- Sanction:** This meet is sanctioned by Michigan Swimming, Inc., (MS) as a timed final meet on behalf of USA Swimming (USS), Sanction Number MI101179. Michigan Swimming rules, safety and warm-up procedures will govern the meet as if fully set forth in these meet rules.  
(No glass permitted on deck!)

- Facilities:** Jack Dunworth Memorial Pool is 50 meters long, 9 lanes. Pool depth is 5' at start and 4' at turn. Stationary starting blocks and non-turbulent lane markers are in place. Colorado Electronic Timing will be used. Separate warm-up pool (diving well) is available during the meet. There is spacious seating space – bring your own chairs to sit in on deck! The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). THERE IS NO USE OF THE SHALLOW POOL.
- Eligibility:** ~~This DRD Meet is a closed invitational between DRD, LCSC, BAC and PCC. All swimmers must be currently registered with United States Swimming.~~ Swimmer's age on July 16, 2011 will determine his/her eligibility for a particular age group. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- Safety:** To comply with USA Swimming privacy and security policy, NO CELL PHONES WITH CAMERAS OR ANY TYPE OF CAMERA OR VIDEO ARE ALLOWED IN THE LOCKER ROOMS AT ANYTIME.
- Entry Limits:** Per USA Swimming Rules, all swimmers are limited to five (5) individual events per day.
- Entry Fees Electronic:** \$4.00 per individual event. Please include a \$1.00 Michigan Swimming surcharge for each swimmer entered. Make checks payable to Dearborn Dolphins. Email entry files to [MLANEGREEN@AOL.COM](mailto:MLANEGREEN@AOL.COM). Please email them to me no later than July 1 so we can set up our volunteers. **Please email me by Friday, July 15<sup>th</sup> at Noon.**
- Entry Fees Paper Entry:** Michigan Swimming's rules regarding non-electronic entries apply. **There is an additional \$1.00 charge per swimmer per event** paid to the Host Club. The Michigan Swimming \$1.00 surcharge for each swimmer will apply.
- Check In:** Check-In will be available as of 15 minutes prior to the start of warm-ups for each session and will close 15 minutes after the start of warm-ups. Check in is mandatory for all events and is required by the time set forth in this meet announcement. Failure to check in will cause the swimmer to be scratched from **all** events in that session. Check in will be at the Marshalling table located at the north end of the pool deck area.

<b>Marshalling:</b>	<b>THIS IS A SELF-MARSHALED MEET.</b> Heat sheets will be posted for each event at the Marshaling table located at the north end of the pool deck area and will be made available for all coaches at the start of each session. When the events are posted on the Marshaling Board and announced, swimmers and their coaches will be responsible for reporting to the starting block for their assigned heat.
<b>Scratch Rules:</b>	<b>SWIMMERS WHO HAVE NOT CHECKED IN DURING THE TIMES INDICATED ABOVE WILL BE SCRATCHED FROM THAT SESSION'S EVENTS.</b> Per MS rules, any swimmer who is checked in for an event and fails to report for the swimming of that event without informing the Clerk of Course before the event is marshaled forfeits the right to swim his/her next scheduled event. COACHES ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR INSTRUCTING THEIR SWIMMERS ACCORDINGLY.
<b>Seeding:</b>	All events will be seeded from the slowest to fastest times and all events will be timed finals. Please <u>submit meter times</u> for all events, including the 1500m freestyle. <b>Awards:</b>	<b>There are no awards for this meet.</b>
<b>Scoring:</b>	No individual or team scoring will be kept.
<b>Results:</b>	Complete meet results will be posted on the Michigan Swimming Website at <a href="http://www.uss-michigan.com">www.uss-michigan.com</a> , and also on the DRD Website located at <a href="http://www.swimdrd.org">www.swimdrd.org</a> (for one week after the meet). Results will also be available (HY-TEK Team results file) by request in scoring at the end of Sunday's afternoon session. Teams must provide their own flash drive.
<b>Time Trials:</b>	Time Trials will not be allowed.
<b>Concessions:</b>	Concessions will be provided.
<b>Admissions/Programs:</b>	There will be a \$3.00 charge for admission. We will offer heat sheets for sale for \$1.00. Heat Sheets will be available as soon as possible AFTER all the coaches have received their copies.
<b>Lost &amp; Found:</b>	A "Lost & Found" box will be kept at the concessions table. Any unclaimed items will be given to charity two weeks after the end of the meet.
<b>Swimming Safety:</b>	Michigan Swimming warm up rules will be followed. To protect all swimmers during warm-ups, swimmers are required to enter the pool feet first at all times except when sprint lanes have been designated. No jumping or diving. [The same rules will apply with respect to the warmdown pool and diving well]. Penalties for violating these rules will be in the sole discretion of the meet referee which may include ejection from the meet.
<b>Deck Personnel:</b>	Only swimmers, registered coaches and meet officials/workers are allowed in the roped off "on-deck" area. Coaches and officials must display their registration cards at all times. Coaches must be current in all certifications through the final date of the meet.
<b>Swimmers with Disabilities:</b>	All swimmers are encouraged to participate. If any of your swimmers have special needs or requests please indicate them on the entry form and with the Clerk of Course and/or the Meet Referee during warm-ups.

- Info:** Any errors or omissions in the program will be documented and signed by the Meet Referee and available for review at the Clerk of Course for Coaches' review. Information will also be covered at the Coaches' Meeting.
- First Aid:** First aid is available in the lifeguard's room in the main entrance building.
- Facility Items:**
- (a) No smoking is allowed in the building or on the grounds of Jack Dunworth Memorial Pool.
  - (b) Pursuant to applicable Michigan law, no glass will be allowed on the deck of the pool or in the locker rooms.
  - (c) No bare feet allowed outside of the pool area. Swimmers need to have shoes to go into the concession area or the restrooms.
  - (d) An Emergency Action Plan has been submitted by the Host Club to the Safety Chair and the Program Operations Chair of Michigan Swimming prior to sanction of this meet and is available for review and inspection at Jack Dunworth Memorial Pool.

**Submitting a meet entry without the athlete being registered and that registration paid for beforehand may also subject the Club to appropriate Board of Review sanctions.**

**The authority for these actions is:**

UNITED STATES SWIMMING RULES AND REGULATIONS 302.4 FALSE REGISTRATION – A host LSC may impose a fine of up to \$100.00 per event against a member Coach or a member Club submitting a meet entry which indicates a swimmer is registered with USA Swimming when that swimmer or the listed Club is not properly registered. The host LSC will be entitled to any fines imposed.
