



SFY TSUNAMI 6 & UNDER SWIMMER POLICY

SUSSEX FAMILY Y

Responsible Adult

- A Responsible Adult is a parent, guardian, or other adult predesignated by a child's parent or guardian;
- A Responsible Adult must be present in the branch and reachable by coaching staff during the entirety of any practice or other team event attended by an SFY Tsunami Team member who is aged 6 & under.
- If a Responsible Adult who has not previously been designated as such, the coaching staff must be notified prior to the start of practice.

Locker-room Policy

- Once the swimmer has been picked up, they may go get changed in their respective locker rooms as dictated by the in-branch locker room policy for children 6 & under.
- The SFY coaching staff is only responsible for program participants during the designated practice times of the program participant.

Restroom Policy

- Program participants 6 & under may not leave the pool deck during or after a practice session without a Responsible Adult.
- Coaching staff is unable to attend to restroom needs of athletes; children 6 & under must be accompanied to the restroom by a Responsible Adult who must be available during all Team events and practices.

It is imperative that our SFY parents arrive on time to pick up their swimmer(s). Many of our coaches work with multiple groups. No exceptions can or will be made to this rule. This policy has been implemented for the safety and security of our entire SFY Swimming family and in compliance with the Safe Sport Act. This policy is subject to revision as needed to ensure proper safety oversight.

By reviewing this policy at the time of swim team sign up, each swimmer's parent or legal guardian acknowledges, understands, and will follow the policies and procedures that pertain to drop off and pick up procedures for program participants at the Sussex Family YMCA. **Failure to adhere to this policy may result in additional program fees as well as suspension and/or removal from the program.**
