COVID Protocols Revised: February 25, 2022

If an employee or participant tests positive for COVID, a five-day quarantine from RSA programming is mandated, regardless of whether the individual is symptomatic. Note the employee or participant must also be fever free for a minimum of twenty-four (24) hours without fever reducing medication prior to returning to work and/or programming.

As a reminder, RSA employees are not responsible for checking vaccination status or calculating the days absent from programming for participants ill with COVID. Determining the appropriate return date will continue to be the responsibility of the participant, participant's guardian and/or healthcare professional.

The goal of RSA's approach is to limit those that need to be absent from programming.
