FORMAT: Scratches from finals will be done via Google form sent to participating teams after entries are finalized. All events on Thursday and Friday are timed finals. Events on Saturday and Sunday are prelims-finals. In 9-10 events, the top 6 athletes will advance to finals (1 heat). In 11-12 events, the top 12 athletes will advance to finals (2 heats). In Open freestyle and events 100yds and longer, the fastest 24 athletes will advance to finals (4 heats). In the Open 50yd Backstroke, Breaststroke, and Butterfly, 12 athletes will advance to finals (2 heats). In all Open events, the 1 slowest heat in finals will be open to athletes 14 & Under athletes only. Events, event order, number of athletes in finals are subject to change at the discretion of the meet director.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Invited USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302. Deck Registrations may be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Director.
Age on **December 8, 2022** will determine age for the entire meet.



- DISABILITY SWIMMERS:** Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need special consideration. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to the competition.

- NTs (No Times) are discouraged. Entries will be cut on a first come first serve basis, except for the host team. Maximum 5 entries per athlete per day. Athletes may enter only 1 session per day. Sessions may be limited to 3 hours at the discretion of the Meet Director.
- DEADLINE:** **Entries must be received by: 12:00pm, December 1, 2022**
An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact the Meet Director if you do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.
- ENTRY FEE:** An entry fee of **\$7** per timed final event, **\$10** per prelims/finals event, and a facility surcharge of **\$25** per athlete must accompany the entries.
Make check payable to: **Hauppauge Athletic Association**
Payment must be received by **December 8, 2022** for email entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet. Host Club may waive meet entry fees & facility surcharge for registered outreach swimmers. Coaches should contact the meet director and identify registered swimmers whom they wish considered for waiver of fees when submitting meet entries.
- WARM-UP:** Warmup lanes will be assigned and posted after entries are closed.
- SCRATCHES:** Coaches may be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual event scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.
- COACHES:** In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
- AWARDS:** Medals will be awards for 1st through 3rd place and Ribbons for 4th through 6th. High point awards may be given at the discretion of the meet director.

- MEET DIRECTOR:** Jeff Chu (coachjeff.haa@gmail.com)
- RULES:** The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.
The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet.
The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.
- SAFETY:** Metropolitan Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer,

or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement. Medical supervision available to athletes will include lifeguards and an AED.

- MAAPP POLICY:** All adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
- WATER DEPTH:** The pool is 12 feet deep at 1m from the start end, and 11 feet and 6 inches at 5m from the start end. The pool is 3 feet 6 inches deep at 1m from the turn end, and 4 feet at 5m from the turn end.
- DISCLAIMER:** Upon acceptance of his/her entries, the participant waives all claims against Hauppauge Athletic Association, Hauppauge School District, Metropolitan Swimming Inc., USA Swimming Inc., their agents or representatives for any injury occurring as a result of the meet. It is understood that USA Swimming, Inc. and Metropolitan Swimming, Inc. shall be free from liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.
- REQUIRED STATEMENTS:** Use of Audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
- DECK CHANGING:** Deck changes are prohibited.
- ADMISSION:** Admission to all sessions is free. Programs are available at no charge via Meet Mobile.
- MERCHANTS:** Limited concessions will be available.
- PARKING:** Ample free parking is available north of the High School.

Professional photographers/videographers will be allowed on deck at the discretion of the Meet Director and Meet Referee, and must adhere to the following guidelines:

Do not stand on the starting end of the pool, or in the starter's box; use of the bulkhead is at the discretion of the Meet Director and Meet Referee.

Do not stand on the edge of the pool (leave approximately two feet for officials and coaches).

Leave the deck when not actively photographing.

Respond immediately to direction from the Meet Referee.
