WARMUPS: There will be morning and afternoon warm up sessions. Please remind your swimmers of feet first entry during warm-ups. Teams may begin one-way sprints at the discretion and under the supervision of the coach. Please note that some lanes are scheduled for one-way sprints during the warmup session in case you need extra time.

We will adjust the afternoon warm up schedule if the morning session does not end on time. The afternoon meet will **NOT START** before 1:55 pm. The first afternoon warm up session is scheduled to start at 1:00 p.m.

COACHES MEETING: We are NOT planning to have a Coaches Meeting at this time. If necessary, a Coaches Meeting will be announced.
