

## **Madison Area YMCA Mariners Swim Team Team Records Rules**

**Swimmer must be a full member, representing the Madison Area YMCA swim team (not unattached) at the time the record is set.**

**Record must be set at a regularly scheduled bona fide YMCA or USA swim meet; record may also be set at a full team time trial (eg. Red/Black Scrimmage) or a replacement meet, such as those prevalent during the Covid 19 Pandemic.**

**The swimmer's age will be determined by the age at the meet. For USA Swimming it will be the day of the first day of the meet and for YMCA Swimming it will be 12/1 or 7/1 respective to season.**

**Team relay records must comply with the age rule for each swimmer on the relay team. Relay records must be intact.**

**A lead-off swimmer's time on a relay may qualify for a record as long as appropriate timing (electronic or 3 watches) is utilized. No relay splits other than lead-off will be considered.**

**Lead-off splits from individual swims, such as 100 fly on a 400 IM or 1000 on the 1650, may be considered for records if the event is completed legally without disqualification. In all cases, a legal completion would be required. A foot touch at the 50 of a 100 backstroke cannot be considered as it's not a legal finish. Furthermore, an honest effort through completion of the race is required for a split record to count.**
