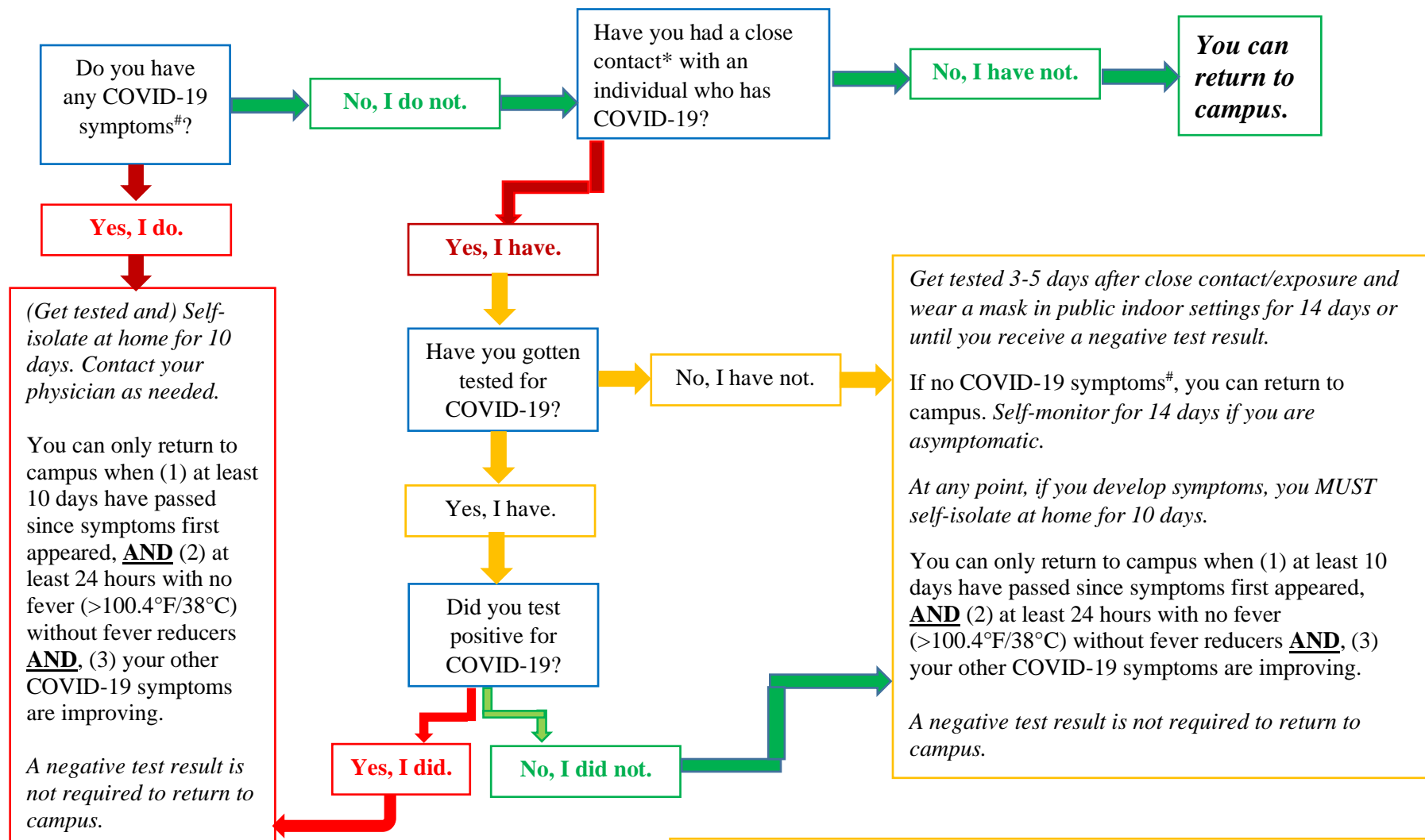


## COVID-19 When-Can-I-Return-to-Campus Flowchart (For Fully Vaccinated Persons)



**NOTE:** As of July 27, 2021, the CDC [recommends](#) that fully vaccinated people who come into close contact# with someone with suspected or with confirmed COVID-19 to be tested 3-5 days after exposure, and to wear a mask in public indoor settings for 14 days or until they receive a negative test result.

#Following are COVID-19 symptoms: fever/chills (>100.4°F/38°C), persistent cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, unexplained muscle or body aches, unexplained headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea. This list does not include all possible symptoms.

**NOTE:** If you have trouble breathing, new confusion, persist pain or pressure in the chest, inability to wake or stay awake, pale, gray, or blue-colored lips, seek emergency medical care immediately. This list is not all possible symptoms.

\*Close contact: Someone who's been within 6 feet (2 meters) of an infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period.
