

## **Welcome back to the Berkeley Swim School!**

For your safety, and the safety of our staff and other participants, we encourage all to adhere to the following policies and procedures while participating in any BAC programming:

- Due to COVID 19, it is now protocol that instructors will not be in the water at this time.
- Entry to and Exit from the Swim School will be through the back entrance “only.” There is a door on the back of our facility which leads directly to the swim school. For the safety of all engaged in BAC programming, parking will be limited to the side parking lots “only” as designated by safety cones. Stairs lead to the door which will be opened and closed by a staff member “only.” (Accommodations can be made to facilitate entry and exit for those requiring an accessible route.)
- Parking is permitted only in the side lots of our facility. There is no parking in the rear, nor is there the ability to circumnavigate our parking lot.
- Swimmers and escorts are to arrive and leave wearing facial coverings while maintaining social distance.
- Swimmers are to arrive in bathing attire, and are to leave in the same.
- One escort per swimmer will be permitted entry
- Escort is to remain for duration of the lesson
- Swimmers may bring in a towel, cap, goggles and a ziplock bag for the stowage of their facial covering.
- Changing areas and showers are not provided during this time. Locker rooms are only available for emergency bathroom use. Portable toilets are available outside the facility.
- When classes begin, the instructor will give the signal for the removal and storage of the swimmers’ facial covering.
- At the conclusion of the lesson, swimmers will exit the water, place back on their facial covering as they dry off and prepare to exit with their escort while maintaining social distancing.
- There will be no refunds after the first class.**
