Swimmers will

Give 100% effort in practice and at meets

Celebrate successes and learn from disappointments

Treat all coaches, teammates, parents, officials and others they meet in the pool with respect

Keep social media posts and digital communications positive

Pick up after practice and meets - Leave every pool a better place than it was found

Parents will

Recognize that swim performance has its ups and downs and consistent support is a key to long-term success

Treat all coaches, officials, swimmers and parents on PCC, and other teams with respect

Bring concerns to coaches and the Board of Directors, after giving the concern 24 hours of consideration (*concerns related to swimmer safety will be raised immediately to the President of the Board of Directors and a Head Coach*)

Keep social media posts and digital communications positive

Remind their swimmer to help pick up after practice and meets - Leave the pool a better place

Coaches will

Treat all swimmers, parents, officials, and other teams with respect

Welcome families to the pool

Show swimmers their full attention in practice and at meets

Celebrate successes, no matter how big or small

Respond to concerns and questions from swimmers and parents within 2 business days
