### **Describe the local protocols governing swim meets at your facility.**

On May 19, 2021, the Sedgwick County Board of County Commissioners amended resolution No. 70-2021, Section 1B to read: "Encourages businesses and organizations to determine, in their best judgment, whether to require individuals to wear masks or other face coverings and/or to maintain social distance from one..."

### **Describe your plan for spectator ingress, egress, and any limitations you may place on spectators.**

\* Whilst the weather is nice enough, we plan to continue blocking off our parking lot to the south of the building and parents and teams will be asked to set up their crash areas outside.

\* Spectators will be allowed to enter the building to watch swimmers and, barring any traffic flow issues, will not be restricted to only watching their child.

\* Once the weather turns colder, we will have to amend this plan and will update this document.

\* The Meet Ref has the ability to change this during a meet if a situation is deemed unsafe for spectators and/or swimmers (i.e. too many people in an area, etc)
