



The HEAD LIFEGUARD is responsible for supervising the aquatics area to prevent accidents, assist swimmers, and respond to emergencies. The candidate will create a safe, enjoyable, and positive atmosphere that promotes safety and satisfaction in accordance with Rochester Swim Club Orca's policies and procedures. The lifeguard will oversee multiple activities such as open swim, swim lessons, lap swim, and school/community groups.

Lifeguards report directly to head lifeguard and/or manager, followed by the CEO of the Rochester Swim Club Orca's.

Essential Functions:

- ) Maintain consistent surveillance of the pool area, know/review all emergency procedures and respond to emergency situations immediately.
  - ) Perform first aid when necessary and complete required reports.
- ) Know, understand, and consistently communicate policies and guidelines for the pool and pool area.
  - ) Attend all staff meetings and in service trainings.
- ) Patrol pool area, locker rooms, and bathroom areas and perform light maintenance duties; includes daily cleanup of all areas, stacking chairs, taking out trash, towel removal, and maintenance of lost & found.

Required Qualifications:

- ) Must be age 18
- ) Current Red Cross Lifeguard, First Aid, CPR/AED Certification
  - ) Oversee peers and have great decision making skills
  - ) Assist in leading in service meetings with staff
  - ) Physically perform all skills required of a lifeguard
- ) Hear noises and distress signals in the aquatic environment
  - ) See and observe all sections of aquatic environment
- ) Ability to communicate with all ages and levels of swimmers
  - ) Ability to work with diverse populations and ages
- ) Dedicated to safety and mission of Rochester Swim Club Orca's

- ) Ability to pass lifeguard water test
- ) Must be able to remain alert in varying weather climates
  - ) Must be able to sit/stand for extended periods of time
- ) Ability to recognize and react calmly to dangerous situations
- ) Be able to perform strenuous activity in and out of the water
  - ) Able to communicate verbally to patrons and staff
  - ) Ability to concentrate for long periods of time
