General Info:

The team will leave for Winnipeg, Manitoba on Wednesday December 11, 2019 from Toronto Pearson International Airport Terminal. During the course of the meet, swimmers must remain with the team at all times. Travel between the hotel and the pool will be by van unless other arrangements are required. The club will be sending 2 coaches, Kyle Welsh and Meghan McDonnell and 2-3 chaperones. Rooms will have 2 queen beds and 4 swimmers will be assigned per hotel room. This may change based on final numbers of swimmers.

Meals:

Breakfast, lunch and dinners will be catered and provided at the hotel. Chaperones will prepare snacks.

Payment & Registration:

The cost of the trip is an estimate; final costs will only be known after the trip. However, every effort is made to stay within budget. The remaining balance will be billed to your TeamUnify account after the conclusion of the meet once all meet expenses have been reconciled.

Budgeted Total Trip Cost: \$1,600

Non-refundable Deposit: \$800 Due by October 25, 2019 to be paid via above JotForm link.

In order to attend this meet the deposit must be paid prior to the deadline. There will be no late registrations past Oct 25, 2019 for this meet. Registrations are confirmed with payment.

SWIMMER RULES OF CONDUCT

The Oakville Aquatic Club (OAK) aims to support athletes in the pursuit of excellence in swimming. To do this, there is a need to maintain a strong behavior and discipline code to support each athlete's efforts. Therefore, the Club has adopted a zero tolerance program, and the following lays out the expectations for all swimmers. In addition to the Club's policies, all swimmers are expected to adhere to the Town of Oakville's R Zone respect and responsibility policy while representing the Club in any of the Town's facilities.

While participating in any Club activity, including practices, swim meets, social events, team travel, overnight stays in hotels/motels/residences, dining in restaurants, and when in or on public/private property, including change rooms and parking lots, etc., swimmers are expected to demonstrate a responsible manner, as befits the Oakville Aquatic Club. Unacceptable behavior, as listed below, will not be tolerated at any time:

- Use of foul language - Damage to facilities - Damage to personal property - Fighting - Unsportsmanlike conduct - Use of drugs, tobacco, or alcohol - Sexual contact - Committing any act which would be considered an illegal offence - Breaking training or curfew without authority - No deck changing allowed - Appropriate Oak attire to be worn on the deck (no sports bras or tank tops).

When at away meets, doors will be left ajar when a non-occupant visits rooms.

Coaches and chaperones have been given direction by the Board of Directors of the Oakville Aquatic Club to act firmly and quickly should any unacceptable incidents occur. Actions may include:

- Being sent home from a swim meet at the member's expense - Suspension from swimming - Damage to property will be the responsibility of the instigator and his/her parents

Any instance of gross misbehavior or property damage will be referred to the Disciplinary Committee for further action. If an incident occurs where identification of the guilty party is not immediately possible, and the offender does not come forward, then the entire group will lose swimming privileges until the offender is identified. Continued misbehavior will result in a loss of swimming privileges for the rest of the season, and a possible permanent ban from the Club with no refund of fees.
