## FSPY Swim Team Places Fifth At Long Course Nationals

The Fanwood-Scotch Plains “Y” swim team set a number of long course team and state records at the 2016 National Championships in Indianapolis, IN. Along with setting new records, a number of swimmers set new personal bests. The team finished fifth overall among 112 teams improving from last year’s eighth place finish and Coach Chris Karelus received Coach of the Meet Honors.

Marlise Moesch, Sarah Davis, Darlene Fung and Amanda Banasiak posted a time of 1:46.04 in the women’s 200-meter freestyle relay to place first, while setting a new team record. In the 400-meter medley relay, Fung, Moesch, Rachel Maizes and Monika Burzynski swam to a first place victory in a time of 4:21:64 and setting a new team record.

In the 200-medley, Moesch, Rachel Maizes, Burzynski and Sara Davis set a time of 1:57:36 finishing second and setting a state record. Burzynski earned a state record in the 100-butterfly with a time of 1:01:74.

Chris Bondarowicz finished second in the 200-breaststroke with a time of 2:21:90 resulting with a new team record. Josh Cohen finished eighth in the 800-free and 14th in the 100-free. Kevin Fleck finished 18<sup>th</sup> in the 1,500-free with a new team record. In the women’s 100-free, Moesch placed fourth with a time of 57:43, Davis finished seventh with a time of 58:25.
