## TEAM GOALS

Each swimmer receives frequent positive feedback on performance. Swimmers can participate in area swim meets from local dual meets to area invitational meets to national-level meets. Swimmers work toward National Age Group standards, as well as qualifying for championship meets in the Genesee Valley Swim League, Niagara LSC, and other USA Swimming Championships.

## YEAR ROUND EXERCISE

Registration fees provide the swimmer with over 200 practices, approximately 300 hours of pool time, indoor "Short Course" season, and optional summer "Long Course" season for a reasonable addition fee. You determine how much to practice based on your goals.

## SOCIAL

The club provides a number of fun, social events like holiday parties, a team picture night, a Swim-A-Thon fundraiser, and an end-of-season banquet.

## SWIMMER RECOGNITION

VSC swimmers receive acknowledgement of individual achievements. Awards include recognition of personal best times, National Age Group Times, meet ribbons, medals, and trophies. There is a spring team banquet following the conclusion of the short course season.
