

The Autumn Aquafest ABC Meet
Hosted By: Dearborn Dolphins
NOVEMBER 6 & 7, 2010

- Sanction:** This meet is sanctioned by Michigan Swimming, Inc., as a timed finals meet on behalf of United States Swimming, Sanction Number MI101105 (Time Trial Sanction #MI101106). Michigan Swimming rules, safety, and warm up procedures will govern the meet as if fully set forth in these meet rules.
- Location:** Allen Park High School
18401 Champaign Rd.
Allen Park, MI 48101
(located East of Allen Rd on Champaign. Champaign is located 1/2 mile South of Ecorse Rd -- See Google Maps for precise directions)
- Times:** Saturday & Sunday Morning warm-up: 7:30 AM Events: 8:30 AM
Saturday & Sunday Afternoon warm-up: 12:00 PM or as soon as the AM Session ends, whichever occurs later.
Events: 1:00 PM or 1 hour after the start of warm-ups.
Note: 8 & UNDER, 10 & UNDER, 11-12 BOYS SWIM IN THE MORNING
11-12 GIRLS, 13-14, AND OPEN SWIM IN THE AFTERNOON
- Facilities:** 6 lane pool is 9ft 6in at the start end and 4ft at the turn end with a diving well available for supervised warm up and warm down. Permanent starting blocks and non-turbulent lane markers are in place. The electronic timing system is a Daktronic Timing system with touch pads. The scoreboard has a 6 lane alpha numeric read out. There is bleacher seating for spectators. Lockers are available (bring your own lock). The 25 yard events will be swim from the blocks. Public phone will be available. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2c(4).
- To enter the building you may park in the small front lot, or take the driveway at the East end of the school and drive to the parking lot behind the school. Please enter through door number 13 and follow the signs to the pool.
- Eligibility:** This DRD Meet is for all USS swimmers. All swimmers must be currently registered with United States Swimming (USS). Swimmer's age on October 6, 2010 will determine his/her eligibility for a particular age group. Mixed relays may consist of any combination of boys and girls (all boys/girls or mixed). A swimmer may sign up for a maximum of 5 individual events per day, plus 2 relays.
- Entry Limits:** **Entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis by date of email for electronic entries and date of receipt by the entry chair for hard copy entries until the Michigan Swimming four (4) hour per session maximum time limit is met. As set forth in Entry Procedures below, entries are not deemed valid and will not be processed until such time as the entry chairperson has received: (a) a hard copy of your club's entry summary sheet, (b) a hard copy of your club's signed release/waiver agreement (c) your club's certification of entered athletes and (d) your club's entry and entry fees. Entries received after the four (4) hour per session time limit has been met will be returned even if received before the entry deadline.**
- Individual Entry Limits:** A swimmer may sign up for a maximum of 5 individual events per day, plus 2 relays.
- Electronic Entries:** \$4.00 per individual event and \$12.00 for relays. Please include a \$1.00 Michigan Swimming surcharge for each swimmer entered. Make checks payable to: **Dearborn Dolphins**
- Paper Entries:** Michigan Swimming rules regarding non-electronic entries apply. **There is a \$1.00 additional charge per swimmer per event paid to the Host Club.** There is a \$1.00 additional charge per individual event and \$1.00 per relay event paid if the entry is not submitted on Hy-Tek (or compatible) disk. The Michigan Swimming \$1.00 general surcharge for each swimmer also applies to paper entries. Paper entries may be submitted to the entry chair on a spreadsheet of your choice however the paper entry *must* be logically formatted and must contain all pertinent information to allow the entry chair to easily enter the swimmer(s) in the correct events with correct seed times.

Entry

Procedures: Entries may be submitted to the entry chairperson as of Noon, Saturday, October 9, 2010. The entry chairperson must receive all entries no later than Friday, October 29, 2010. Entries must include swimmer name (no nicknames, official registered names must be used), age and USS number. You can import the order of events and event numbers from the Michigan Swimming website (www.uss-michigan.com). ENTRY TIMES MUST BE SUBMITTED IN YARD TIMES. Entries should be submitted on disk in Hy-Tek format. All individual entries should be submitted via electronic mail to the entry chairperson at mlanegreen@aol.com. Any entries submitted will be not processed until such time as the entry chairperson has received a hard copy of: (a) your club's entries (Team Manager Meet Entries Report), (b) a hard copy of your club's signed release/waiver agreement (c) your clubs signed certification of entered athletes and (d) your club's entry fees. The complete [Name of Meet] entry packet with entry forms is available on the Michigan Swimming Website at www.uss-michigan.com.

Refunds: Once a team or individual entry has been received and processed by the entry chair there are no refunds in full or in part.

Check In: Check In will be available 15 minutes before the start of warm-ups and will close 15 minutes after the start of warm-ups. Check in is mandatory for all events and is required by the time set forth in this meet announcement. Failure to check in will cause the swimmer to be scratched from **all** events in that session. Also note that pursuant to MS Rules that failing to swim an event after checking in for that event will disqualify a swimmer from his or her next event. Check in sheets will be posted in the hall outside the pool.

Scratch Rules: Prior to check in close a swimmer may scratch events at the Clerk of Course. After check in closes, you must see the Meet Referee to scratch an event. Once a swimmer has checked in for an event that swimmer must compete in that event or the swimmer will be scratched from his/her next event.

Marshaling: The meet will be self-marshaled. All swimmers will be expected to find their heat and lane independently. Heats will not be delayed. Heat cards will not be used. Heat sheets will be posted in conspicuous places on deck and distributed to coaches as soon as possible after Check-In.

Seeding: All events are timed finals and will be seeded slowest to fastest. After a swimmer has checked in and is seeded, that swimmer must compete in that event or such swimmer will be scratched from his/her next scheduled event.

Deck Entries/ Time Trials:

Deck entries and/or Time Trials may be accepted at the Clerk of the Course and may swim if time and space permit in the sole discretion of the Meet Referee and Meet Director. Deck entries and Time Trials are \$7 for an individual event. Deck entries are subject to MS surcharge if not already entered in the meet.

Admissions: \$4 per person over the age of 12 on Saturday and Sunday. 12 & under are free. Programs will be \$6.

Scoring: No individual or team scoring will be kept.

Awards: Custom ribbons will be awarded for all divisions (A, B, C) 1st – 6th places. Relay awards will be 1st – 6th place ribbons. **Awards will not be distributed to swimmers; all awards will be given to coaches at the end of the Sunday session -- Awards WILL NOT BE MAILED!**

- Results:** Complete meet results will be posted on the Michigan Swimming Website at www.uss.michigan.com., and also on the Dearborn Dolphins Website at www.swimdrd.org.
- Concessions:** Food and beverages will be available in the Concessions area. No food or beverages will be allowed on the deck of the pool, in the locker rooms or in the spectator areas. A hospitality area will be available for coaches and officials.
- Lost and Found:** Articles may be turned in/picked up at the Awards Table. Articles not picked up by the end of the meet will be retained in the home of the Meet Director for at least 14 days (any longer period shall be in the sole discretion of the Meet Director).
- Swimming Safety:** Michigan Swimming warm-up rules will be followed. To protect all swimmers during warm-ups, swimmers will be required to slip into the pool except when sprint lanes have been designated. Penalties for violating these rules will be in the sole discretion of the meet referee. There will at all times be at least three (3) marshals monitoring during all warm ups. All such marshals will be members of United States Swimming.
- Deck Personnel:** Only swimmers, registered coaches, meet officials, and workers are allowed on the deck. Coaches and officials must display their registration cards at all times. Coaches must be current in all certifications through the final date of the meet.
- Swimmers with Disabilities:** All swimmers are encouraged to participate. If any of your swimmers have special needs or requests please indicate them on the entry form and with the Clerk of Course and/or the Meet Referee during warm ups.
- Info:** Any errors or omissions in the program will be documented and signed by the meet Referees and available for review at the Clerk of Course for Coaches review. Information will also be covered at the Coaches' Meeting.
- First Aid:** Supplies will be kept in Marshalling.
- Facility Items:**
- (A) No smoking is allowed in the building or on the grounds of Allen Park High School.
 - (B) Pursuant to applicable Michigan law, no glass will be allowed on the deck of the pool or in the locker rooms.
 - (C) No bare feet allowed outside of the pool area. Swimmers need to have shoes to go into the hallway to awards or concessions.
 - (D) An Emergency Action Plan has been submitted by the Host Club to the Safety Chair and the Program Operations Chair of Michigan Swimming prior to sanction of this meet and is available for review and inspection at the Computer Tower on Deck.

Certification of Registration Status Of All Entered Athletes Autumn Aquafest

Michigan Swimming Clubs must register and pay for the registration of all athletes that are contained in the electronic TM Entry File or any paper entries that are submitted to the Meet Host with the Office of Michigan Swimming **prior to submitting the meet entry to the meet host**. Clubs from other LSCs must register and pay for the registration of their athletes with their respective LSC Membership Coordinator.

A penalty fee of \$100.00 per unregistered athlete will be levied against any Club found to have **entered** an athlete in a meet without first registering the athlete and paying for that registration with the Office of Michigan Swimming or their respective LSC Membership Coordinator.

Submitting a meet entry without the athlete being registered and that registration paid for beforehand may also subject the Club to appropriate Board of Review sanctions.

The authority for these actions is:

UNITED STATES SWIMMING RULES AND REGULATIONS 302.4 FALSE REGISTRATION – A host LSC may impose a fine of up to \$100.00 per event against a member Coach or a member Club submitting a meet entry which indicates a swimmer is registered with USA Swimming when that swimmer or the listed Club is not properly registered. The host LSC will be entitled to any fines imposed.
