# 2008 Montana Swimming Junior B-C Short Course Swimming Championships <br> February 23 - 24, 2008 <br> Great Falls, Montana 

## Sanction Number - 0694

LOCATION: The meet will be held at the Great Falls High School Bison Pool. This pool is a 6 lane, 25 -yard pool with an adjacent warm-up pool. The High School is located on $19^{\text {th }}$ St. So. and $5^{\text {th }}$ Ave. So.

SAFETY REGULATIONS: Montana Swimming safety guidelines and warm-up procedures will be in effect, Each coach is responsible for informing swimmers of the provisions of the safety code before attending the meet. A safety marshal will be on deck during the meet. No glass containers are allowed on the deck or in the locker rooms. The adjacent warm-up pool may only be used for warm-up or warm-down. All swimmers must be under the supervision of a USAS member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. Swimmers competing at the meet without their coach in attendance will be assigned to a coach in attendance at the meet or the swimmer may ask when entering to be assigned to a specific coach. There is no diving allowed in the warm-up pool.

RULES: 2006 USA Swimming and Montana Swimming rules will govern the meet. This meet is sanctioned by USA Swimming and Montana Swimming. Timing will be Colorado Timing System and/or two manual watches.

AGE GROUPS: $8 \& U, 10 \& U, 11-12,13-14,15-16$, and 17-21. $8 \&$ Under Swimmers may swim in either the $8 \&$ Under or the $10 \&$ Under age group, but not both. All combined and mixed events will be awarded and scored separately by age group and male/female. Age on February $23^{\text {rd }}$ shall determine the swimmer's age for the meet.

EXCEPTION: Any swimmer who ages up to a higher age group between February 23 and March 1 may enter the events in that higher age group as long as they have not achieved a BB time in any event in any course in that higher age group. This swimmer must then swim all events in that higher age group for the meet. They may not swim both age groups.

## All events will be Timed Finals.

ELIGIBILITY: All swimmers must be registered athletes with USA Swimming and Montana Swimming for 2008. Swimmers that qualify for Montana Short Course Championship Meet with a "BB" or faster time in any course (Yards, LCM or SCM) since January 1, 2007 are ineligible to compete in any events at the Junior B - C Short Course Swimming Championship Meet in which they have a "B" time or greater. They may enter any events that they do not have a "B" time or greater in. Swimmers age $8 \&$ under may compete in any $8 \&$ under event that they do not have a state qualifying time in any course.

Time Trials: There will be a separate Time Trial held at the conclusion of the meet events on both Saturday and Sunday for swimmers that are not entered in the 2008 Montana Swimming Junior B-C Short Course Swimming Championships and have/have not attained a qualifying time for the 2008 Montana Spring Junior Olympics. Swimmers may enter a maximum of 3 events each day. See the attached list for events and order that will be offered at the Time Trials, NOT ALL STATE MEET

## EVENTS WILL BE OFFERED.

## Time Trial Sanction Number - 0695

ENTRIES: Each swimmer may compete in a maximum of eight (8) individual events for the entire meet with a maximum of four (4) individual events per day. Each swimmer will be seeded according to their fastest submitted times. No Time entries will not be accepted.

No deck entries will be allowed. There will be no minimum waiting period between events. Please consider this when entering swimmers in consecutive events.

Please include a team entry report sorted by athlete name from Team Manager. When e-mailing, please include these reports in Word or RTF. The entry Summary, Waiver, and USA Swimming Registration Confirmation Sheet must be filled out, signed and returned with the entries and reports. Swimmers will not be allowed to swim until the fees are paid and required paper work is turned in.

Please note: Exception swimmers who are aging up between Feb. 23 and Mar. 1 will need to place their entries on the Master Entry Form provided. Please do not include them on your team entry file.

DEADLINES: Entries must be received no later than Thursday, February $14^{\text {th }}$. Phone in entries will be accepted until Monday, February $18^{\text {th }}$ at 12:00 noon by Laurie Brennan at 406-453-2722, if no answer leave a message and your call will be returned.

ENTRY FEES: An entry fee in the sum of $\$ 28.00$ for each individual swimmer must be must be paid with the entries. Checks should be made payable to the Falls Aquatic Swim Team. There will be no refunds.

STARTING TIME: The meet shall commence at 7:30 am for warm-ups for the 500 free on Saturday and the 1000 free on Sunday. The races will begin at 7:50 am both days. General warm-ups will begin immediately following the distance events each day and no earlier then $8: 30 \mathrm{am}$. Each team should provide an email address so a warm-up schedule can be distributed before the meet.

SCORING: Individual-scoring points will be 16, 13, 12, 11, 10, 9, 7, 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1.
AWARDS: Individual medals will be awarded for $1^{\text {st }}$ through $6^{\text {th }}$ and ribbons for $7^{\text {th }}$ through $12^{\text {th }}$ place. All swimmers who achieve a 'BB' time during the meet will be awarded a BB Time Achievement Certificate.

SPIRIT AWARD: A traveling Team Spirit Banner will be awarded to the team showing the best display of team spirit.
DISABLED SWIMMERS: Disabled swimmers are welcome. Please notify the meet referee and the meet manager if you have any special needs by the meet entry deadline. The disabled swimmers will be seeded with the able bodied swimmers and will be accommodated for special requests in seeding if desired.

SCRATCH PROCEDURE: There will be no clerk of course. Heat and lane assignments will appear in the program. Swimmers are responsible for taking their position behind the blocks. Swimmers failing to report for their races will be scratched at the blocks. Coaches should report scratches to the meet referee prior to the start of the meet both days.

PROTESTS: All protests should be given to the meet referee.
OFFICIALS AND TIMERS: All teams will be asked to provide timers during the meet. We also appreciate the help of certified officials from other clubs. There will be an officials meeting and coaches meeting prior to the start of the meet each day.

CONCESSIONS: The Falls Aquatic Swim Team will have a selection of nutritious snacks, meals, and drinks for sale.
