

**PRIVATE SWIM LESSONS
AT THE JENISON HS
AQUATICS CENTER
Pool Closed August 2-10, 2021**



We will not be offering any group swim lessons this summer, unfortunately.

Private swim lessons are available for all ages, abilities, and residency. Semi-private Lessons for those residing within the same household will be available. More information below on semi-private lessons.

Location: Swim lessons are held at the Jenison Aquatics Center, located at Jenison High School, 2140 Bauer Road. Enter the large, student parking lot on the west side of the high school building. Drive along the high school building toward the football stadium. The main pool lobby doors and balcony will be locked. Enter the pool through the "D55" door to the south of the pool lobby entrance. The "D55" door will be propped open ten minutes before lessons begin. Please remove your outdoor shoes immediately upon entering the pool deck and bring a clean pair to change into (or plan to go barefoot). Swimmers may get dropped off/picked up at the "D55" door for lessons or one parent/guardian per swimmer is welcome to stay on the pool deck bleachers masked up to observe. If the parent is a detriment to the child's ability to focus on the instructor, he or she may be asked to leave the facility for the duration of the lesson. All children must exit promptly after their lesson. Please do not remain parked on the drop off/pick up curb for an entire lesson. If you plan to stay through a lesson we ask that you use a parking spot.



Locker Room Use: Our locker rooms are currently closed. Swimmers must arrive in their suits and leave in their suits. Swimmers should find a space for their bag/belongings on the bleachers and get ready for their lesson on deck socially distanced from other private lesson participants. Locker rooms will only be available for showering before entering the water and for using the bathroom.

COVID-19 Health and Safety Precautions: In order to maintain social distancing all private swim lessons will be held to a one student to one instructor ratio (semi-private swim lesson information below). Swimmers must wear a mask until they enter the water. There are hooks on both ends of the facility to hook your mask while you enter the water. Instructors will utilize a face shield and/or mask during instruction. The accompanying parent or guardian must wear a mask the entire time while in the Jenison HS Aquatics Center. Instructors will not tolerate those who are not wearing masks properly and following the Covid-19 Health and Safety precautions of our facility. We have hand sanitizing pumps all over the pool area for your use.

The success of our Return-To-Swim plan requires a team effort. This means swimmers, instructors, and parents/guardians, will need to follow the plan and help others adhere to the plan. It is an expectation

that everyone does their part, practices social distancing, and maintains proper hygiene at all times. Should any member not adhere to these guidelines their participation in lessons may be suspended. Following these guidelines will help to protect everyone as well as ensure our continued use of the pool.

By entering the pool you are verifying that you do not have and have not had any of the following symptoms in the last 14 days:

- Uncontrolled cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Loss of taste or loss of smell
- Temperature equal to or higher than 100.4
- Signs of fever (chills/sweating)
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain
- Muscle aches
- Fatigue
- Headache

If your child has tested positive for COVID-19 email Nicole immediately (nvos@jpsonline.org).

General Information: Water temperature is approximately 80-81 degrees. The cost for four - 25 minute private swim lessons is \$75/Jenison school district resident or School of Choice (SOC) and \$80/non Jenison school district resident. Each set of private lessons are assigned a certain start time on four specific days. Dates and details are below. A refund less \$10 will be granted up to three business days prior to the start of class. Any refund requests made less than three business days prior to the start of the first class will not be granted. In addition to any medical information we need please write your intentions for the private lessons in the "Medical Information/Notes" section when signing up. Examples include: swim team prep, water safety and comfort, complete JPS Swim Lessons Level 2, complete JPS Swim Lessons Level 3, focus on head first entry dive, focus on rotary breathing, etc.

The only exception to the 1:1 ratio is semi-private lessons for anyone residing within the same household. Semi-private lessons may accommodate up to two additional at \$50 per swimmer (max total of three per lesson). You must email Nicole at nvos@jpsonline.org to add additional swimmers who reside within the same household. Please include name, age, and intentions for the private lesson. She will manually enter and bill your account accordingly.

How to Register: Online registration (only) will open on Wednesday, May 26, at 6pm, on our aquatics website: www.jenisonaquatics.org. From the main page, click on the "Private Swim Lessons" tab at the top. CLICK on "Private Swim Lessons" again half way down the page. From here you will see the class options and you need to click "Register" on the class of your choice. Private lesson slots are very limited; and enrollment is on a first come, first serve basis. Any classes added during the summer schedule will

be emailed to the families on our swim lesson mass email list. To have your name and email added to this list for all future lessons, email nvos@jpsonline.org.
