



VOLUNTEERS MAKE SWIM TEAM HAPPEN!

As a gentle reminder to all our families... swim meets are run completely by our amazing parent volunteers. Even the folks wearing the white polo shirts (officials) are volunteer parents and they are not compensated for the many hours that they put in supporting all our athletes. Many hands make light work, so please consider supporting the entire youth swimming community by being a timer, herder, official, or filling another key role. Our SFY coaching community understands that family dynamics may make it challenging to fulfill one of these roles (younger siblings attending the meet, etc.), but any help is much appreciated.

Typically, a 'job sign up' is posted on the event page of each competition SFY participates in. Please sign up for a job for each meet you attend. At home meets it is expected that at least one non-swimmer volunteer from each family will participate in helping to run the meet. At away meets the team needs volunteers to assist our younger swimmers in getting to their events on time and we are asked to provide timers on deck as well.

As part of the volunteer process is the Y of Delaware requirement that all volunteers complete Safe Sport training; it is expected that at least one adult for each family will have completed the Safe Sport training prior to our first seasonal meet. Training is provided by the Y at no cost to our Tsunami families.
