



YNS Sharks IMX Meet COVID Protocol Update 01/06/2022

The following protocols will apply to everyone who will be attending the January 15th and 16th YNS IMX Meet at the Greater Beverly YMCA:

1. The City of Beverly is currently in a "[Mask Mandate Protocol](#)" and as such anyone age 2 and above entering the facility must be wearing a mask.
2. Coaches, Officials and Volunteers at the meet must remain masked at all times unless in an area where they are eating and or drinking. All eating and drinking should be confined to the hospitality/ café area. We would appreciate no eating on the pool deck.
3. All Swimmers must bring a mask and a zip lock bag to have with them on the pool deck so that while they are warming up, down or competing they will have a container for their mask. (we will have extra masks and zip locks on hand)
4. We will have a warm-up/down for 13/over swimmers in the 6 lane pool. Each team should monitor this area with a Coach, if not monitored by a coach the swimmers will be asked to leave the 6 lane pool.
5. We are continuing our "No Spectator" policy but we will be live streaming the meet and will provide directions and a link for viewing prior to the meet beginning
6. All swimmers will be on the pool deck and asked to remain in specific locations while not actively swimming.
7. Coaches, Officials and Volunteers will be able to direct swimmers to "Staging" areas on the pool deck in order to maintain as much social distancing as is reasonably possible during each session
8. Coaches should be aware of not allowing start or turn end crowding during warm up session and if possible use a strategic configuration of swimmers in your respective lanes
