

## Weymouth Waves Honor Code – Travel Meets

Swimmers should be respectful of their peers, coaches, parents, chaperones, meet officials, etc.

No alcohol, tobacco products, or drugs at any time.

Room curfew and 'lights out' times will be established by the coaches and will be adhered to.

No male athletes in female athletes' rooms; no females in male athletes' rooms. No exceptions.

Swimmers will attend and participate in all team functions, whether meetings, meals, planned activities, or meet sessions.

Swimmers will not leave the hotel, pool, or restaurant without express permission of the coaches.

Swimmers will refrain from any inappropriate or illegal behavior at all times.

WAVES swimmers are expected to behave in an exemplary manner at all times.

Coaches will have the final word on any rules, regulations, or disciplinary actions.

All swimmers and parents are apprised in writing of these policies. Signing this document constitutes unconditional agreement to comply with the Honor Code of the Weymouth Waves. Failure to comply with the Honor Code may result in disciplinary action including but not limited to:

- Dismissal from the team and immediate return home at parents' expense;
- Disqualification from one or more events, or all events of competition;
- Disqualification from future Waves travel opportunities;
- Other disciplinary measures upon the team's return home.
