

# 30th Anniversary Awards Banquet

On Saturday evening, June the 5<sup>th</sup>, over 80 well-dressed Maryland Masters swimmers and guests gathered at the Knights of Columbus Hall in Catonsville to celebrate the long and storied 30-year tradition of one of the finest Masters swimming programs in the USA.

Founder, Coach Nancy Brown, was in attendance and honored for her personal swimming achievements as well as for her years of unwavering devotion and inspiration to so many in Maryland Masters swimming. As usual, she lent her familiar brand of hilarity and peculiar fashion sense to the evening during her awards presentations which included the obligatory "slammers."

On display were hundreds of pictures generously shared from swimmers' personal collections and a long wall full of Meet T-shirts, chronicling our history together. The dinner tables were suitably decorated with imaginative live goldfish bowl centerpieces.

Cocktail hour and a generous buffet dinner preceded the awards presentations, emceed by the LMSC chair, Barb Protzman. The presentations commenced with the playing of our own Maryland Masters Rap Song made popular by Sherif Shaalan at Y National Meets. After an overview of the most recent 2003-2004 season, the lights went down as everyone was treated to a special multi-media presentation outlining the 30-year history of our growing Maryland Masters swimming family that Barb prepared for the evening.

Many other swimmers were recognized and honored for the achievements and contributions to Maryland Masters swimming including several past members posthumously. They were Carol Chidester, Fred Forshey, Jeanne Mason Bostwick, Marilyn Lumpkin, Norris and Audrey Fluke, Betty Taylor, Jim Forsythe.

As a group, we collectively acknowledged the special honor we can still enjoy of successfully hosting the 2000 Masters Long Course National Swim Meet, the largest Masters Long Course Meet to date.

Also, the successful 27 year history of the Maryland Masters Winter Meet, the Maryland Masters 1000/1650 Meet and the Carol Chidester Swim Series that evolved from the Potomac Valley/Maryland dual meets are further distinctions we pointed up.

Awards were presented by the Maryland Masters at UMBC, Maryland Masters at SPY, Maryland Masters at Towson University, and the LMSC Swim Series Challenge and Swimmer of the Year. The twenty-one swimmers who broke a total of fifty-one LMSC records were also recognized for their accomplishments.

Barb Protzman, who will be moving to Florida soon and relinquishing her position as LMSC chair (and registrar and top ten and newsletter and Swim Series Coordinator), welcomed the honor of an unexpected citation received from the Governor of Maryland presented by Nancy Brown along with other lovely parting gifts.

A special thank you was given to the outgoing officers and appointees: Nancy Brown - vice-chair; Patty Devanny - Treasurer; Ray Toy - Secretary; Caroline Day - Webmaster; Sherif Shaalan - Newsletter. The new slate of officers were unanimously elected for a two-year term in the first election in the LMSC in over 15 years.

In keeping with the nostalgic and celebratory mood of the evening, a wide variety of dancing music was provided by a DJ to top off a wonderful evening. Of course, excelling in the dry-land world of the dance floor was Chuck Eremchuk, our own Fred Astaire. And nonagenarian Ray Edlehoff also cut quite a rug.

Many thanks to those who helped make the evening a great success including: Patty Devanny who coordinated arrangements with the Knights of Columbus; Gladney McKay and Cheryl Kinney, and other SPY swimmers who handled the table decorations; Barb Protzman for the multi-media presentation and T-shirts.

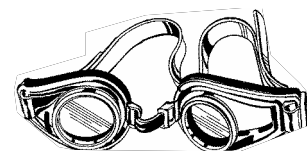
