Welcome to the 2019-20 Season!

The coaching staff is looking forward to the start of a new swim season. Practice will be starting in September. Within the first couple of weeks of the season, the Board and coaching staff will be providing lots of information about the season. Most of this information is already available on the website.

The <u>2019-20 tentative Meet Schedule</u> is already posted to the website so you can start making plans for swim meet weekends. Some meet announcements and event files are already posted, so log on to the website and commit. The rest will get posted as they become available from meet hosts. If you are unsure of what events to enter, please ask your child's coach.

You'll also receive an email from me with a link to be able to upload any pictures you might want to share with the team. We use these pictures for our website, social media, advertising, and for an awesome slideshow at our end of year banquet.

The team runs around 7 meets per season in addition to attending other swim meets that the team does not run. It takes approximately 40 volunteers (parents and officials) to run a swim meet session. Most of our meets are 2-3 sessions per day so if you do the math, we need a lot of volunteers. We are counting on all of you to uphold our tradition of hosting great swim meets because we have great volunteers!

New "Safe Sport" Rules

USA Swimming's top priority continues to be keeping our athletes safe. As a part of a continued commitment to safeguarding our athletes, USA Swimming has enacted enhancements to our Safe Sport policy and education requirements. LAC is subject to these policies and is committed to implementing and enforcing them.

Whether your family is new to the sport, or if you've been part of the LAC family for years, please take some time to understand new national-level policies that are in place to protect our athletes.

The new policies apply to "Applicable Adults", defined as:

- USA Swimming non-athlete members (coaches and officials) and, in some situations, swimmers over 18;
- On deck volunteers (e.g. meet marshals, meet computer operators, timers, etc.);
- Board members; and
- Any other adult with regular contact and authority over minor athletes.

<u>The Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy</u> (MAAPP) has five parts, this article covers the first two:

1. <u>One-on-One Interactions with Athletes</u>. Any interaction between an Applicable Adult and a swimmer, must be both observable and interruptible by another adult. Coaches, Board Members and Officials must ensure any one-on-one interactions with (non-family member) swimmers are both observable and interruptible. Adults volunteering on-deck (timing, computer operator, etc.) must also ensure interactions with swimmers are observable and interruptible.

2. <u>Social Media and Electronic Communications</u>. Any communications between an Applicable Adult and a minor athlete should be open, transparent. Additionally, electronic communications between an Applicable Adult and a minor athlete must involve the minor's legal guardian and take place during reasonable hours (between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m.).

Coaches, Board Members and Officials are not permitted to engage in email, phone or text message communication directly with swimmers unless the swimmer's parent/guardian is included in the conversation. As a general rule of thumb, please have your swimmers refrain from email or texting coaches.

Coaches, Board Members and Officials are not permitted to "follow", "friend" or otherwise connect with athletes on Social Media. Similarly, swimmers are not permitted to "follow", "friend" or otherwise connect with Coaches, Board Members or Officials on Social Media. Existing social media connections must be removed.

Upcoming Meets

Sept. 29 – LAC Intrasquad Meet, Lancaster PA

Held at Franklin & Marshall, this is a fully sanctioned meet only for LAC swimmers. We will offer each stroke and an IM event to get some times as we start the season. This meet also offers a great opportunity for parents to learn the jobs that go into running a meet. <u>Details here</u>.

Oct. 5 – EST 13 & Over Invite, Owings Mills, MD

For Senior and Senior Prep swimmers, this one-day meet is a quick and fun event, with only four or five other teams and no qualifying times. <u>Details here</u>.

Oct. 5-6 – WSY October Invite, Mechanicsburg, PA

For swimmers not attending the EST meet, this is West Shore YMCA hosted meet is held at Cumberland Valley High School. Caution... spectator seating is limited to 375 and is strictly enforced. This is an early season meet with no qualifying times. <u>Details here</u>.

Oct. 20 – Dual Meet w/ HAC, Lancaster, PA

Held at Franklin & Marshall, this is a dual meet with Hershey Aquatic Club. Every LAC swimmer (from 5 to 18 years old) is welcome at this meet. This meet has no qualifying times. <u>Details here</u>.

Nov. 2 – SSC Musical Mini-Meet, Newtown Square, PA A fun, no pressure meet for 8 & under swimmers with no

qualifying times at Suburban Swim Club. Details to follow.

Nov. 8-10 – Thanksgiving Invite, Mechanicsburg, PA For swimmers 9 years and over, this is West Shore YMCA hosted meet is held at Cumberland Valley High School. Caution... spectator seating is limited to 375 and is strictly enforced. This meet has no qualifying times. <u>Details here</u>.

Nov. 16 - Tri Meet w/ HAC and CYA, York, PA

Held at Central York, this is a tri-meet with Hershey Aquatic Club and Central York Aquatics. With a focus on ages 5 through 14, this meet has no qualifying times. Details here.

Dec. 6-8 – NLAC Winter Splash, University Park, PA

Held at Penn State by the Nittany Lion Aquatic Club, this meet is recommended for 9 & over swimmers who are not likely to meet qualifying times for the LAC co-hosted Arena Holiday Cup. This meet has no qualifying times. Details here.

Dec. 7-8 – NLAC Winter Mini Meet, University Park, PA Held at Penn State by the Nittany Lion Aquatic Club, in conjunction with the above meet, this is a good experience for 8 & under swimmers in a larger format meet. This meet has no qualifying times. <u>Details here</u>.

Dec. 13-15 – LAC Arena Holiday Cup, Lancaster, PA This meet has very fast qualifying times. LAC co-hosts this premier meet with Franklin & Marshall College. But LAC parent volunteers are still needed to help out on deck and in hospitality. <u>Details here</u>.



LAC's Most Critical Volunteer Need: Operational Risk Director (ORD)

Our team, like any swim team, runs on volunteers. Many volunteer jobs require little or no training. Some others require an extensive certification process. Operational Risk Director (ORD) is one that requires a background check and a process for certification. We currently have three ORDs, but we need at least three more.

We need an ORD present on deck for every session of every swim meet. The ORD's job is to ensure a safe environment and assist the Meet Referee/Meet Director in making sure swimmers, coaches, officials and volunteers are not doing anything to compromise the safety of athletes.

The certification process is not difficult, simply:

- 1. Let Greg Spaulding or Sam Kieffer know you're interested in becoming an ORD.
- 2. Register for non-athlete membership for the 2020 season (the club will reimburse after certification).
- 3. Participate in an on-line clinic
- 4. Take and Pass the online test
- 5. Pass Background Check (the club will reimburse after certification)
- 6. Complete Athlete Protection Training (online)
- 7. Apprentice 4 sessions under a certified ORD
- 8. Submit completed Apprentice Form to Middle Atlantic for certification

The Arena Carbonics suit has been selected for the 2019-20 season, the suit comes in both back styles, jammers and briefs. In addition to the Carbonics suit, the Arena Madison style suit has also been selected for female swimmers. The Madison suit comes in a solid color with a higher neck line and thicker straps. You are not required to purchase both the Carbonics suit and the Madison suit for female swimmers.

Tech suits will be ordered on a separate date in October, that date and time will be released at a later date. <u>Swimmers under 10 years of age should not order Tech</u><u>Suits.</u>

If you miss the team store or the team suit order, we will be offering additional order dates in October. You WILL NOT be able to order caps with the October order.
