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<b>FACILITY</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Webster Aquatic Center</b>          875 Ridge Road          Webster, NY 14580          585-670-1087</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>50-meter pool will be set up as 6 to 8 lane, 50-meter pool with non-turbulent lane dividers and electronic timing.</li> <li>Water depth: From start end, pool depth is 15' at 1 meter and 5 meters. From turn end, pool depth is 4' at 1 meter and 5 meters.</li> <li>The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.</li> <li>Lane(s) will be available for continuous warm-up and cool down.</li> <li>Swimmers will sit with their teams on the pool deck.</li> </ul>
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<b>ENTRY DEADLINE</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>June 1, 2023 at 10 pm</b></p> <p>IMPORTANT: The above date is the deadline for clubs to submit their entries to the Entry Coordinator. Therefore, clubs usually set an earlier deadline to receive entries from their swimmers. Check with your club for this information.</p>

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<b>ELIGIBILITY</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Open to all registered USA Swimmers.</li> <li>No swimmer will be permitted to compete in the meet unless the swimmer is registered as an athlete member of USA Swimming as provided in <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i>, Article 302.</li> </ul>
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<b>DISABILITY SWIMMERS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>NI and host clubs along with their meet directors are committed to <a href="#">the Inclusion Policy</a> as adopted by the NI BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to competition.</li> </ul>
<b>TIMING SYSTEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Automatic timing will be used.</li> </ul>
<b>RULES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.</li> <li>All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming <a href="#">Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy</a> ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.</li> <li>No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted.</li> <li>In compliance with <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i>, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per NI policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.</li> <li>Deck changes are prohibited.</li> <li>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> <li>Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</li> <li>Dive-over starts will be used.</li> <li>The Meet Director and the NI Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 &amp; U events per Rule 205.3.1F.</li> </ul>
<b>EVENT RULES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>The meet will be capped at 4 hours. Entries will be accepted on a first come basis until the meet is full.</b></li> <li><b>800 Freestyle may be limited at the discretion of the meet director to stay within timeline.</b></li> <li>All events are timed finals.</li> <li>Swimmers may enter and swim no more than 3 individual events.</li> <li>Age on the first day of the meet determines eligibility.</li> <li><b>Please use a "coach's custom time (LCM)" in lieu of "NT" for proper seeding.</b></li> <li>Deck entries may be allowed if there is room in empty lanes. Swimmers will be required to prove current USA Swimming membership in good standing if the swimmers are not already in the meet and vetted through Niagara LSC's meet recon procedure.</li> </ul>
<b>POSITIVE CHECK IN</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All events will be pre-seeded with the exception of the 800 Freestyle and 400 Individual Medley events which will be deck seeded with positive check-in required 45 minutes before the start of the meet.</li> </ul>
<b>WARM-UP</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The prescribed NI warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.</li> </ul>

<b>SUPERVISION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers in all areas throughout the duration of the meet and cleaning up the team area.</li> <li>Cooperation with the request of a Meet Marshal is expected.</li> <li>The meet area is restricted to the pool and adjoining locker rooms, the adjacent hallway and balcony area. Any swimmer found in an area designated out-of-bounds will be barred from participating in the remainder of the meet.</li> </ul>
<b>SEEDING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The meet will be seeded following USA Swimming seeding rules with the exception of the 800 freestyle which will be seeded fastest to slowest. Failure to swim after positive check-in will result in disqualification from that event.</li> </ul>
<b>SCORING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>There will be no scoring at this meet</li> </ul>
<b>AWARDS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>There will be no awards given at this meet</li> </ul>
<b>PROGRAMS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Programs will be provided for coaches and officials and will be made available electronically to spectators.</li> </ul>
<b>CREDENTIALS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times.</li> </ul>
<b>SPECTATOR ENTRY FEE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>None</li> </ul>
<b>OFFICIALS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Officials interested in volunteering should contact the Officials Chair listed above.</li> <li>Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials briefing will precede each session during warm-ups.</li> </ul>
<b>TIMERS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Participating clubs will be required to provide timers.</li> </ul>
<b>ENTRY PROCEDURES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Entries should be submitted by email to <a href="mailto:adminofficial@wsabluefins.com">adminofficial@wsabluefins.com</a></li> <li>Include in the subject of the email, "NI Super Circuit #2 - ****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files include training site in the subject of the email.</li> <li>Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.</li> <li>In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).</li> <li>Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.</li> <li>Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.</li> <li>The entry coordinator will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.</li> <li>Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by NI and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.</li> </ul>

<b>ENTRY FEES</b>	<p>Per Swimmer Surcharge: \$5                      Relay event fee: \$0 Individual event fee: \$5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Make checks payable to <b>Webster Swim Association</b> and mail to the following address:  Webster Swim Association  Treasurer  P.O. Box 262  Webster, NY 14580</li> <li>• Payment for entries from unattached swimmers not affiliated with a team must be received prior to the meet. Payment may be made by cash or check.</li> <li>• Entry fees are due with meet entry. Unpaid fees will be reported to the NI Administrative Office at the conclusion of the meet.</li> </ul>
<b>Available Medical Supervision/ Equipment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Webster Aquatic Center (WAC) has lifeguards stationed on the pool deck monitoring the competition and warm up pool. A lifeguard office is located off the pool deck with medical supplies. AEDs are available in the facility.</li> </ul>
