Meet Times Morning Session for 6&U, 8&U, 9 &10, and 15-18 will start at 8:30 a.m.

Warm-ups: Girls at 7:15-7:45 a.m., Boys 7:45 to 8:15 a.m.

Afternoon Session for ages 11-12, 13-14 will start no earlier than 2 p.m. Warm-ups: Girls at 1-1:30, and Boys 1:30-2. Warm ups may commence while the morning session is in progress. The warm up pool
