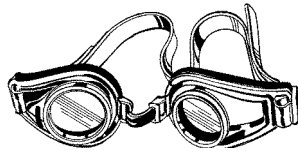


Maryland LMSC Swim Series

2003 YMCA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

The meet was held April 24-27 at the Sarasota (FL) YMCA. The Anne Arundel YMCA won the overall title with a total of 2,549 points. 70 swimmers, aged 19 through 90 swam to excellence, with the women's team winning the number 1 place, and the men's team, number 2.

Head Coach, Nancy Brown won "the gold" in each of the events she swam; the 100, 200, 500 and 1650 free, the 50,100, and 200 yd fly, and the 400 yd IM. 90 yr. old Ray Edelhoff broke records in the 50 and 100 yd breaststroke, and the 50 and 100 yd back. Sue Marinzel toppled Nancy Brown's record in the 200 yd fly with a 2:58.50. Sue also captured 1st place in the 100 yd fly. Bob Johnston broke the 100 yd breaststroke record for the 65-69 age group.

Other first place swimmers were Crystalle Frazier 19-24 1650 free, Kay Williamson 40-44 1650 free, Joan Libby 60-64 1650 free, Pam Breza 55-59 50 and 100 yd breaststroke and free, Bob Johnston 65-69 50yd breaststroke, Denzil Pritchard 80-84 50 yd breaststroke, Megan Linz 19-24 50 yd free and 50 and 100 yd back, Sally Iliff 55-59 200 yd butterfly, Carolyn Voorhees 40-44 100 and 200 yd IM, John Collings 75-79 200 yd IM, and Gary Trimble 60-64 100yd IM.

As in any swim meet of this importance, the swimmers who place 2nd through 8th, provide the bulk of the points for the team overall. Most of the following Anne Arundel County swimmers participated in, and some placed in all 8 individual events in which they swam and most of the 6 relays. JIM FORSYTHE

James Lewis Forsythe, 64, died of brain cancer Feb. 14 at his home after a lengthy illness. He was an industrial engineer graduate of Ohio University, where he set individual and medley school records as a member of the varsity swim team. His professional career encompassed many aspects of the retail industry. He was involved in businesses from Boston to Greensboro, NC, from Denver to Laurel. In 1989, he and his wife of 25 years, Anne Dempsey Forsythe, started Wallpapers To Go, a home-decorating center in Pasadena. In addition to his wife, 3 children and 4 grandchildren survive him.

Jim swam for the Severna Park Masters from 1992 until shortly before his death. He held team records and state records. He also had a life-long passion for golf, a highlight of which was playing a few rounds with Jack Nicklaus. Jim was easy-going, friendly, and with a positive attitude. He was a regular competitor at YMCA Nationals where he would swim whatever events would benefit the team. We will all miss Jim.
