- 25 yards, 8 lanes, Daktronics 2000 Timing System, 8 lane readout scoreboard and anti-turbulent lane lines. Pool depth of 3.5 ft at 1M, 4ft at 5M from turn end. Depth of 13ft at 1M, 12.5ft at 5M from start end. USA-S Rule 202.4.10.C
- Pool has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).

**FACILITY:** 

- FACE COVERINGS. All persons in an LPS facility shall wear a face covering at all times. Coaches, spectators, athletes, officials, school staff members will all wear masks. The face covering shall cover the person's mouth and nose. Face shields are not allowed as a replacement for a face covering. All swim meet participants will wear cloth face coverings per district policy. This requirement applies to all swimmers, coaches, volunteers, meet officials, family, spectators, and anyone else present in or at an LPS facility. Swimming participants are allowed to remove their face coverings while engaged in exercise or while swimming.

- No glass containers of any kind will be allowed on the pool deck, no concessions will be allowed.
- Disinfecting stations- Entrance into the pool area, on the table by pool office, Before the bull pen area. Clerk of course table
- Nebraska Aquatics and Lincoln Public Schools reserve the right to remove from the premises any individual who
  might jeopardize safety and facility privileges.
- Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted behind the blocks, in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present
- Two gender specific facilities are available at this facility. Gender specific locker rooms will be available for athlete restroom use only. Locations of these facilities can be found in the concourse of the spectator

DISABILITY
SWIMMERS:

Athletes with a disability are welcomed and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the Deck Referee of any disability prior to competition.

RULES:

Current USA Swimming Rules and Midwestern Rules will govern this meet. All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPPP, and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition..

**CREDENTIALS:** 

- Presentation of coach's membership credentials will be required at coach sign-in. Credentials shall be available at all times. Deck Pass is acceptable proof of USA Swimming membership.
- In accordance with MWS Policy, only those coaches who hold current, valid USA Swimming credentials
  will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these
  credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

**ELIGIBILITY:** 

- All swimmers, coaches and clubs must be currently registered with USA Swimming.
- NO on deck registration permitted. NO late entries permitted.
- The age of the swimmer on December 5, 2021 determines his/her age for the entire meet.
- Athletes who appear as unregistered on the first pre-meet recon must register with Midwestern or their own LSC immediately. A second pre-meet recon will be run 4 days prior to the start of the meet and any MW unregistered athlete that appears on that list must register with Midwestern Swimming and will be charged an additional \$30.00 above the current MW registration fee and must provide proof of registration before being allowed to swim in the meet. Meet management must delete unregistered athletes from the meet file prior to meet commencement.
- All ages; No time standards.
- Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified
  by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each
  race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to
  ensure compliance with this requirement.

- No time trials.
- The 4-hour rule will be applied. The host will accept no further entries for a session with 12 & Under swimmers where a 4-hour projected time limit is reached. The Meet Director reserves the right to limit events, heats, teams, and swimmers to conform to the 4-hour time limit (205.3.1F). Teams will be notified of any and all necessary adjustments.

**COACH MEETING:** 

Prior to the start of each session.

#### **GENERAL MEET** CONDUCT:

- All events will be timed finals and pre-seeded.
- Report any scratches as soon as possible.
- All starts will take place in the deep end of the pool. All events other than 25 yard swims will finish into touch pads at the deep end wall. 25 yard events will finish into the shallow end wall. Two timers will be at the end of those lanes recording finish times.
- All events swum Fastest to Slowest.
- Fly over starts may be used at the discretion of the meet referee and meet director.
- Each swimmer shall report promptly to his/her assigned lane prior to the start of each race in which he/she is entered and stand on tape provided behind the blocks when waiting for their heat to be called to help with social distancing behind the blocks.
- Exhibition swimming will not be allowed.

WARM-UP **PROCEDURES:** 

- Athletes should arrive in their suits and depart in their suits. Locker rooms will be available for restroom use only and will be monitored for usage and social distancing.
- MWS Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the Meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, or club for the failure to follow the safety rules.
- Teams will be assigned time and lanes for warm-ups.
- Swimmers are to sit and slide entering water.
- During sprint starts, swimmers must swim one direction only from deep to shallow.

### USA Swimming and Midwestern Swimming Supplement Document for Sanction

The following information must be provided for sanction.

- a) A statement of the local protocols and requirements

  At this time there are limited special requirements for facility use. Mask requirements: For athletes,
  volunteers, visitors, and families face coverings are REQUIRED
- b) The plan for spectator ingress and egress
  All participants and spectators will enter from the Northeast side of the building. Door # 9 Prasch activities center
- c) The planned number of individuals gathering in the spaces: pool, deck, spectator seating, etc LPS Maximum spectator and participant seating capacity at Lincoln Southeast is 560 persons. Teams will be spaced out around the pool deck and in the back hallways when crashing during the event. Spectators are encouraged to space themselves out appropriately when in the stands
- d) Safe Sport considerations to ensure parents have access to and/or the opportunity to observe their child NA will ensure that athletes compete, coaches coach, and parents spectate. All on deck changing rooms are only available to athletes. Coaches, officials, and meet volunteers will have alternate access to restrooms on the basement level of the school. Parents and spectators are not allowed on the pool deck per USA swimming rules. Spectators have the ability to watch the meet from the stands or in the hallway.
- e) An attestation statement in which the meet hosts attest that the conduct of the meet will adhere to local jurisdictional guidelines.
  - In applying for this sanction, the Host, <u>Nebraska Aquatics dba Lincoln Swim Club</u>, agrees to comply and to enforce all health and safety mandates and guidelines of USA Swimming, Midwestern Swimming, Inc, the State of Nebraska, and the City of Lincoln, Lancaster County.

### COVID-19 Protocols for Non-LPS Youth Organizations LPS Swimming Facilities Addendum

Non-LPS Youth Organization use of LPS swimming pools shall comply with the following additional protocols in addition to all other issued protocols.

1. **MAXIMUM CAPACITY**. The total, maximum number of persons at an LPS facility attending, participating in, or observing a swimming event shall be as follows:

2. FACE COVERINGS. All persons in or at an LPS facility shall wear a face covering at all times. The face covering shall cover the person's mouth and nose. This requirement applies to all swimmers, coaches, volunteers, meet officials, family, spectators, and anyone else present in or at an LPS facility. Youth swimming participants are allowed to remove their face coverings while engaged in exercise or while swimming.

The Non-LPS Youth Organization reserving the LPS swimming pool is and shall be responsible for enforcing the face covering requirement. Any Non-LPS Youth Organization determined by LPS in its sole discretion to not have enforced the face covering requirement may be denied future reservations of LPS swimming facilities.

3. SOCIAL DISTANCING. All persons in or at an LPS facility shall observe appropriate social distancing guidelines, including wherever possible maintaining 6 feet of distance between individuals.

The Non-LPS Youth Organization reserving the LPS swimming pool is and shall be responsible for enforcing social distancing requirements. Any Non-LPS Youth Organization determined by LPS in its sole discretion to not have developed a social distancing plan or to not have enforced appropriate social distancing or its social distancing plan may be denied future reservations of LPS swimming facilities.

For information purposes only, social distancing in bleachers may be accomplished by appropriate non-permanent markings on bleacher seats for allowed seating. By way of example only, blocking every other row of bleacher seating may be appropriate. Also for information purposes only, the number of persons on pool decks should be limited as much as possible to essential persons only and persons not needed on pool decks should be directed to allowed bleacher seating. By way of example only, social distancing on the pool deck may be accomplished by appropriate non-permanent markings on the floor, including appropriate swimmer spacing near the starting blocks, and limiting the number of swimmers on the deck prior to events and heats.

4. **COMPLIANCE MONITORING.** The Non-LPS Youth Organization reserving the LPS swimming pool shall develop and retain records showing compliance with LPS protocols, applicable federal, state, or local health measures and regulations, and any governing or sanctioning organization COVID-19 guidance. Such records shall be in writing and shall be made available to LPS upon request. Any Non-LPS Youth Organization determined by LPS in its sole discretion to not have compliance records or to not be in compliance with LPS protocols may be denied future reservations of LPS swimming facilities.
