- a. Deidre Loyda shared a handout with a template of a “Code of Conduct” for athletes to qualify for Zones.
- b. The thought behind this proposal is that our athletes will represent Montana Swimming and need to be held to a high standard of behavior and conduct in order to be offered this privilege.
- c. Some discussion took place as to the template that was handed out.
- d. Deidre asked everyone to review this template before making any decisions.

d. License Plates

- a. Curt Jacobson shared that he would like to pursue using Montana Swimming License Plates as a fundraiser
- b. Curt stated that we need submissions from artists to consider and put out to our swim clubs for view
- c. An idea was put on the table to offer incentives for the artists submissions in the amount of \$300 / \$200 / \$100 (\$600 dollars total) to inspire artists to take this seriously and get submissions in.

Motion Made by Merle Gunderson to move forward with the license plate idea with the stipulation that the State shares parameters with the artists as to what will be acceptable for license plates or not.

a. Championship Meets committee and Report

- a. Teams need to put bids in for meets
- b. Discussion regarding the cost for running the meet

f. Coaches Clinic October 21-23 in Missoula

- a. Regional Meeting (Montana Swimming in conjunction with USA Swimming) will be on October 21 – 23, Friday / Saturday and Sunday in Missoula
- b. \$2500 is available through Montana Swimming will be applied for registration and meals.
- c. Coaches must fund their own rooms, provide transportation and fund the balance of food needs.

g. All Star Camp

- a. Deidre Loyda updated the group
- b. This year's All-Star Camp will be held in Bozeman on Friday / Saturday and Sunday on June 17, 18 and 19th.
- c. The cost will be \$100.00 per swimmer
- d. Athletes and Coaches will be camping outside
- e. Special presenters will be brought in for Yoga instruction, shoulder instruction and a Division One Coach for pool sessions.

h. Re-selection of Assistant Head Zone Coach and talk about other coach chaperons

- a. A discussion was held regarding how many coaches and chaperones were needed to handle 40 swimmers at Zones.
- b. The suggestion offered was to follow a prior grid to send 3 adults with 20 kids, 4 adults with 30 kids, 5 adults with 40 kids, etc.....
- c. A suggestion was given that there should be a balance of female and male coaches / chaperones going to Zones each year.
- d. Chaperones do require a background check
- e. A suggestion was given for assistant coaches who were interested in attending Zones to apply to the head coach, Kirk Ermels.
- f. A question was asked if there were enough funds to pay for the head coach, assistant coach and chaperones. The answer was yes.
- g. The chaperones will not get paid.
- h. The cost per coach is around \$1400.00

A final decision was made to have team representatives vote for who the assistant zones coach would be during this weekend's Bozeman Long Course Swim Meet.

- a. A discussion took place whether B/C Championships needed to be a week before Short Course State, or if it could be moved to a different week either earlier or even after Short Course State
- b. Discussion shared reflected keeping the B/C Championships the week before Short Course State as that has worked well for teams in the state and the athletes.
- c. The B/C Championships will be on February 18 – 19, 2012
 - i. The Teams that offered to host the B/C Championships were:

 - 2. Hardin
 - ii. **A vote took place and Hardin was selected to host the 2012 B/C Championships on February 18-19, 2012**

b. Short Course State Meet

- a. A discussion took place as to the location of the 2012 Short Course State Meet
- b. A discussion also took place as to when the State Swim Meet should occur on the calendar
 - i. Two options were offered for the Short Course State Meet:
 - 1. February 24 – 26
 - 2. March 2 – 4
 - ii. **A vote took place and February 24 – 26 was selected as the Short Course State Meet dates for 2012.**
- c. The following teams offered to host the 2012 Short Course State:
 - i. Missoula Aquatic Club offered to host the meet with a \$0.00 dollar pool rental fee.

- ii. Butte stated that they have put \$25,000 into repairing their pool situation and that it is up and running back to normal. They shared that they have paperwork and reports to verify this if needed. Butte offered to host the Short Course State Meet with a \$0.00 pool rental fee and they offered to donate \$1,000 to Montana Swimming in order to host this meet in 2012.
