On-Deck Training Record: Phase Two (Partnership Phase) Trainee continues to stand in uniform on-deck with a certified official, but now the trainee raises his/her hand when s/he sees a call and then describes to the trainer what was seen and why s/he would make a call. The certified official is the only one who can make an actual call during this time-if the certified official does not raise his/her hand there is no call. During Phase Two the trainee grows in understanding, ability and confidence through the training partnership. Phase Two Training Time: 16-18 hours minimum. Phase Two does not end until the trainee and trainer feel comfortable in the trainee's understanding and application of the USA Swimming Rules and regulations.
