

**BBD Day After Meet**  
**Hosted By: Birmingham Blue Dolphins**  
**November 23, 2014**

<b>Sanction:</b>	This meet is sanctioned by Michigan Swimming, Inc. (MS), as a Timed Finals meet on behalf of USA Swimming (USA-S), Sanction Number <b>MI1415042</b> . In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event. MS rules, safety, and warm up procedures will govern the meet as if fully set forth in these meet rules.
<b>Location:</b>	Location: Cranbrook Schools Williams Natatorium 550 Lone Pine Road Bloomfield Hills, MI 48304
<b>Times:</b>	Sunday AM: Warm Up Starts: 8:00 AM Events Begin: 9:00 AM
<b>Motels:</b>	N/A
<b>Facilities:</b>	Williams Natatorium, is an 8 lane pool with a supervised warm-up and warm down area available. Depth at start is 12' and 4' at turn. Permanent starting blocks and non-turbulent lane markers will be used. List type of timing system with an 8 lane display will be used. There is ample balcony seating for spectators. Lockers are available (provide your own lock). Public phones will be available. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4).

<b>Eligibility:</b>	BBD Day After Meet is for those swimmers with "A" times or faster. All swimmers must be currently registered with United States of America Swimming (USA-S). A swimmer's age on November 23, 2014 will determine his/her eligibility for a particular age group.
<b>Deck Registration:</b>	Unregistered swimmers must register on deck at this meet by turning in the athlete registration form and payment to the Meet Referee. The cost of registering on deck is double the normal fee (\$132.00 per swimmer for 2014-15 registration).
<b>Meet Format:</b>	Time Trial/One Session/Three Rounds
<b>Entry Limits:</b>	Swimmers may swim up to 5 individual events. There is no limit on the number of relays.
<b>Swimmers Without A Coach:</b>	Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA-S member coach, must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
<b>Individual Entry Limits:</b>	Swimmers may swim up to 5 individual events.
<b>Paper Entries:</b>	\$7.00 per individual event and \$12.00 for relays. Please include a \$1.00 Michigan Swimming surcharge for each swimmer entered. Make checks payable to: <b>BBD</b> .
<b>Entry Procedures:</b>	Entry into this meet is by deck entry only. Coaches will be required to sign the Release and Waiver form and the Certification of Registration form which are at the end of this document. Parents of swimmers will be expected to sign these if the coach is not present. It will speed up the entry process if these would be completed prior to arriving at the entry table.
<b>Refunds:</b>	Once a team or individual entry has been received and processed by the entry chair there are no refunds in full or in part unless the "over qualification exception" applies (see MS Rules).

<b>Check In:</b>	N/A
<b>Scratch Rules:</b>	A swimmer may scratch events at any time at the Clerk of Course
<b>Marshaling:</b>	This meet will be self-marshalled. Lane cards will be distributed to the athletes before they swim.
<b>Seeding:</b>	Seeding will be done after each session's entries close.
<b>Deck Entries/ Time Trials:</b>	This is a deck entry only meet. For deck entries, registration status must be proven by providing a current USA Swimming membership card or a current print out of an athlete roster from the Club Portal, the Club Portal is located on the USA Swimming website. The athlete may also enter by showing their membership from USA Swimming's DECK PASS on a smart phone. Name, athlete ID and club affiliation should then be added to your database just as it appears on the card or list or the swimmer may compete unattached (UN) if they request to do so.
<b>Meet Programs/ Admissions:</b>	No Program or Admission Fees.
<b>Scoring:</b>	Not a scored meet.
<b>Awards:</b>	Awards will not be given for this meet.
<b>Results:</b>	Complete meet results will be posted on the Michigan Swimming Website at <a href="http://www.miswim.org/">http://www.miswim.org/</a> . Results will also be available on flash drive (HY-TEK Team Manager result file) upon request. Teams must provide their own flash drive.
<b>Concessions:</b>	Limited beverages will be available in concessions area on 1st floor. No food or beverage will be allowed on the deck of the pool, in the locker rooms or in the spectator areas. A hospitality area will be available for coaches and officials.

<b>Lost and Found:</b>	Articles may be turned in/picked up at entrance to pool deck. Articles not picked up by the end of the meet will be retained by the Meet Director or a representative for at least 14 days (any longer period shall be in the sole discretion of the Meet Director).
<b>Swimming Safety:</b>	Michigan Swimming warm up rules will be followed. To protect all swimmers during warm-ups, swimmers are required to enter the pool feet first at all times except when sprint lanes have been designated. No jumping or diving. The same rules will apply with respect to the warm-down pool and diving well. Penalties for violating these rules will be in the sole discretion of the Meet Referee which may include ejection from the meet.
<b>Deck Personnel/ Locker Rooms/ Credentialing:</b>	<p>Only registered and current coaches, athletes, officials and meet personnel are allowed on the deck or in locker rooms. Access to the pool deck may only be granted to any other individual in the event of emergency through approval by the Meet Director or the Meet Referee. The General Chair of MS and the Program Operations Vice-Chair of MS are authorized deck personnel at all MS meets. Personal assistants/helpers of athletes with a disability shall be permitted when requested by an athlete with a disability or a coach of an athlete with a disability.</p> <p>Lists of registered coaches, certified officials and meet personnel will be placed outside the door to the pool deck. Meet personnel will check the list of approved individuals and issue a credential to be displayed at all times during the meet. This credential will include the host team logo, "BBD" as well as the function of the individual being granted access to the pool deck (Coach, Official, Timer, or Meet Personnel). In order to obtain a credential, Coaches and Officials must be current in all certifications through the final date of the meet. Meet personnel must return the credential at the conclusion of working each day and be reissued a credential daily.</p> <p>All access points to the pool deck and locker rooms will either be secured or staffed by a meet worker checking credentials throughout the duration of the meet.</p>

<b>Swimmers with Disabilities:</b>	All swimmers are encouraged to participate. If any of your swimmers have special needs or requests please indicate them on the entry form and with the Clerk of Course and/or the Meet Referee during warm ups.
<b>General Info:</b>	Any errors or omissions in the program will be documented and signed by the meet Referee and available for review at the Clerk of Course for Coaches review. Information will also be covered at the Coaches' Meeting.
<b>First Aid:</b>	Supplies will be kept in the control room on deck.
<b>Facility Items:</b>	<p>(A) No smoking is allowed in the building or on the grounds of Williams Natatorium.</p> <p>(B) Pursuant to applicable Michigan law, no glass will be allowed on the deck of the pool or in the locker rooms.</p> <p>(C) No bare feet allowed outside of the pool area. Swimmers need to have shoes to go into the hallway to awards or concessions.</p> <p>(D) An Emergency Action Plan has been submitted by the Host Club to the Safety Chair and the Program Operations Chair of Michigan Swimming prior to sanction of this meet and is available for review and inspection at the Clerk of Course.</p> <p>(E) To comply with USA Swimming privacy and security policy, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.</p> <p>(F) Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and it is <b>prohibited</b>.</p>
