

## **EMAC FALL INVITE PRE-MEET COMMUNICATION**

### **SPECTATORS PERMITTED**

- Spectators will enter the building through doors 93, 94, 95 (refer to video walkthrough). Officials, Volunteers, and Coaches: see below in SafeSport Considerations. Admission will be \$5.00, children under 10 are free. Volunteers and officials are free.
- Spectators must always wear a mask while inside the facility, except when eating.
- While inside the building, spectators will have access to bathrooms and a snack bar via the hallway directly adjacent to the stands. (refer to video walkthrough)
- Heat sheets will only be provided if there is a failure to publish meet via MeetMobile.
- Note below that your swimmer will not have access to the snack bar.

### **SWIMMER ENTRANCE AND SEATING**

Swimmers will enter the pool via doors 90, 91, 92 (refer to video walkthrough). Swimmers are asked to bring their own deck chairs. The deck has been cleared and there is ample space for swimmers provided they have their own deck chairs. Deck chairs that are rusty or muddy may be removed to preserve the cleanliness and integrity of the deck surface.

### **COVID PROTOCOLS**

#### **Self Assessment**

Every swimmer, volunteer, coach, and spectator should do a self-assessment prior to coming to the facility, asking themselves the following questions:

1. Do you have a fever over 100 degrees F?
2. Do you have a cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing that is not normal for you?
3. Have you tested positive for COVID-10 within the past 14 days?

4. Have you been recommended for quarantine because of exposure to someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19?
5. Are you currently awaiting COVID-19 test results?
6. Are you aware of yourself being in close contact with someone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19?

### **Mask Usage**

Every swimmer, volunteer, coach, and spectator must wear a mask while in the building. Swimmers are allowed to remove masks only to swim.

Swimmers should bring a plastic baggie or other means to hold their masks while they are swimming.

### **SAFESPORT CONSIDERATIONS**

Facility rules during COVID restrict access to school hallways and bleachers from the pool area during events. Therefore, swimmers will only be able to access the pool area and the locker rooms, which will be locked from the school hallway side to restrict access to the locker rooms from the school.

Officials, volunteers, and coaches will access the pool via doors 90, 91, 92 (prefer to walkthrough) and will have access to hallway bathroom, separate from locker room.

No adult is permitted into the locker rooms per SafeSport regulations.

Only adults who have signed up for a volunteer position are permitted on-deck.
