

FAST Fundraising Agreement

Long Course - 2018 Season

-> Flag City Invitational – Riverside Park – June 8-10, 2018

- Expected Number of Work Sessions: 4
- Operational Fee Assessed: \$45 per session if not fulfilled

-> Long Course Regionals – BGSU – July 6-8, 2018

- Expected Number of Work Sessions: 4
- Operational Fee Assessed: \$45 per session if not fulfilled
- If your swimmer has 7 or more JO cuts we will make every attempt to fill slots prior to asking you to attend.
- High School Only Families (ages 15 & over) are asked to work as many sessions as possible. FAST is offering a \$10 per session credit (up to \$50) toward your 2018 Short Course (Fall) season.

-> Pick 3 Fundraiser – June 2018

- Tickets will be sold the month of June 2018 and July 2018 Pick 3 (nightly) numbers will be used.
- Each family is required to sell 20 tickets at \$10 a piece. Possible ticket sales to start in May 2018.

All volunteer hours are eligible for National Honor Society credit.

FAST-Sponsored Event Typical Revenue Generation

Flag City Invitational - \$6,000-\$8,000

Regionals: \$7,000- \$9,000

Pick 3 Fundraiser: \$2,500 – \$8,000 (if all tickets sold)

These events require people and funds to make them possible. You may either: (1) **choose to work the required number of sessions to meet the operational fee** (*i.e. work expectations*). OR (2) **pay the operational fees up front**; Each session normally requires **1-4 hours** of your time.

Expectation Guidelines

These events require people to make them possible. Prior to the fundraising event, you will select from a number of available work sessions in Team Unify. Most sessions run approximately 4 hours. Families may work extra sessions if they so choose. If you are working extra sessions to assist another family, please contact the volunteer coordinator prior to the event to make arrangements.

You may either:

1. Choose to work the required number of sessions to meet the operational fee.
2. Recruit a person over 18 years of age to work your sessions.

If a family is unable to fulfill their fundraising expectations, they will be responsible for the operational fee assigned to that event. The family may execute one of the 2 options:

1. Pay the operational fee for each missing session; or
2. Have their account billed for the operating fee for each missing session.
