Please read this carefully, initial, and sign, where indicated, and return with your registration

Parents and swimmers are obligated to fulfill the responsibilities specified below. Ant swimmers whose financial obligations to the club are not fully satisfied will be barred from registering to swim with this or any other YMCA or USS Team until those obligations re satisfied. To remain in good standing a family must be current with fee payments and have satisfied all fundraising and participation requirements, OR have selected one of the two buyout options below.

YMCA Meets

- Work a minimum number of 3 YMCA Dual meets.
- Work at Championship/Mini meets in which your child competes.

USS Meets: (Age Group and Senior Levels)

- Work any USS meet in which your child competes, or arrange for a replacement worker.

Fundraising:

- Work all fundraising meets hosted by HAC – even if your child is not swimming. We run three USS meets in June and July. We provide timers, admissions and hospitality, and monitors

Swimmers:

- ALL swimmers are expected to compete in ALL YMCA dual and championship meets. Notification of inability to attend a meet must be made to your coach at least one week in advanced.
