ABOUT WEBB CITY SUMMER SWIM TEAM: The Webb City Summer Swim Team is part of the Tri-State League and participates in meets held in short course 25 yard pools. It's a great team for kids who want to try out swim team for the first time, as well as those who have been swimming year round. Swimmers will gain endurance and be instructed on the competitive techniques in a fun and encouraging environment. Team members will also be given opportunities for growth and leadership that go beyond the pool, such as learning how to set individual goals and how to be a great teammate.

MEMBER DUES:

- June/July: One time fee of \$130. Includes two months and t-shirt and latex cap. Due June 1st. If swimmer did not participate in April/May \$10 will be added for insurance.

PRACTICE OPTIONS: Families can choose which practice times work for their schedule and swimmers can attend as many practices as they want, but it is recommended for swimmers to attend 2-3 practices a week during preseason and 3-4 practices a week during summer season (in any combination of days/times listed).

EQUIPMENT: Each swimmer should bring their own Swim Cap, Goggles, Water Bottle.

A Team T-Shirt and Team latex swim cap are included in the price of dues. Families will also be given an opportunity to order a team swim suit and silicone team swim cap, if desired.

SWIM MEETS: Participation in meets is not mandatory, but is encouraged once coaches have given feedback that a swimmer is ready to compete in certain events. Competition gives swimmers a chance to see personal improvement, race in an exciting and fun atmosphere, celebrate hard work, be inspired by others, and solidify friendships with teammates.

MEET ENTRIES: Meet entries are done online through www.berzerkerswimming.com by the swimmer's family. Coaches will suggest certain events for individual swimmers based on their skills and endurance. It is also important to know that once a swimmer is registered for a particular meet, their coach might also place them on a relay!

- MEET FEES: The host team charges "meet fees" based on the events entered. The fees for Tri-State meets are typically \$2 per individual event and \$1.25 per swimmer per relay. Meet fees will be billed to the family's online swim team account the week after the meet. In addition to the meet fees charged by the host team, families will also be billed a \$10 coaching surcharge per swimmer per meet to their account to cover our coaches' costs for attending that meet.
➤ CHAMPIONSHIP MEETS: In order to be eligible to participate in "B Champs" and/or "A Champs" at the end of the season, each swimmer must attend at least 3 regular Tri-State season meets. For championship meets, the coaching surcharge is \$20 per swimmer, in addition to the meet fees for individual events.
➤ MEET SCHEDULE: The meet schedule is posted at www.berzerkerswimming.com under the Events/Meets tab. All Tri-State meets are designated with (Tri-State) in the name of the event.
