FOR AN UNRELATED-AESC-APPLICABLE-ADULT TO ENGAGE WITH MINOR ATHLETE(S) OUTSIDE OF USA SWIMMING ACTIVITIES

On June 23, 2019, American Energy Swim Club (AESC) adopted USA Swimming's *Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy* (MAAPP), which is intended to protect minor athletes from potential abuse by limiting one-on-one interactions between adults, especially those in a position of power (e.g., coaches), and minor athletes. While the MAAPP does not apply to non-USA Swimming activities, AESC nevertheless requires this form to be completed by the parent(s)/legal guardian(s) of a minor(s) whose minor child(ren) will be interacting with a coach outside the presence of other adults at any non-USA Swimming activity.
