

Montana Swimming Times Report October HOD Meeting

Congratulations to Kaitlyn Kleppelid of the Helena Lions Swim Team for being named for the second year to the USA Swimming Scholastic All America Team. Congratulations to Hailey Jacobson and Kate Zimmer from the Missoula Aquatic Team for also being named to USA Swimming Scholastic All America Team. All three swimmers had 4.0 grade point averages last year in school. The Scholastic All-America Team is made up of high school student-athletes who have a grade point average of 3.5 or higher and who have achieved the required time standard in a single event. To be eligible for this recognition, swimmers must have completed 10th, 11th or 12th grade and must be a USA Swimming member athlete.

Congratulations to Hanni Leach of the Missoula Aquatic Club for being named to the National Age Group (NAG) Top 10 list for her seventh place finish in the 14 year girls' 100 yard backstroke with a time of 55.65 at the 2011 Speedo Short Course Junior Nationals.

For the long course season April 1, 2012 through August 31, 2012 Montana Swimming loaded 8 meets into the SWIMS data base which included six long course meets and two yard meets. There were 9,413 individual times loaded and 105 relay times loaded. The Montana Swimming Long Course State Championships had the second largest number of individual swims loaded with 2,881 individual times and the most relays with 95 relay times loaded. The largest number of individual times loaded, 2965, was from the MAC Firecracker Classic and nine relays times were loaded from the same meet.

Montana Swimming also maintains a LSC times data base in Hy-Tek's Team Manager. This summer the LSC began a times database with Team Unify although that database does contain errors. Once the third party vendor sweep capability is available to use with SWIMS, the Team Unify database will be more accurate. Due to the nature of the Team Unify database, there will most likely continue to be some errors in this database. The only accurate times database will continue to be SWIMS.

The Montana Swimming updated top 10 times reports for the short course and long course seasons are posted on the Montana Swimming website. Updated reports can be generated throughout the season if there is interest in the data. Reports can also be generated listing top times by event for men and women in each course as well as the top IMX scores for men and women in each course.

There are still eight swimmers and one relay with times in the SWIMS error holding tank. These swimmers were either not registered at the time of the swim or the identifying information for the swimmers in the meet was incorrect. I am unable to correct their registration data at this time to move the times into the SWIMS data base.

Please continue to send me a meet manager back-up of your meet results. If you attend an out-of-state meet, ask the meet host for a meet manager back-up of the meet results or ask the meet host to e-mail me a meet manager back-up of the meet results. Thank you to all the teams who notify me when they attend out-of-state meets and send me the results promptly afterwards!

I would like to thank all the teams who do the pre-meet registration recon with Lanni Jacobson and ensure the swimmer registration data is correct for their meets. It allows the data to be

entered into SWIMS cleanly. I'd also like to thank all the meet referees for checking the times, relay names, and splits data for their meets to ensure the data is correct.

The USA Swimming SWIMS personnel has asked that we name out meets in the following format: year, MT, club abbreviation, and then the meet name – such as 2012 MT BTST Mining City Classic. This is the proper name format to load meet results into SWIMS. Also please remember to include the elevation of your city in Meet Manager so times that can be altitude adjusted will be altitude adjusted in SWIMS and OME.

If non-USA Swimming registered athletes are competing in an approved meet, please do not include a USAS ID number for those swimmers in Meet Manager. Masters swimmers should be listed with the team as Montana Masters and should have either their Montana Masters ID number or **no** ID number included.
