

Meet Surcharge Policy

To help cover team travel expenses for swim meets, CMA imposes a “meet surcharge” to all swimmers participating in swim meets.

The surcharges vary, depending on the length and location of the meet:

- \$10 per swimmer for single-day meets within Maine
- \$15 per swimmer, for multi-day meets within Maine, except for JOs and Bowdoin Open.
- \$35 per swimmer for JOs and Bowdoin Open.
- \$35 per swimmer for out-of-state meets with 10 or more CMA swimmers attending.
- For out-of-state meets with less than 10 CMA swimmers attending, the families of attending swimmers equally share the travel expenses for the coach (transportation, hotel, meals); for a maximum cost of \$250. per swimmer.

Meet surcharges are automatically billed to your account at the time the meet entries are finalized, in the same way that heat fees currently are.

A separate surcharge is not imposed each day of multi-day meets, but instead the surcharge covers the entire meet. Swimmers must pay the entire multi-day surcharge, even if they are planning only to swim one day of a multi-day meet.
