

Utah Swimming is in need of Officials

Teams should provide 1 official per 20 swimmers on their team.

To become an official you must:

- 1) Attend a clinic and take an open-book test designed to familiarize you with the stroke rules in the first few pages of the rulebook.
- 2) Complete the on-line paperwork of registration and back-ground check, and view the Athlete Protection video.
- 3) Complete on-deck training in calling stroke violations (a total of 24 hours with another official assisting)

Clinics for new Stroke & Turn Officials generally run from 6:30 to about 9:00

The next clinics are scheduled to be held at the following dates and locations:

October 13th at 1550 Indian Hills Drive at the Gontrum residence
