We would like to thank many of you again for the success of our meet early in February. Parents and swimmers (most swimmers 11 and up) worked in numerous arenas to make the meet go smoothly. We had volunteers working in the coaches' room, pool room and bull pen. They were also outside helping with parking, by the pool as relief timers and heat winner prize distributors, and some ran necessary errands while others helped to set up and clean up for the invitational. We couldn't run a meet without all of you. THANKS AGAIN!!

We also need to remember to thank the following businesses that made donations. Ulbrich's provided donuts, Wendy's of Troy donated baked potatoes, and Tim Horton's of Troy donated coffee. When you visit these places, please let them know that we appreciate their support!!

Because we had such a successful meet, we are able to make purchases throughout the season. This year, we have purchased new exercise bands, new kickboards for the Robinson Branch, a new lane line reel that cost around \$2000. We have also purchased a new lap top and carrying bag for the coaches, which cost about \$500; they have already proven beneficial because both YMCAs have recently added WiFi. Thanks to the Marlin Madness meet, we were also able to pay for an Urbana University speed coach to work with Marlin swimmers 13 and older and purchase the new Meet Manager 4.0 that costs \$230 and is required so that we are able to run Meet Mobile. The MPAC also agreed to purchase MCY swim caps for all swimmers, pay for the fall hayride and purchase pizza for movie night.


