Facilities:	<p>The Jenison High School Aquatics Center is an 8-lane 50 meter pool. Seven lanes will be used for competition, and the other lane will be available for supervised warm-up and warm-down. Depth at the start is 13'11" and 4'6" at the turn. Movable starting blocks and non-turbulent lane markers will be used. IST timing with a seven lane display will be used. There is ample balcony seating for spectators. Lockers are available (provide your own lock). The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4).</p> <p>1) We are a NUT FREE Facility. If you or your swimmer has any nut product we will have to discard of it for the safety of one of our swimmers.</p> <p>2) Chairs are not allowed in the walkway of the pool balcony (other than medically necessary chairs in designated areas).</p> <p>3) Coolers are not allowed in the balcony area. <u>You will be required to return your cooler to your car if you try to bring one into the pool balcony.</u></p>
Eligibility:	<p>The ABC spectacular is for all level of swimmers who are currently registered with United States Swimming (USA-S). A swimmer's age on Friday, June 13, 2014, will determine his/her eligibility for a particular age group.</p>
Deck Registration:	<p>Unregistered swimmers must register on deck at this meet by turning in the athlete registration form and payment to the Meet Referee. The cost of registering on deck is double the normal fee (\$124.00 per swimmer for 2014 registration).</p>
Meet Format:	<p>Sun and Fun is a timed final format. Sessions 1 and 4 are 13 & Over sessions swum Friday and Saturday afternoon. Session 2 is a Friday evening distance session with events for all ages. Session 3 and 6 are 12 & Under sessions swum Saturday and Sunday morning. Sessions 5 is a Saturday evening sessions with only the 1500 meter freestyle.</p>
Entry Limits:	<p>Entries will be accepted as of Thursday, May 15, on a first come first serve basis by date of email for electronic entries and date of receipt by the entry chair for hard copy entries until the Michigan Swimming four (4) hour per session maximum time limit is met. Entries received after the four (4) hour per session time limit has been met will be returned <u>even if received before the entry deadline</u>. To balance sessions to meet the four (4) hour per session time limit, the meet host reserves the right to use any reasonable technique including but not limited to splitting age groups and/or splitting teams. If the meet host desires to either split age groups and/or split teams, the contact person of each club entering the meet and each unattached swimmer shall be provided with electronic notification of such change at least ten (10) days prior the date of the meet. Any club that withdraws entries based on such change shall receive a refund of such entry fees.</p> <p>As set forth in entry procedures below, (A) a hard copy of your club's entry summary sheet, (B) a hard copy of your club's signed release/waiver agreement (C) your club's certification of entered athletes and (D) your club's entry and entry fees must be received by the Entry Chair in a timely fashion prior to the start of the meet, or your swimmers will not be allowed to swim in the meet. Entries received after the four (4) hour per session time limit has been met will be returned even if received before the entry deadline.</p>
Swimmers Without A Coach:	<p>Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA-S member coach, must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this</p>

	requirement.
Individual Entry Limits:	<p>Swimmers may enter up to 4 individual events for sessions 1, 3, 4, and 6. The distance events in session 2 and 5 will not count towards the 4 individual events per session limit. However, a swimmer may not exceed five events in a day. All participants in the 1500m Free (session 5) are asked to provide one timer and they may have someone to count. ‘No times’ (NT) will be exhibited and will not be eligible for awards in any events or the IMX Challenge. Coaches must convert SCY and SCM times to long course meters. If times are not converted the swimmer will not be eligible for awards (in any events) but will still be entered into the meet.</p> <p>Deck entries may be accepted if time permits.</p>
Electronic Entries:	\$5.00 per individual event for all timed final events. Please include a \$1.00 Michigan Swimming surcharge for each swimmer entered. Make checks payable to: JAWS.
Paper Entries:	MS rules regarding non-electronic entries apply. \$6.00 per individual event. There is a \$1.00 additional charge per individual event if the entry is not submitted in Hy-Tek format. The Michigan Swimming \$1.00 general surcharge for each swimmer also applies to paper entries. Paper entries may be submitted to the entry chair on a spreadsheet of your choice however the paper entry <i>must</i> be logically formatted and must contain all pertinent information to allow the entry chair to easily enter the swimmer(s) in the correct events with correct seed times.
Entry Procedures:	<p>Entries may be submitted to the entry chairperson as of Thursday, May 15, at 6:00 pm. The entry chairperson must receive all entries no later than Monday, June 2, 2014, 6:00 pm. Entries must include correct swimmer name (as registered with USA/MS Swimming), age and USA number. You can import the order of events and event numbers from the Michigan Swimming website (http://www.miswim.org/) and/or the Jenison Aquatics website (www.jenisonaquatics.org). All individual entries should be submitted via electronic mail to the entry chairperson at Entries@jenisonaquatics.org (Nicole Redder). An email confirmation will be sent upon receipt of entries.</p> <p>All entries will be processed in order by email date code or mail date code. Any entries submitted will be considered provisional until such time as the entry chairperson has received a hard copy of: (a) your club's entries (Team Manager Meet Entries Report), (b) a hard copy of your club's signed release/waiver agreement (c) your clubs signed certification of entered athletes and (d) your club's entry fees. This must be received in a timely fashion prior to the start of the meet (Friday, June 13) or your swimmers will not be allowed to swim in the meet. Refunds:	Once a team or individual entry has been received and processed by the entry chair there are no refunds in full or in part unless the “over qualification exception” applies (see MS Rules).

Check In:	See stated times above. Check in is mandatory for all events and is required by the time set forth in this meet announcement. Failure to check in will cause the swimmer to be scratched from all events in that session. Check in will close 15 minutes after the start of warm up for each session. Check in sheets will be separated by gender and located in the hallways outside of each locker room.
Scratch Rules:	<u>Prior</u> to check in closing a swimmer may scratch events at the Clerk of Course (located at the pool office – please stay out of the office). <u>After</u> check in closes, you must see the Meet Referee to scratch an event.
Marshaling:	There is no marshaling in this meet. Heat sheets will be posted for self-marshaling for all age groups underneath the American flag and the scoreboard.
Seeding:	Seeding will be done after check in closes. Swimmers who fail to check in for an event will be scratched from that event. All events are timed finals and will be seeded slowest to fastest other than all of the events in Session 2 and Session 5 which will be seeded fastest to slowest, alternating genders-women/men, by event.
Deck Entries/ Time Trials:	For deck entries, registration status must be proven by providing current USA swimming membership card or a current print out of an athlete roster from club portal, the Club Portal is located on the USA Swimming website. The athlete may also enter by showing their membership from USA Swimming’s DECK PASS on a smart phone. Name, athlete ID and club affiliation should then be added to your database just as it appears on the card or list or the swimmer may compete unattached (UN) if they request to do so. Deck entries will be offered based on the time schedule of the meet and availability. Deck entries will cost \$7.50 per individual event. Sign up for the deck entries at the Clerk of Course. Deck entry swimmers are subject to the Michigan Swimming \$1.00 general surcharge. There will be no time trials.
Meet Programs/ Admissions:	Admission will be \$5.00 per person per day for all non-participants over 8 years old. Heat Sheets will be available for \$3.00 for the 12 & Under and 13 & Over sessions.
Scoring:	No scores will be kept.
Awards:	<p><u>13 & Over and Open events:</u> No awards will be given</p> <p><u>12 & under events:</u> Awards for 12 & Under will be split into 11/12 and 10 & Under categories. Medals will be given for 1st-3rd in all A, B, & C categories for each event and ribbons will be given for places 4th- 8th in all A, B, & C categories for each events (for both 11/12 and 10 & under).</p> <p>Coaches MUST claim awards at the end of the meet, they will NOT be mailed. Do not contact JAWS or the Jenison HS Aquatics Center to send them to you.</p> <p><u>IMPORTANT IMX INFORMATION:</u> All swimmers who are pre-entered into the meet (not deck entered) and swim (legally) all of the IMX combination of events for their age group at the Sun and Fun will receive an IMX trophy. Deck entries in IMX events do not count toward the IMX (all trophies are ordered prior to the meet). No Times (NT) do not count toward awards for IMX or medals and ribbons. All NTs are exhibited swims.</p>

	**13 & Over and 12 & Under events will be split into appropriate age groups for IMX awards.
Results:	Complete meet results will be posted on the Michigan Swimming Website at http://www.miswim.org/ and the Jenison Aquatics website www.jenisonaquatics.org . Results will also be available on flash drive (HY-TEK Team Manager result file) upon request. Teams must provide their own flash drive. Results will be emailed out to all entry chairs at the conclusion of the meet and posted on the main page of www.jenisonaquatics.org .
Concessions:	Full concessions will be available in the pool balcony for swimmers and spectators. Food and beverages in plastic containers will be allowed on the deck. NO glass containers will be allowed on the pool deck and will be confiscated if found. Trash receptacles will be made available all over the pool deck and balcony area. Please use them :-)! Fresh fruit smoothies will be available by Maui Wowi Friday through Sunday. A hospitality area will be available for coaches and officials for all sessions with the exception of the 1500 on Saturday evening. We are a NUT FREE Facility. If you or your swimmer has any nut product we will have to discard of it for the safety of one of our swimmers.
Lost and Found:	Articles may be turned in/picked up at the pool office. Articles not picked up by the end of the meet will be retained by the Meet Director or a representative for at least 14 days (any longer period shall be in the sole discretion of the Meet Director).
Swimming Safety:	Michigan Swimming warm up rules will be followed. To protect all swimmers during warm-ups, swimmers are required to enter the pool feet first at all times except when sprint lanes have been designated. No jumping or diving. <i>[The same rules will apply with respect to the warm-down pool and diving well].</i> Penalties for violating these rules will be in the sole discretion of the Meet Referee which may include ejection from the meet.
Deck Personnel / Locker Rooms / Credentialing:	Only registered and current coaches, athletes, officials and meet personnel are allowed on the deck or in locker rooms. <i>Coaches and officials must display their registration cards at all times. Coaches must be current in all certifications.</i> During session 5, all participants in the 1500m Free are asked to provide one timer and they may have someone count for them. This is the only exception to the 1 st sentence of this paragraph. Access to the pool deck may only be granted to any other individual in the event of emergency through approval by the Meet Director or the Meet Referee. The General Chair of MS and the Program Operations Vice-Chair of MS are authorized deck personnel at all MS meets. Personal assistants/helpers of athletes with a disability shall be permitted when requested by an athlete with a disability or a coach of an athlete with a disability. Lists of registered coaches, certified officials and meet personnel will be at the check in table located outside the family room door. Meet personnel will check the list of approved individuals and issue a credential to be displayed at all times during the meet. This credential will include the JAWS logo as well as the function of the individual being granted access to the pool deck (Coach, Official, Timer, or Meet Personnel). In order to obtain a credential, Coaches and Officials must be current in all certifications through the final date of the meet. Meet personnel must return the credential at the conclusion of working each day and be reissued a credential daily. All access points to the pool deck and locker rooms will either be secured or

	staffed by a meet worker checking credentials throughout the duration of the meet.
Swimmers with Disabilities:	All swimmers are encouraged to participate. If any of your swimmers have special needs or requests please indicate them on the entry form and with the Clerk of Course and/or the Meet Referee during warm ups.
General Info:	Any errors or omissions in the program will be documented and signed by the meet Referee and available for review at the Clerk of Course for Coaches review. Information will also be covered at the Coaches' Meeting.
First Aid:	Supplies will be kept with the lifeguards on duty.
Facility Items:	<p>(A) No smoking is allowed in the building or on the grounds of Jenison High School Aquatics Center.</p> <p>(B) Pursuant to applicable Michigan law, no glass will be allowed on the deck of the pool or in the locker rooms.</p> <p>(C) No bare feet allowed outside of the pool area. Swimmers need to have shoes to go into the hallway to go anywhere other than the pool deck and locker rooms.</p> <p>(D) An Emergency Action Plan has been submitted by the Host Club to the Safety Chair and the Program Operations Chair of Michigan Swimming prior to sanction of this meet and is available for review and inspection at the office.</p> <p>(E) Outside food items are not allowed in the pool balcony and no bag chairs are allowed.</p> <p>(F) To comply with USA Swimming privacy and security policy, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.</p> <p>(G) Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.</p>

IMX Challenge:	<p>The IMX Challenge is a motivational program whereby swimmers will be scored and ranked nationally on their performance in a combination of five or six events. The purpose of the program is to promote versatility in age group swimming while advocating greater participation and development across a range of events that are integral to long term success in swimming.</p> <p>In order to receive an IMX score, a swimmer must legally swim each IMX event for their age level in a sanctioned meet at least once during the season. However, at the JAWS Sun & Fun ABC Spectacular, all swimmers who swim all of the IMX events at the Sun and Fun meet will receive</p>

	<p>a trophy (all events must be swum legally and must have been entered with a time).</p> <p>Age Groups and Events The following single age groups and event combinations will be tabulated and scored for both men and women:</p> <p><u>9 & U/ 10-year olds:</u> 200 IM, 200 Free, 100 Back, 100 Breast, 100 Fly</p> <p><u>11-year olds; 12-year olds:</u> 200 IM, 400 Free, 100 Back, 100 Breast, 100 Fly</p> <p><u>13, 14, 15, 16, 17, and 18 -year olds:</u> 200 IM, 400 IM, 400 Free, 200 Back, 200 Breast, 200 Fly</p> <p>USA Swimming will automatically compute scores and results for all athletes. Swimmers only need to compete in the IMX combination of events for their age group and they will be part of the program. USA Swimming will automatically update each athlete with best times as they are achieved during each season.</p>
