The committee will get the info to The Starting Block to come up with different designs, which Nicolas and Baylee will then take to the swimmers for their feedback.

### **G, Lock-In Dates**

After discussion, it was agreed the swimmers staying overnight must be 13 & over. 12 and unders will have to be picked up between 11:45 pm and 12:15 am. Passed unanimously. Randy Krueger will set up an event on Team Unify, with the sign up deadline being February 27. Lock in date is now March 3. Suggested cost is \$50, to go to the Strong Communities.

Committee Chair Stacy will work with Randy for a job sign up, and Abi for further details, and will then work with her committee for preparation.

MV admin to discuss in the spring. The first All Star of the Month is set to go. Coaches have decided on the first recipient, to be presented this month by Nicolas and Baylee.
