Meet Format The meet events will be swum 12 and Under in the morning sessions and 13 and Over in the

afternoon session. 1500 and 400IM will be available to 11 and Over swimmers. 400 Free will available to 9 and Over swimmers. 400 Free and 400 IM will be a part of the afternoon session.

Entry Fees An entry fee of \$16.00 plus \$2.00 per event will be charged. The Relay fee is \$5.00 per relay. Make

checks payable to the **Bozeman Swim Club**. *No entries will be accepted without payment of fees*.

There will be no refunds.

Entry Deadline All entries must be received in Bozeman no later than Wednesday, May 4, 2011.

Entries must be made through the swimmer's club with a <u>team</u> check. Unattached swimmers may make direct entries. Phone entries will be accepted until 8:00 p.m. Wednesday May 4th. Phone entries to Kris Hall (406) 586-6996. **Phone entries for entire teams will not be accepted**. Late entries, **if accepted**, will require double entry fees.

Rules 2011 USA Swimming Rules and Montana Swimming Rules will govern the meet. This meet is

approved by Montana Swimming. All events are timed finals. Deck seeding may be provided if there

are open lanes. There will be a safety marshal on deck.

Age Groups 8 & U, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-21, 22 and Over. All combined events will be scored separately

by age group. Age on May 13th shall determine the swimmer's age group for the meet.

Eligibility All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming or the Canadian equivalent or US Masters

Swimming (USMS). Masters swimmers are welcome and encouraged to compete. Swimmer and coach registration will be confirmed with the Montana Swimming Registration Coordinator. Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the

swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Limitations Each swimmer may compete in a maximum of eight (8) individual events with a maximum of five (5)

individual events on any single day.

Relays Relays may be mixed age as well as mixed gender. We encourage mixed age group if possible.

Entry Procedure All entries may be submitted by e-mail (preferred) as a Team Manager file to:

bozemanbarracudas@yahoo.com or by mail on the enclosed master sheet. Please include a printed copy of your entries with your payment. Also complete and return the USA Swimming Registration Confirmation, Waiver, and Accounting Sheet with your entries (all enclosed in the entry packet). All paperwork and fees can be mailed to: Bozeman Barracudas, PO BOX 804, Bozeman,

MT 59771.

Seeding Each swimmer will be seeded according to age group and submitted times in meters. Failure to

convert yard times before sending could result in your swimmers being incorrectly seeded. Yard times will be entered as submitted and will not be converted. The 1500 Free; 400 Free, 400 IM will be

seeded fastest to slowest with heats alternating between women and men.

Events All events will be timed finals.

Clerk of Course There will be no Clerk of Course. Heat and Lane assignments will appear in the program. Swimmers

are responsible for taking their position behind the blocks.

Timing A Colorado electronic timing system will be used along with backup timers and will be displayed on a

new 8 lane scoreboard. Each club will be responsible for providing at least two (2) timers at all times. A sign-up sheet will be posted at the meet. **Swimmers entered in the 1500 Free, 400 Free and 400**

IM must provide their own timers and counters.

Awards Participation awards will be given to each swimmer. No individual awards will be given.

Concessions Concessions will be available. Absolutely no glass containers are allowed in the locker rooms or

deck areas. The gymnasium will **NOT** be available, Saturday. The gym will be open on Sunday for swimmers and families. Personalized meet t-shirts and/or clothing will be available for sale as well as

an array of swim items in the Swim Shop.

Meetings A coaches' meeting will be held in the office Saturday at 7:00 a.m.

An Officials' meeting will be held in the office at 5:30 p.m. Friday and during the warm-up sessions on

both Saturday and Sunday.
