



MEET JOB DESCRIPTION - MEET MARSHAL

1. Arrive 15 minutes prior to warm-up
2. Monitor warm-up to ensure the safety of all participants
 - a. No forward or backstroke starts except in controlled one-way sprint lanes at the designated time; at all other times swimmers must enter the water feet first at the same end of the pool
 - b. No training equipment used
 - c. Circle swimming only
3. Monitor all meet areas throughout the duration of the meet
 - a. Monitor the warm-down pool
 - b. Periodically walk through any areas where swimmers may be present
 - c. Make sure that all adults on deck have wristbands
 - d. Report any suspicious adults to the Meet referee
4. Monitor locker rooms
 - a. Check with Meet Director re: locker room policies
 - b. Collaborate with other staff to periodically walk through locker rooms and document as required
5. Report unsafe areas to the Meet Referee
