including mailing. If the cards are picked up in Needham, the cost is \$19 per thousand. There is no minimum, and the cards may be split any way between boys and girls.

If you want initials on the cards, the price for 1,000 cards is \$31, including mailing. If the cards are picked up in Needham, the cost is \$28. If you want 2,000 or more cards with initials, the cost is \$26 per thousand, including mailing, or \$23 per thousand if the cards are picked up in Needham. The minimum order for cards with initials is 1,000 cards.
