

BBA Service Policy

Parent volunteers are vital to the success of BBA. BBA hosts several meets during the season and it is vital to have meet workers at each session/meet. Without help from our families we would not be able to provide swimmers with a great swimming experience. Without a strong parent base, programs and opportunities would be limited. Our Service Policy is intended to share the workload of running our BBA hosted meets.

This policy is intended to help meet the following objectives:

1. **Benefit swimmers:** Competition allows swimmers the opportunity to race and test the skills they work so hard to achieve. Home meets give the added benefit of a familiar environment without the added time and expense of travel.
2. **Promote and actively support competitive swimming in our community:** Swimming is unique in that it relies almost exclusively on volunteers. By volunteering, you are actively supporting BBA, the sport, and your child's swim experience.
3. **Get more families involved:** Meets hosted by BBA require an average of 30 workers per session. The service policy helps to involve all families, so we can continue to host well-run, well-attended, and successful meets.

Each BBA family fulfills the service policy commitment by working four (4) sessions at any BBA hosted meet. Families will be assessed \$100 per session not worked.
