

Supplemental COVID Document for Teddy Bear Classic 2020

- 1) To adhere to guidance from the Gallatin Health Department and to allow for social distancing, No spectators will be allowed in the swim center or the athlete tents.
- 2) The meet will be live streamed on our public facebook page following safe sport guidelines.
- 3) Masks will be required at all times except when actively swimming or approaching the blocks.
- 4) Social distancing is mandated at all times throughout the swim center and within the tents
- 5) Swimmer ingress will be through the North door on the West side of the building and egress will be through the South door on the West side of the building.
- 6) Temperatures will be taken on admittance. Temperatures > 100 will be denied admittance.
- 7) A questionnaire will be collected at admittance: Do you have a fever, cough or muscle aches? Have you been identified or had contact with someone who has symptoms of COVID-19 or tested positive for COVID- 19 in the last 14 days? Have you tested positive for COVID -19 in the last 14 days ? If the answer to any of these questions is yes, the swimmer/ volunteer will be refused admittance.
- 8) Locker rooms will be minimally available for changing and short showers. Only 5 -6 athletes will be allowed into the locker room at one time. Time will be limited to 5 minutes to allow everyone access to the locker rooms and restrooms. While in the locker room, athletes will adhere to social distancing guidelines and wear a mask at all times. The mask can be removed while showering but you must maintain social distance of 6 feet.
- 9) No more than 100 people will be in the swim center at a time during the meet including swimmers, life guards, officials and volunteers
- 10) Only swimmers in the current heat and subsequent two heats will be allowed in the swim center at a time
- 11) Warm ups and cool downs in the shallow end are reserved for swimmers 12 and over and social distancing must be followed while in the warm up and cool down pool.
- 12) Team seating will be in separated tents. Each team will have their own section and within this section they are expected to adhere to social distancing guidelines
- 13) High touch surfaces will be cleaned hourly and the restrooms and blocks and other high touch surfaces sanitized between sessions.
Athletes are expected to take their belongings with them between sessions.
- 14) Hand sanitizer will be provided throughout the facility as well as access to the locker rooms for hand washing.
- 15) No concessions will be provided and athletes and volunteers are asked to bring their own water bottles. A refill station will be available and sanitized between sessions.

- 16) We will provide grab and go lunches for the coaches and officials once per day most likely between session 1 and 2 and session 4 and 5.**
- 17) An electronic whistle will be used by the meet referee**
- 18) We will require strict adherence to the COVID rules and athletes and volunteers not abiding by the rules will be asked to leave and no refunds will be given.**
